AT HOME: The Brewers are 7-7 at home, going 2-2-1 in series play.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff....

Rickie Weeks (associate manager), **Daniel de Mondesert** (assistant coach) and **Charlie Greene** (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made seven replay challenges this season, going 5-2....their last challenge came on 5/6 at Kansas City as an out call at third base involving Jackson Chourio on a stolen base attempt stood.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #48 - RHP COLIN REA (6gs, 3-0, 2.67)

REA AT A GLANCE: Colin Rea, 33, will be making his seventh start....Rea last started last Wednesday vs. Tampa Bay in a 7-1 win (6ip, 4h, 0r, 2bb, 5k, 99 pitches)....he recorded his highest pitch count since throwing 103 pitches with the Padres on 7/25/16 at Toronto....the team is 5-1 in his starts....has made 2 quality starts....opponents are batting .227 (30-for-132, 5hr)....Rea is signed through the 2024 season with a club option for 2025....name is pronounced "RAY."

LAST SEASON: Rea went 6-6 with a 4.55 ERA in 26 games/22 starts during five stints with Milwaukee last season....the team went 14-8 in his starts....he had 4 quality starts....opponents batted .235 (110-for-468, 23hr)....he set career highs in wins (6), games (26), starts (22), innings pitched (124.2) and strikeouts (110).

CAREER: Is 17-14 with a 4.52 ERA in 68 games/55 starts (312.2ip, 157er)....has pitched in the majors for San Diego (2015-16), Miami (2016), Chicago-NL (2020) and Milwaukee (2021, '23-24)....is 15-13 with a 4.59 ERA as a starter (286ip, 146er) and 2-1 with a 3.71 ERA as a reliever (26.2ip, 11er)....Rea was selected by San Diego in the 12th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Indiana State University....he underwent "Tommy John" surgery on 11/11/16, causing him to miss the entire 2017 season....Rea also pitched in Japan with the Fukuoka SoftBank Hawks in 2021 and 2022.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 4-4 with a 4.41 ERA in 18 games/15 starts (83.2ip, 41er)....is 2-0 with a 3.00 ERA in 3 starts this season (18ip, 6er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 8-6 with a 4.52 ERA in 30 games/22 starts (135.1p, 68er)....is 1-0 with a 2.30 ERA in 3 starts this season (15.2ip, 4er).

CAREER vs. ROYALS: Is 0-0 with a 7.71 ERA in 2 games/1 start (4.2ip, 6h, 4r, 4er, 2bb, 5k, 1hr)....his first outing came in relief with the Cubs on 8/5/20 at Kauffman Stadium (1ip, 2k)....his second appearance came in a start last season on 5/14 at American Family Field as he had no decision in a 9-6 win (3.2ip, 6h, 4r, 4er, 2bb, 3k, 1hr).
