TRIO OF ALL-STARS: The D-backs will be represented by 2B Ketel Marte (starting 2B), 3B Eugenio Suárez (reserve) and OF Corbin Carroll (reserve) at the MLB All-Star Game on July 15 in Atlanta.

2B Ketel Marte - Fan-Elected Starter:

- Led NL players in Phase 2 voting.
- Second straight and third career start at second base (also: 2019, '24).
- · First NL second baseman with consecutive fan-elected starts since Chase Utley with 5 straight from 2006-10.
- First D-back with 3 fan-elected starts, second with 3 starts (also: Paul Goldschmidt) and third with consecutive starts (also: Paul Goldschmidt in 2014-15 and Randy Johnson in 2000-01).

3B Eugenio Suárez - Player-Elected INF Reserve:

• 2-time All-Star (also: 2018 with the Reds, player-elected at 3B).

OF Corbin Carroll - Player-Elected OF Reserve:

• 2-time All-Star (also: 2023 as fan-elected starter in LF).

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 6-5 @ Angels, for their second straight 1-run loss and third 1-run loss in their last 4 games.

- Randal Grichuk initiated the scoring with a 2-run homer in the second...added a game-tying homer in the eighth...was his first multi-homer game since Sept. 3, 2024 @ Giants (2)...first game with 3+ extra-base hits since June 11, 2024 vs. Angels (3).
- Ketel Marte had his second straight multi-hit effort and fourth straight game reaching multiple times (2 H).
- Alek Thomas reached safely in his eighth straight road game and had his second multi-hit performance.
- Reliever Anthony DeSclafani made his sixth straight appearance of 2.0+ innings...was his third scoreless game in his last 4.

GALLEN 8 K SHY OF 1,000: Zac Gallen is 8 strikeouts shy (992 K) of 1,000 in his career.

- He would become 1 of 11 active starting pitchers since 2019 to reach the feat, joining Zack Wheeler/ PHI (1,242), Gerritt Cole/NYY (1,241), Aaron Nola/ PHI (1,234), Luis Castillo/SEA (1,161), Dylan Cease/SD (1,145), Charlie Morton/BAL (1,141), Kevin Gausman/ TOR (1,126), teammate Corbin Burnes/AZ (1,079), José Berríos/TOR (1,049) and Sonny Gray/STL (1,048).
- His 949 strikeouts as a D-back are fourth in franchise history, behind Randy Johnson (2,077), Brandon Webb (1,065) and Robbie Ray (998).

SNAKEBITES: Josh Naylor has hit safely in 5 straight games vs. AL West and reached base safely in 11 of his last 12, hitting .386 (17-for-44)/.471 OBP/.727 SLG/1.198 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 homers, 13 RBI and 7 walks (5 K).

- Corbin Carroll has hit in 7 straight road games, since June 8, at a .320 clip (8-for-25)/1.118 OPS, 2 doubles, 2 triples, 1 homer, 4 RBI, 5 walks and 1 HBP.
- · Geraldo Perdomo, since July 1), has reached base safely in 10 of his 11 games, batting .317 (13-for-41)/.451 OBP with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 7 RBI, 8 walks (7 K) and 2 hit-by-pitches.

GRICHUK AT THE BIG A: Randal Grichuk, as an opponent @ Angel Stadium, is a career .306 hitter (15-for-49)/.673 SLG/1.020 OPS with 3 doubles, 5 homers, 10 RBI and 3 walks over 15 games.

• His .673 SLG and 1.020 OPS @ Angels ranks sixth and eighth respectively among all players since 2016 (min. 15 G).

HOMERS RECENTLY AND ON THE ROAD The D-backs' 37 home runs (22 G) since June 19 are tied for third in the Majors with the Mariners, behind the Cubs (40) and Yankees (38).

- On the road, the D-backs' 70 home runs are fourth in the Majors, behind the Cubs (82), Mariners (71) and Angels (71).
- It is the fourth time in franchise history with 70+ road homers within the first 100 games of a season (also: franchise-high 93 HR in 2019, 70 HR in 2001 and 70 HR in 1999).

VS. ANGELS: The D-backs are 9-8 since 2018, including 5-4 on the road.

• Randal Grichuk, in his last 6 games, is hitting .429 (9-for-21)/.478 OBP/1.095 SLG/1.573 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers, 5 RBI and 2 walks.

· Josh Naylor, in his last 13 games, is hitting .311 (14for-45)/1.141 OPS with 1 double, 6 homers, 15 RBI, 8 walks (7 K) and 2 stolen bases.

Corbin Carroll, in 4 career games, is hitting .308 (4for-13)/.938 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 1 RBI, 2 walks and 1 stolen base.

CALL TO THE 'PEN: D-backs relievers, in their last 8 games since July 4, boast a MLB-best 1.08 ERA (4 R-3 ER in 25.0 IP) with an opponent .211 AVG (19-for-90)/.675 OPS and 16 strikeouts.

• Among all bullpens since June 30 (12 G), their 1.98 ERA ranks tied for second with the Brewers, behind the Marlins (1.27)...are 1 of 2 relief staffs to surrender only 1 homer in the span with the Brewers (1).

WHEN STARTERS WORK 6.0+ INNINGS: The D-backs are 31-14 when their starting pitcher works 6.0+ innings.

• The D-backs are 12-4 in their last 16 starts, since June 1, when their starting pitcher works 6.0+ innings (8-1 in June, 4-3 in July)...their 16 such starts are fourth in the NL since June 1 behind the Phillies (22), Braves (19) and Giants (17).

LIMITED FREE PASSES: D-backs starting pitchers' 7 walks surrendered in their last 8 games since July 4 are tied for second fewest with the Marlins, behind the Mets (4).

ABOVE AVERAGE DEFENDERS: D-backs outfielders' 4 outs above average and 4 runs prevented in July are tied for the most in MLB with the Red Sox and Brewers...ahead of the Athletics (3 OAA/3 RP) and Cubs (4 OAA/3 RP).

NEXT STARTER: RHP MERRILL KELLY (7-5, 3.41)

Tossed 7.0 innings of 1-run, 4-hit ball with 0 walks and 4 strikeouts in his last start on July 8 @ Padres...took the loss in the 1-0 affair, surrendering a solo homer to Luis Arráez (Bot 7)...it was just the second time in the Majors this season a starting pitcher worked 7.0+ innings with 77 or fewer pitches (also: José Soriano/ LAA on March 29 @ White Sox, 7.0 IP, 73 pitches).

 In his lone start vs. Angels on June 11, 2021, did not factor in the 5-6 loss after allowing 3 runs on 4 hits in 5.0 innings with 6 strikeouts.
