AROUND THE HORN

FOURTH LARGEST D-BACKS GIVE BACK 50/50 RAFFLE: Last night's D-backs Give Back 50/50 Raffle total of \$340,281 was the fourth largest all-time: 1. June 15, 2025 (Father's Day): \$560,331 | 2. Aug. 10, 2024 (Replica NL Champs Ring Giveaway): \$451,093 | 3. July 4, 2025 (Independence Day): \$397,476 | 4. March 30, 2026 (Home Opener): \$340,281

\$100 MILLION IN GIVING: The D-backs and Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation have earned a place among professional sports' most impactful philanthropic organizations in fewer than three decades, reaching a historic milestone of \$100 Million In Giving through their signature "D-backs Give Back" approach and investment in communities across Arizona...March 9 will forever be celebrated annually as "D-backs Give Back Day" as proclaimed by Arizona Governor Katie Hobbs ensuring the organization's longstanding statewide commitment will be recognized each year.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs have scored first in each of their first 4 games to start the season, the Majors' longest active streak, longest since the Orioles' 5 straight from March 27-21, 2025 and tied for the second longest in franchise history (also: March 28-31, 2024)...the D-backs longest streak to start a season is 6 games (2x - April 4-9, 2000 and April 3-9, 2006).

- The D-backs have scored 2+ runs within the first 3.0 innings in 3 straight games, tied for the Majors' longest active streak (also: Rangers).
- Corbin Carroll**, in 10 career games vs. Tigers, is hitting .341 (14-for-41)/1.264 OPS, with 3 doubles, 5 triples, 3 homers, 10 RBI and 3 walks.
- Brandon Pfaadt** makes his season debut today...in his last 8 home starts, since July 18, 2025, has gone 4-0 with a 2.29 ERA (13 ER in 51.0 IP), opponent .215 AVG, 9 walks and 40 strikeouts.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 9-6 in their home opener vs. Tigers last night in front of a sellout crowd of 48,350.

- Michael Soroka** earned the win in his D-back debut after a 5.0-shutout-inning, career-high-tying 10-strikeout performance, which included an immaculate inning in the fifth.
 - His 10 strikeouts were the most by a pitcher in a D-backs debut, surpassing Randy Johnson's 9 on April 5, 1999 @ Dodgers.
 - Fourth D-back all-time with an immaculate inning (second occurrence @ Chase Field), joining Randy Johnson (Aug. 23, 2001 @ Pirates, sixth inning), Byung-Hyun Kim (May 11, 2002 @ Phillies, eighth inning) and Wade Miley (Oct. 1, 2012 vs. Rockies, third inning).
 - Third D-back pitcher with a start of 10+ strikeouts with an immaculate inning (also: Miley and Johnson)...first MLB pitcher to do so since Ryan Peipot/TB on Sept. 18, 2024 (12 K, immaculate fifth).
- Corbin Carroll** logged his first multi-hit game with 1 triple, 1 homer, 4 RBI and 1 walk...became the second player in D-backs history with a triple and a homer within the first 2.0 innings of a game (also: Conor Jackson on April 18, 2008 vs. Padres).
 - Was his first career game reaching each of those feats in a game and first D-back to do so since Daulton Varsho on Aug. 22, 2021 @ Rockies (1 3B, 1 HR, 1 BB, 4 RBI).
- Ildemaro Vargas** went 2-for-4 with 1 homer and 1 RBI...was his first solo homer since Aug. 28, 2022 vs. Reds with the Nationals after hitting 8 consecutive homers with men on base from May 21, 2023-Sept. 5, 2025.

PERDOMO'S ON-BASE STREAK: **Geraldo Perdomo's** 21-game on-base streak dating back to Sept. 9, 2025 is the Majors' second longest active on-base streak, behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (35 since Aug. 24, 2025).

- Has hit safely in 19 of those 21 games, hitting .338 (27-for-80)/1.042 OPS with 7 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 11 RBI and 12 walks (12 strikeouts).

FERNANDEZ'S DEBUT: **Jose Fernandez** (age 22-189) is the youngest Venezuelan-born position player to debut for the D-backs... also: C Jose Herrera (25-044 on April 9, 2022 vs. Padres), 2B **Ildemaro Vargas** (25-348 on June 29, 2017 vs. Cardinals), C Miguel Montero (23-059 on Sept. 6, 2006 @ Marlins) and PH-1B Alex Cabrera (28-185 on June 26, 2000 vs. Astros) [source: Elias Sports Bureau]. - His 11 extra-base hits (3 2B, 5 3B, 3 HR) vs. Tigers are most against an AL team and fifth most vs. any team with Braves, Phillies and Nationals, behind Giants (12), Rockies (16), Padres (21) and Dodgers (22).

- In 2025 with the Royals, went 1-1 with 1 save, a 3.25 ERA (20 ER in 55.1 IP), 0.85 WHIP, opponent .194 AVG, 9 walks and 44 strikeouts in 51 games...posted career highs in scoreless outings (40), WHIP (0.85) and opponent AVG (.194).
- In 2025, was 1 of 2 pitchers with 50+ appearances and 9 or fewer walks (also: Tyler Rogers/SF-NYM, 81 G/7 BB).
- Made 50+ appearances in each of his last 2 seasons in 2023 and 2025 (did not appear in the Majors in 2024 due to injury).
