AROUND THE HORN

PRESIDENT'S CIRCLE GRANTS: During a special pregame ceremony last Friday, **Derrick Hall** and the Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation celebrated the 63 Arizona nonprofits awarded with \$309,000 in Derrick Hall President's Circle Grants at the end of 2025... established in 1998 and renamed in 2024 in honor of Derrick Hall, whose long-standing leadership has helped expand the club's statewide community impact, the program has awarded a total of \$7.3 million in grants.

HERE'S THE STORY: D-backs starters have allowed 1 or fewer runs in 5 of the last 6 games and own a MLB-best 1.74 ERA in that span, ahead of the Athletics (2.12), Blue Jays (2.12) and Pirates (2.19).

- In the span, the rotation ranks among MLB leaders in quality starts (1st, 5), innings (1st, 41.1), innings/GM (1st, 7.0), opponent AVG (2nd, .164), OBP (2nd, .242), WHIP (2nd, 0.92) and OPS (3rd, .537)
- The D-backs will look to win their fourth consecutive series vs. Rangers since Sept. 10, 2024 (6-2).
- The D-backs have won or split 5 of their 6 series vs. Rangers (9-5) since 2023.
- The D-backs are 14-4 (.778) when leading after 5.0 innings, including 5-3 (.625) on the road.

RECORD BOOKS WATCH: **Ketel Marte** tonight will tie Paul Goldschmidt (1,092) for second most games played in franchise history, behind Luis Gonzalez (1,194).

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 5-1 vs. Mets yesterday in the series rubber match behind **Eduardo Rodriguez's** career-high 8.1-inning performance, including his third-longest no-hit bid of 5.1 innings (W, 1 ER, 4 H, 3 BB, 4 K).

- Rodriguez's** 46 pitches were the fewest by a D-back starter thru the first 5.0 innings since Barry Enright on Sept. 1, 2010 vs. Padres (42)... is the first D-back starter with 50 pitches or fewer thru the first 5.0 innings since Brandon Pfaadt (50 on June 19, 2024 @ Nationals).
- Ryan Waldschmidt** recorded his first career multi-hit game and RBI, going 2-for-4 with 1 double and 3 RBI.
- Ketel Marte** had a 2-run triple in the sixth inning.
- Juan Morillo** (0.2 IP) extended his MLB-leading 17-game active home scoreless streak after recording the final 2 outs of the game.

LOGGING INNINGS: D-backs starters have logged 6 straight starts of 6.0+-innings, the longest active streak in the Majors, for the first time since Sept. 1-7, 2025...the last time the D-backs recorded 7 straight was Aug. 2-9, 2017.

For the first time since July 5-12, 2019, D-backs pitchers have posted 3+ consecutive starts of 6.0+ innings, 1 or fewer runs and 4 or fewer hits.

All-time, the D-backs have recorded 4 such streaks of 4 straight games (June 1-5, 2009; July 23-26, 2015; Sept. 3-6, 2017; July 5-12, 2019).

ROLLIN' NOLAN: **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 15 of his last 16 starts, hitting .360 (18-for-50)/1.047 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 7 RBI and 9 walks, including 7 games reaching base 2+ times.

- Since April 21, ranks among MLB third basemen [min. 50 PA] in OBP (1st, .459), OPS (2nd, 1.028), runs (T-3rd, 12), AVG (3rd, .353), SLG (4th, .569), hits (T-5th, 18) and homers (T-5th, 3).

ROAD SNAKES: **Ildemaro Vargas** has hit safely in 13 of his 14 road games at a .373 clip (22-for-59)/.895 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer, 5 RBI and 3 walks.

- Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has hit safely in his last 4 road games at a .467 clip (7-for-15)/1.033 OPS with 1 double, 1 RBI and 1 walk, including multi-hits in 3.
- Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base in his last 7 road games, hitting .308 (8-for-26)/.862 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 3 RBI and 4 walks, including multi-hits in 3.

¡BRAVO MORILLO! **Juan Morillo** has allowed 1 run over his last 10 games, going 1-0 with 1 save, a 0.84 ERA (1 ER in 10.2 IP), opponent .111 AVG, 0.47 WHIP, 1 walk and 14 strikeouts.

- Has not allowed a hit or walk to a righty in his last 8 games (0-for-12, 14 BF) with 3 strikeouts.

PEN SPOTLIGHT: In their last 9 games, since May 1, the D-backs own a NL-best 1.50 ERA (5 R-4 ER in 24.0 IP), ahead of the Padres (1.55) and Dodgers (1.74)...rank second in MLB to the Rays (0.51).

- In their last 9 games, the D-backs' bullpen owns a MLB-best opponent .127 AVG (10-for-79)/.426 OPS and 0.75 WHIP with 8 walks and 19 strikeouts.

VS. RANGERS: The D-backs are 9-5 in their last 14 matchups and have won 3 straight series, including their last on the road from Aug. 11-13, 2025 (2-1)...are 8-6 in their last 14 games @ Rangers.

Ketel Marte has homered in 5 of his last 7 games, including 4 straight from Aug. 12-Sept. 2, 2025.

- Has reached base in his last 7 games, hitting .414 (12-for-29)/1.469 OPS with 2 doubles, 5 homers, 14 RBI and 2 walks, including 4 multi-hits.

Gerardo Perdomo is hitting a career .350 (14-for-40)/1.045 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers, 6 RBI and 3 walks in 12 games, including hits in 11 games.

Corbin Carroll has reached base safely in 8 of his last 9 games, hitting .289 (11-for-38)/.868 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 4 RBI and 2 walks.

Gabriel Moreno has reached base safely in his last 6 games, hitting .368 (7-for-19)/.874 OPS with 2 doubles and 3 RBI and 1 walk.

Took the loss in a 4-2 defeat on May 7 vs. Pirates (L, 4 ER in 6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 BB, 5 K).

In 6 career starts vs. Rangers, is 3-1 with a 2.67 ERA (10 ER in 33.2 IP), 6 walks and 38 strikeouts.
