TODAY'S GAME: The Giants aim to level this three-game series tonight after a spirited comeback fell just short in last night's 8-7 loss to the D-Backs.

- ▶ The Giants have lost 13 of their last 20 games dating to August 11 and are three games under .500 for the first time since July 30 when they were 53-56 after a loss to the A's here at home.
- ▶ SF is 4-8 in its last 12 home games dating to August 11 and 39-31 overall this year at Oracle Park.

PARSELTONGUE: The Giants are undefeated in their last 11 home series against the D-Backs dating to 2020 (9-0-2), the club's longest streak at home since an 11-series run vs. Colorado from 2010-2014 (*OptaStats*).

- ▶ However, the Giants are 7-5 versus Arizona here since the beginning of 2023 and have a negative run differential in that time, being outscored 58-52.

WE ARE YOUNG: Last night's Giants starting lineup had an average age of 26 years, 363 days, the lowest of any Giants starting lineup this season...it's just the fourth lineup in the last 10 seasons (since 2015) the Giants have rolled out with an average age of 26 years, 363 days or younger...the other three dates occurred towards the end of last season (*OptaStats*).

BUILDING BLOCKS: Giants rookies have played big roles on both sides of the ball for the Giants in 2024.

- ▶ SF's rookie pitchers have thrown 442.1 innings so far in 2024, tied for the most innings thrown by rookie pitchers in the Majors this season with the crosstown A's.
- ▶ The team with the third-most rookie innings this year is Miami at 399.1, 43.1 innings behind both the A's and Giants.
- ▶ It's the most innings thrown by a group of Giants rookies in a single season since 1975 when that club's rookies combined to throw 541.1 innings.
- ▶ On the other side, SF's rookie position players have appeared in 165 games this year, 14th most in the Majors, but have combined for a .759 OPS...the .759 OPS from rookies is second-best in MLB behind San Diego's rookies with a .787 OPS (*Philadelphia's* rookies have a .929 OPS but have only amassed 32 games played entering play today).

LOOKING SPRY: IF Matt Chapman connected on his 22nd homer last night for SF and carries a .778 OPS into tonight's contest...the .778 OPS would be his highest in a full season since his 2019 All-Star campaign with Oakland that saw him put up an .848 OPS in 156 games.

- ▶ Chapman's 22 homers are the most by a Giants third baseman since **Pablo Sandoval** hit 23 in 2011...the last Giants third baseman to hit more than 23 in a single season was also Sandoval when he hit 25 in 2009.
- ▶ He owns a 6.0 bWAR in 136 games in 2024, tied for third-best in the National League with ARI's Ketel Marte behind LAD's Shohei Ohtani (7.1), NYM's Francisco Lindor (6.4)...it's Chapman's highest bWAR total since putting up a career-best 7.8 bWAR in the aforementioned 2019 season.

THE BIRD MAN: RHP Hayden Birdsong starts tonight looking to string together some positive outings as his rookie campaign winds down.

- ▶ The 23-year-old had a tough August, going 0-4 with an 8.68 ERA (18er, 18.2ip) as he allowed 18 hits (five homers), walked 15 and struck out 22.
- ▶ It's a stark contrast to his July where he made five starts and went 3-0 with a 2.45 ERA (7er, 25.2ip), allowed 16 hits, walked 12 and struck out 33.
- ▶ The youngster has worked 106.1 innings this year between Double-A Richmond, Triple-A Sacramento and the Majors, a new pro career high after being drafted in 2022...Birdsong threw 100.2 innings between three MiLB stops last season.

MIKE CHECK: OF Mike Yastrzemski clubbed his 15th career homer versus the D-Backs in his 70th career game last night...in fact, three of his eight hits against Arizona this year are homers.

- ▶ His 15 homers against Arizona are his most against any single opponent (next highest is his 11 HRs vs. Colorado) while his 41 career RBI versus the D-Backs are his second best against a single opponent (42 vs. Colorado).
- ▶ For the year, Yastrzemski now has 13 homers and has hit at least 10 homers in each of his six seasons as a Giant since debuting in 2019...the last Giants with six consecutive seasons of a least 10 homers were **Brandon Belt** and **Brandon Crawford** from 2014-2019.
- ▶ Over Yastrzemski's last eight games dating to August 24 he's 9-for-30 (.300) with nine runs scored, a double, four homers, six RBI and five walks.

THROWING TOO MANY PUNCHES...: The Giants struck out 15 more times last night, the 12th time in their last 19 games registering at least 10 strikeouts...not so coincidentally they have won just two of those 12 games with 10+ strikeouts.

- ▶ SF's 203 strikeouts since August 12 are fifth-most in the Majors and third-most in the NL behind the Brewers (211) and Mets (206).
- ▶ However, the club's 29.4% strikeout rate in that time is highest in the Majors.

