### THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY

struck out nine in a 5-0 shutout at Cleveland in his last start of the regular season...Palmer joined teammates LHP Dave McNally, LHP Mike Cuellar, and RHP Pat Dobson as 20-game winners...The Orioles became the second team with four 20-game winners, joining the 1920 Chicago White Sox.



DATE September 27 ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Orioles fell to the Blue Jays on Friday night in Buffalo by the score of 10-5 and now own just a 1-7 record against Toronto this season.

- (8-for-21) with two doubles, one home run, and three RBI over his nine Major League games.
- 🚱 Urías joined INF/OF Ryan Mountcastle as Orioles hitters with their first Major League home run coming at Buffalo's Sahlen Field...Mountcastle clubbed two home runs on August 30 at the ballpark as he went 3-for-4 with nine total bases.

I SAN-TAN-DARE YOU: OF Anthony Santander has been voted the winner of the 2020 Louis M. Hatter Most Valuable Oriole Award by local media who cover the team on a regular basis.

- Os Santander finished the season hitting .261/.315/.575 (40-for-153) with 13 doubles, one triple, 11 home runs, 24 runs scored, 32 RBI, and 10 walks.
- (h) His season was cut short after being placed on the IL with a strained right oblique on September 5...At the time of his injury. Santander was leading the American League in extra-base hits (25), ranked tied for second in doubles (13), third in total bases (88), tied for third in RBI (32), sixth in slugging percentage (.575), and tied for sixth in home runs (11).

SEPTEMBER HAYS: OF Austin Hays is batting .356/.396/.600 (16-for-45) with three home runs and 10 runs scored since coming off the Injured List on September 14 (non-displaced rib fracture)...His 16 hits and 10 runs scored are tied for second in the AL during this stretch.

hays is a career .296 (50-for-169) hitter in 52 September games, with eight of his nine career home runs coming during the month.

BUFFALO WILD THINGS: The Toronto Blue Jays home ballpark for the 2020 season is Sahlen Field in Buffalo...The Blue Jays have called the park "home" since August 11.

- Os According to ESPN Stats and Info, 2020 marks the first time that Buffalo has hosted Major League regular season games since the Buffalo Buffeds/Blues of the short-lived Federal League called the city home from 1914-15.
- Prior to the O's previous trip to Sahlen Field (August 28-31), it had been nearly 105 years since a team from Baltimore last played a Major League game in the city of Buffalo...On September 8, 1915, the Baltimore Terrapins were swept in a doubleheader (4-0. 5-4) by the Buffalo Blues at Federal League Park...The games of that day were the last Major League games played in Buffalo prior to 2020.

ROAD WARRIORS: At 11-14 (.440), the O's own the sixth-best road record in the AL and their road record ranks 16th-best in the majors...O's hitters rank first in the AL and third in the majors with a .274 team batting average on the road...The Orioles lead the AL and rank sixth in the majors with a .772 team OPS on the road...O's pitchers own a 4.76 ERA (113 ER/213.2 IP) in 25 games on the road this season to rank seventh in the AL and 16th in the majors.

WAKE ME UP WHEN SEPTEMBER ENDS: According to teamrankings.com the O's 2020 strength of schedule (as of September 25) ranks as the toughest in the AL and fifth-toughest in the majors.

- Ox During the month of September, O's hitters rank sixth in the AL in OPS (.747), rank fourth in batting average (.258), and are tied for fifth in the AL in home runs (32).
- OF DJ Stewart's seven home runs are tied for seventh in the AL in September and INF/ OF Rvan Mountcastle is tied for eighth in the AL with 18 RBI, while Stewart and INF Rio Ruiz are tied for 14th in the AL with 15 RBI each during the month.
- ₱ The O's 4.45 ERA (98 ER/198.1 IP) during September ranks eighth-best in the AL...O's pitchers have allowed 98 earned runs during the month to rank seventh-fewest in the AL.

IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: On the first pitch of a plate appearance, the Orioles rank first in the majors in batting average (.417), and rank second in the AL and fourth in the majors in OPS (1.116), while ranking seventh in the majors in extra-base hits (33)...The Orioles rank second in the AL and are fourth in the majors in doubles (20), and lead the AL in hits (88) and rank fifth in the majors as a team on the first pitch.

SMALL BALL FOR ALL: The O's lead the majors with 16 bunt hits this season...OF Cedric Mullins leads the majors with nine bunt hits, while INF Hanser Alberto is tied for fourth in the majors with five bunt hits and INF/OF Andrew Velazquez is tied for 12th in the majors with two bunt hits.

**SEVENTH HEAVEN:** Orioles pitchers have allowed just eight runs in the seventh inning this year for a 1.33 ERA (8 ER/54.0 IP)...It is the fewest runs allowed in the seventh inning in the majors, with the second-closest team (Atlanta) allowing 17 runs.

- Ox LHP Tanner Scott has made nine appearances in the seventh inning (6.1 IP) without allowing a run, while LHP Paul Fry has made eight appearances in the seventh inning (6.1 IP) without allowing a run.
- On the offensive side, the Orioles have scored 32 runs in the seventh inning, fifth-most in the AL and tied for ninth-most in the majors.

