TRANSACTIONS: The Reds today recalled from AAA-Louisville **OF Rece Hinds**.
 • Following Sun's game vs **LAA**, optioned to Louisville **OF Noelvi Marte**.
 • Yesterday, traded **INF Christian Encarnacion-Strand** to the **Orioles** in exchange for cash considerations...**Encarnacion-Strand** was designated for assignment by the Reds on 4/8.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs **2025 Robert O. Fishel Award-winner Matt Chisholm's Giants** and the fourth game (1-2) of a 7-day/6-game homestand that includes a 1-2 series loss vs **LAA** (Fri-Sun).
 • The Reds are coming off their first series loss to the **Angels** since 2016.
 • Following Thu's game vs **SF**, the Reds will head back on the road for a 6-game trip at **Min** (3g, 4/17-4/19) and **TB** (3g, 4/20-4/22).

SWITCH BLADE: **SS Elly De La Cruz** has homered 4 times in 22 at-bats this season vs left-handed pitchers (.318/.348/.909), including Sun off **LAA's Drew Pomeranz**...in 2025, he hit 5 HR in 199 at-bats vs LHP (.236/.276/.342).

OUR PAL SAL: **1b Sal Stewart** has hit safely in 12 of his 16 games this season and reached base in 15 of 16 (16-for-47, .309/.435/.600)...he's been on base 30 times, which ranks T9th in the majors.
 • **Stewart** ranks among Major League leaders in OPS (1.135, 9th).

WINS/RUNS: The Reds have won 9 of their first 16 games despite ranking T27th in the majors with 54 runs scored (**CWS** 49, **SF** 51, **KC** 54).

- 7 of Cin's 9 wins this season have come in games decided by 2 runs or fewer, the most such wins in the majors this year.
- The 2025 Reds went 35-38 (.479) in games decided by 2 runs or fewer, the ninth-worst record in the majors.
- The Reds have been *held* to 2 runs or fewer 7 times already this season, T6th in the majors.
- The Reds plated a season-high 7 runs in Sat's 15th game of the season, marking the second-longest wait in franchise history for Cin to produce its first 7-run game...the 2022 Reds didn't score 7 or more runs until their 26th game (5/7g1, 9-2 win vs Pit).

MISSED OPPORTUNITIES: Cin batters rank T3rd in the majors with 127 runners left on base...the Reds are 1 of 5 teams in the majors to have stranded at least 10 runners on 5 different occasions (**Sea** 6, **LAA** 6, **Chc** 5, **Pit** 5).

- With runners in scoring position Cin is slashing .173/.305/.307...rank last w/RISP in batting average while ranking near the bottom in hits (22, T29th), RBI (31, T29th), SLG (.307, 28th), OPS (.612, 28th) and runs scored (39, T27th).

STEER, THERE, EVERYWHERE: **OF/INF Spencer Steer** on Sat vs **LAA** made his 150th career start in the outfield (LF), becoming the fifth Red since 1900 to make at least 150 starts in both the infield (305) and outfield.

SERIES NOTES: The Reds went 1-2 vs **SF** at **Great American Ball Park** to open the 2025 season (3/27-3/30) and 2-1 at **Oracle Park** from 4/7-4/9.

- The Reds shut out the **Giants** on 4/7 and 4/8...it marked the first time Cin blanked the same opponent in consecutive games since 7/3-7/4, 2019 vs **Mil**, and the first time on the road since 7/28-7/29, 2015 at **StL**.
- Beginning with the 2008 season, the Reds are 61-51 (.545) vs **SF**, the best winning percentage of any Giants opponent since then (min 25g).
- Beginning 6/29/12 and including the 2012 National League Division Series, the Redlegs have won 25 of 44 meetings at **Oracle Park**.

EL CABALLO DE HIERRO: **SS Elly De La Cruz** has appeared in each of Cin's last 234 games, beginning 7/30/24...it's the fifth-longest consecutive games played streak by a Red since 1970 (see box below).

NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM: The Reds have avoided being swept in 34 consecutive home series (min. 1g) dating back to 2024, including the recently-completed series vs **LAA**...it's the longest such streak since 9/19/11-9/25/13 when the Reds avoided being swept at **Great American Ball Park** in a franchise-record 52 consecutive home series.

