The Washington Nationals close out the 2026 season on Sunday afternoon against the New York Mets, looking for the series victory in the rubber match.

- The Nationals have won nine of their last 13 games overall and are 12-6 (.667) at home since Aug. 13.
- Washington's 76 wins this season are its most since 2019 (93 wins)...The Nationals secured their 38th road victory on Wednesday, the most in a season since the 2019 Nationals won 43 road games.

The Nationals announced the winners of the Club's 11th annual end-of-season awards, as voted on by members of the local media, on Saturday.

- **National League All-Star James Wood** was named Player of the Year for the second consecutive season
- **Cade Cavalli** was unanimously named the Pitcher of the Year, his first such award.
- **Nasim Nuñez** and **Jacob Young** were named winners of the Good Guy Award, presented to a player for his always-professional dealings with members of the media, his work in the community and for representing the Nationals organization with class both on and off the field....It is the first time in the history of the awards that two players tied in a category.

Entering the last game of the season, Washington has a +4 run differential (815 runs scored/811 runs allowed)...For comparison, the 2025 Nationals had a -212 run differential (687 runs scored/899 runs allowed).

- According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, the +216 improvement from last season to this season is second in MLB behind Colorado (+234 improvement) this season and the +216 improvement is the best season-to-season improvement in Nationals history (2005-pres.)
- The Nationals also sit on a 10-game win improvement over 2025...It's tied for the fifth-best improvement in Major League Baseball behind the White Sox (23 wins), Rays (21 wins), Braves (18 wins), Rockies (15 wins) and tied with the Pirates (10 wins).

CJ Abrams is just the third shortstop in Major League history to record a season with at least 30 home runs, 30 stolen bases and 100 RBI, joining **Bobby Witt Jr.** (2024) and **Alex Rodriguez** (1998).

- Abrams and **Alfonso Soriano** (40 HR/41 SB in 2006) are the only two players in Nationals history with at least 30 HR and 30 SB in a season...Only Abrams, **Pete Crow-Armstrong** and **Elly De La Cruz** have reached the 30/30 mark in MLB this season.
- His 105 RBI this season are tied for sixth-most in a season in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...Next on the list is **Ryan Zimmerman's** 106 RBI in 2009.
- Also of note, Abrams leads Major League Baseball with an 86% ABS Challenge success rate (min. 10 challenges)...He is 12-for-14 in ABS Challenges this season.

The Nationals have 16 players with at least one save this season, the second-most for a team in Major League Baseball history behind the 2025 Arizona Diamondbacks (17).

- **Clayton Beeter** (12), **Gus Varland** (6), **Richard Lovelady** (4), **Erik Tolman** (4), **Andrew Alvarez** (1), **Tom Cosgrove** (1), **Yovanny Cruz** (1), **Will Dion** (1), **Josiah Gray** (1), **Justin Lawrence** (1), **Brad Lord** (1), **Mitchell Parker** (1), **PJ Poulin** (3), **Orlando Ribalta** (1), **Paxton Schultz** (1) and **Jack Sinclair** (1) have all recorded saves this year.

In 29 games since Aug. 19, **Simon Mathews'** starting pitchers/openers rank in MLB in opponents' average (1st, .205), home runs allowed (1st, 13), opponents' slugging (1st, .328), opponents' OPS (3rd, .627) and ERA (4th, 3.11).

James Wood is the first player in Major League history to hit 30 home runs, steal 20 bases and walk 100 times while playing in less than 140 games in a season.

- He is just the 10th player to accomplish the feat in any number of games, joining **Shohei Ohtani** (2025), **Juan Soto** (2025), **Paul Goldschmidt** (2015), **Bobby Abreu** (2001, '04), HOF **Jeff Bagwell** (1996-97, '99), HOF **Chipper Jones** (1999), **Barry Bonds** (1992-93, '95-'98), HOF **Mike Schmidt** (1974-75) and **Jimmy Wynn** (1969).
- Wood (105 R, 101 BB), **Yordan Alvarez** (102 R, 109 BB) and Miguel Vargas (106 R, 101 BB) are the only three players in MLB with at least 100 runs and 100 walks this season.

CJ Abrams and **James Wood** are just the fifth pair of teammates in MLB history to record 30 home runs, 30 doubles and 20 stolen bases in the same season, joining **Francisco Lindor/José Ramírez** (CLE, 2018), **Carlos Beltrán/David Wright** (NYM, 2007), **Ken Griffey Jr./Alex Rodriguez** (SEA, 1998) and **Ellis Burks/Dante Bichette** (COL, 1996).

CJ Abrams (33 HR, 105 RBI) and **Daylen Lile** (22 HR, 89 RBI) have both eclipsed the 20 HR/80 RBI mark this year, while **James Wood** (30 HR, 77 RBI) is close to joining them.

- There are only 13 players in MLB age 25 and younger to hit the 20/80 mark this season and Washington is the only team with more than one player in that group...With four more RBI, **James Wood** joins the club.
- If Wood reaches the 80 RBI mark, the 2026 Nationals would become the eighth team in Major League history with at least three players age 25 and younger to record a 20/80 season.
- The last team to do so was the 2007 Milwaukee Brewers, who hold the record with four (**Ryan Braun**, **Prince Fielder**, **J.J. Hardy**, **Corey Hart**)...The last team to have three was the 1999 Kansas City Royals (**Carlos Beltrán**, **Jermaine Dye**, **Mike Sweeney**).