LEADER IN THE CLUBHOUSE: INF José Iglesias is hitting .370 (51-for-138) through his first 38 games with the Orioles...Among players with at least 120 at-bats, Iglesias' .370 average leads the majors...Juan Soto of the Washington Nationals ranks second in the majors with a .351 mark (min. 120 AB)...The last player in the majors to hit over .390 in a season was San Diego's Tony Gwynn, who hit .394 during 110 games of the strike-shortened 1994 season.

LEFT IS RIGHT: Since the start of the 2019 season, INF Hanser Alberto leads the majors with 106 hits off of left-handed pitching...In that time, he leads the majors with a .394 (106-for-269) average against lefties...This season, Alberto ranks 12th in the AL among qualifying hitters with a .294 (62-for-211) average against all pitchers.

INJURED LIST: Seven players are on the Injured List...INF Chris Davis (left knee patellar tendinitis), RHP Evan Phillips (right elbow inflammation), OF Anthony Santander (right oblique strain), and RHP Dillon Tate (retroactive to 9/21; right finger sprain) are on the 10-day Injured List...LHP Wade LeBlanc (left elbow stress reaction), INF/OF Trey Mancini (colorectal cancer recovery/treatment), and INF Richie Martin (right wrist fracture) are on the 60-day IL.

<u>LAST START:</u> Made his ninth start of the season on 9/20 vs. TB...Earned the win after working 5.2 innings, allowing one run on three hits (one home run) with no walks, a career-high 12 strikeouts, and two hit batters...His previous strikeout career-high was seven...Became the first Baltimore pitcher to record double-digit strikeouts in a game this year...The 12 strikeouts were the most by an O's pitcher since RHP Dylan Bundy struck out 14 on 5/24/18 at CWS...Struck out seven-straight Rays batters (two in the first inning, three in the second inning, two in the third inning) to match the Orioles club record for consecutive strikeouts set by Sammy Stewart in 1978.

CAREER VS. TORONTO: This will be Means' third career appearance against the Blue Jays...Between his two previous starts against Toronto, Means is 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA (3 ER/9.0 IP) and 10 strikeouts...Last faced Toronto on 8/28 in Buffalo, where he took a no-decision after allowing two runs on four hits (two home runs), with one walk and three strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work.

FACING THE AL EAST: Means has faced AL East opponents in 21 games (16 starts) throughout his career...Owns a 8-5 record and 4.58 ERA (47 ER/92.1 IP) with 84 strikeouts in these outings...AL East opponents are batting .245 (88-for-359) with 39 extra-base hits (19 doubles and 20 home runs) against Means in his career

FINISHING STRONG: Over his last three starts (since 9/8), Means is 2-0 with a 1.53 ERA (3 ER/17.2 IP) with two walks and 21 strikeouts...Opponents are batting .175 (11-for-63) with three home runs against Means over this span, and he has allowed just one run in each of his last three starts (four total times this year)...Over his first six starts of the season from 7/30-9/2, Means was 0-3 with a 8.10 ERA (18 ER/20.0 IP) and opponents were batting .293 (24-for-82) against him.

STARTING SLOW: Means has posted an 10.38 ERA (10 ER/8.2 IP) in the first inning in his nine starts this season, his highest mark of any inning...Opponents are hitting .314 (11-for-35) with two home runs, two walks, and a hit-by-pitch in the first inning...For his career, Means' first inning ERA is 5.30 (21 ER/35.2 IP) and opponents are batting .241 (33-for-137).

HOME VS. ROAD: Means has started six of his nine games at home this season...In 24 career games (22 starts) at home, Means is 9-8 with a 3.56 ERA (45 ER/113.2 IP), compared to 5-6 with a 4.70 ERA (43 ER/82.1 IP) in 17 games (14 starts) on the road...Has held opponents to a .219 (94-for-429) clip in games at Oriole Park, as opposed to his .264 (85-for-322) opponent average on the road.

<u>LEFT IS RIGHT:</u> Means has held lefties to a .210 average (39-for-186) in his career, compared to a .248 clip (140-for-565) against right-handed batters...Means held left-handed hitters to a .184 (26-for-141) clip last season, which ranked eighth-lowest in the AL and 13<sup>th</sup>-lowest in the majors...Lefties had a .223 OBP and slugged just .333 against Means...Left-handers hit .153 (13-for-85) against him at Oriole Park in 2019.

**AT THE TOP OF HIS CLASS:** Finished the 2019 campaign leading all rookie pitchers (min. 155.0 IP) in opponent batting average (.234), and ranked in the top 10 among rookie pitchers in: opponent OPS ( $2^{nd}$  - .702), WHIP ( $2^{nd}$  - 1.14), K/BB ( $2^{nd}$  - 3.18), ERA ( $3^{rd}$  - 3.60), K/9 ( $3^{rd}$  - 7.03), winning percentage ( $3^{rd}$  - .522), wins ( $4^{th}$  - 12), opponent SLG ( $4^{th}$  - .417), HR/9 ( $4^{th}$ , 1.34), strikeouts ( $5^{th}$  - 121), and Quality Starts ( $6^{th}$  - 11)...He received votes from the media in April and May's voting for AL Rookie of the Month.