- The Reds avoided being swept in all 26 of their series last year at **GABP**...only the Cin teams of 1940, 1943, 1944, 1994, and 2012 ran the home schedule without being broomed.

SUDDEN SAM: **LHP Sam Moll** has opened the 2026 season by not allowing a hit to any of his first 35 batters...it's the longest such hitless streak by a Reds pitcher to open a season since 1961.

- **Moll's** 8 consecutive hitless relief apps ranks as the second-longest streak by a Reds pitcher to open a season since 1900 (**John Franco** 11g, 1987).

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the 7-4 loss on 4/8 at Mia (2.2ip, 10h, 6r/5er, 0bb, 3k, 1hr, 73TP).

- Was his shortest outing since 7/21/25 at Wsh (2.1ip).
- Allowed 10 hits for the first time since 8/24/24 for KC vs Phi (11h, 5.0ip).
- Allowed 10 of his 17 batters to reach.
- Was lifted in the 3rd inning after Leo Jimenez followed Griffin Conine's 2-run homer with a 2-out single.

APRIL 3 at TEX: Did not factor in the decision in the 5-3 win at Tex on 4/3 (5.0ip, 6h, 2r/2er, 1bb, 5k, 0hr, 87TP).

- After allowing a pair of 2-out runs and 4 hits in the 2nd inning, proceeded to scatter 2 hits over his final 3.1 innings.
- Was struck in the right leg on a 107mph Corey Seager grounder in the 5th inning but recovered to make an outstanding sliding play to throw out Seager at first... remained in the game.

MARCH 28 vs BOS: Did not factor in the decision in the 11-inning 6-5 win vs Bos on 3/28 (4.0ip, 5h, 3r/3er, 2bb, 5k, 1hr, 74 TP).

- Left the game after 4 innings with the Reds leading 4-3.
- Was originally slated to start the season's third game but was moved up in the rotation when Nick Lodolo was placed on the injured list.

2026 SPRING TRAINING: Went 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA in 5 spring starts (16.2ip, 11r/10er, 8bb, 12k, 292 TP).

- In his final Spring Training start on 3/23 vs the Brewers in Milwaukee, allowed 6 runs (5er) on 6 hits over 4.0 innings (1bb, 3k, 1hr, 78TP).
- Exited his second-to-last spring appearance after 51 pitches due to a blister on his right finger (3/18 vs Col).

2025 RECAP: In his first season with the Reds, led the staff with 32 starts, 14 wins, 169.2 innings pitched, and 15 quality starts...produced a quality start in a career-high 6 straight outings from 8/12 to 9/12.

- His 14 wins were a career high and tied for the fourth-most in the National League...were the most wins by a Reds pitcher since Luis Castillo won 15 games in 2019.
- Over his final 12 starts (7/27-9/28), pitched to a 7-4 record with a 2.81 ERA.
- Received votes for the Rawlings Gold Glove Award for the second consecutive season.

ACQUIRED: From the Royals on 11/22/24 in exchange for INF Jonathan India and OF Joey Wiemer.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the 8-1 loss on Thu 4/9 at Mia (5.1ip, 8h, 5r/4er, 2bb, 2k, 95 TP).

- Allowed 5 runs, 4 extra-base hits, 9 hard-hit balls (95+ mph EV), 10 base runners, and 22 balls in play - all career highs.
- Was ahead in the count to just 6 of his 26 batters.
- Pitched into the 6th inning (3 BF, 2h, groundout) before turning it over to reliever Brock Burke, who retired both batters he faced...left trailing 5-1.

APRIL 4 at TEX: Earned the 2-0 win on Sat at Tex (6.0ip, 3h, 0r/0er, 2bb, 4k, 82TP).

- Was his first win since 9/21/24 vs Pit and his second career quality start (9/5/24 vs Hou).
- Of his 8 career starts, was his fifth in which he pitched at least 5.0 scoreless innings...ties him with Fernando Valenzuela (1981) for the most such outings through his first 8 career starts by any Major League pitcher since 1900.
- His 1.30 ERA after 8 career starts became the fifth-lowest by any Major Leaguer (min. 4ip/start) in that span, and the lowest since Valenzuela's 0.50 in 1981.
- Became the fourth Reds pitcher since the mound moved to its current distance in 1893 to allow 6 hits or fewer in each of his first 8 career starts, joining Tony Cingrani (2013-2014), Scott Williamson (2000), and Rob Bell (2000).