HAYDEN BIRDSONG RHP #60

2024 RECORD: 3-4, 5.14 ERA

Height/Weight: 6-4/215 Bats/Throws: R/R

TODAY'S START: The 23-year-old is scheduled to make his 12th big league start today...he's gone 3-4 with a 5.14 ERA (28er, 49.0ip) in his 11 starts, with the Giants going 4-7 in his outings... had his contract selected from Triple-A Sacramento on June 26.

LAST TIME OUT: Had another tough outing last Thursday in Milwaukee and was hit with the loss in SF's 6-0 defeat...he allowed five runs, all earned, on four hits and four walks over 3.2 innings while throwing 92 pitches.

BUMP IN THE ROAD: Posted an 8.68 ERA (18er, 18.2ip) after allowing batters a .254 average and a .917 OPS over five starts in August...the Giants lost each of his five starts during the month... in his previous six starts, Birdsong posted a 2.97 ERA (10er, 30.1ip) and held batters to a .204 average and a .664 OPS.

HVAC ISSUES?: According to Sports Info Solutions, opponents slugging % off Birdsong's fastball more than doubled from July to August, going from .367 in July to .758 in August...he allowed four homers on his fastball in August after surrendering one on it in July.

HEAVY LIFTING: Birdsong has worked a combined 106.1 innings this year between Double-A Richmond (48.1ip), Triple-A Sacramento (9.0ip) and the Giants (49.0ip)...in fact he's already passed his innings total from last year (100.2 innings across three levels), which was his first full year in pro ball after being drafted in 2022.

THROW THAT CURVE: He's thrown 201 curveballs this season at the MLB level and batters are 5-for-48 (.104) with 25 strikeouts against it...the D-Backs' .255 average vs. curveballs is fourth-best in MLB (second-best in the NL) while their .744 OPS against them in tops in the NL and second in MLB behind Baltimore (.797)...their 26.0% strikeout rate on curveballs is also fourth-lowest in MLB.

VS. THE LEFTY: Lefties are batting just .206 (20x97) with a .351 slugging percentage off Birdsong this season, while righties are hitting .244 (20x82) with a .512 SLG...however, Birdsong tends to issue more walks to lefties (6.75 BB/9) vs. righties (4.03 BB/9).

STRIKE THREE!: His 12 strikeouts in his start against Colorado at Coors Field on July 21 were the most he'd ever accumulated in an outing in his pro career...in fact, his 12 punchouts were the most by a Giants pitcher ever at Coors Field...they were also the most by a Giants rookie since **Tim Lincecum** fanned 12 on July 1, 2007.

THE FUTURE IS NOW: The Illinois native entered the 2024 campaign as the Giants #6 prospect according to *Baseball America* and #7 according to *MLB.com*...he has since graduated from the prospect rankings given his accrued MLB time this year but is still one of SF's younger pitching hopefuls having just turned 23 last Friday.

PRIOR TO HIS MLB DEBUT: Birdsong spent parts of three seasons in the Giants system after being selected in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Eastern Illinois University (Charleston, IL).

EARLY ARRIVAL: Birdsong became the second Giant from the 2022 draft to reach the Majors, joining **OF Wade Meckler** (eighth round), who did so last year...there are just four players from the first round of that 2022 draft that have reached the Majors overall (IF Jackson Holliday with Baltimore, IF Zach Neto with the Angels, OF Jordan Beck with Colorado, IF Brooks Lee with Minnesota)...at the time of his debut, there were just 12 players selected ahead of Birdsong (6th round, 30th pick) in that 2022 draft that had made their debuts.

LIKE, REALLY EARLY: According to Grant Brisbee of *The Athletic* Birdsong's 169.2 minor league innings were the fewest thrown by a Giant before their Major League debut since **RHP Tim Lincecum** debuted in 2007 with only 62.2 minor league innings under his belt.

2024 IN THE MINORS: He began this year at Double-A Richmond and posted a 4-2 record with a 2.05 ERA (11er, 48.1ip) with 61 strikeouts in 11 starts for Double-A Richmond before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on June 11...made two starts for Sacramento after the promotion and posted a 5.00 ERA (5er, 9.0) with 14 strikeouts before his eventual MLB debut on June 26.

2023 SEASON: Split last season between three levels (San Jose -A, Eugene -A+ and Richmond -AA) and combined to go 2-5 with a 3.31 ERA (37er, 100.2ip) with 149 strikeouts overall...his 3.31 season ERA was best among SF Minor Leaguers (min 100.0ip) and earned him three awards, including SF Giants' 2023 MiLB.com Organization All-Star.
