PITTSBURGH PIRATES (58-97) vs. CINCINNATI REDS (81-75) September 27, 2021 at Great American Ball Park, Cincinnati, OH -- GAME #156/ROAD #81 RHP CONNOR OVERTON (0-0, 2.51 ERA) vs. LHP REIVER SANMARTIN (MLB Debut)

THE PIRATES... snapped their three-game losing streak with a 6-0 win in Philadelphia Sunday afternoon...Have gone 8-7 in their last 15 games and 10-8 in their last 18...Have gone 16-18 in their last 34 games after losing 13-for-14...Collected a season-high 19 hits and 14 runs against the Brewers on 8/14 (game 1)...Have won a season-high three straight games on four occasions (last time from 7/11-17).

LET'S MAKE UP: Today the Pirates and Reds are making up their rained out game from last Wednesday...The Bucs have won three of the last five meetings between the two clubs after losing nine of the first 10...Pittsburgh's 6-2 win last Tuesday snapped a 13-game losing streak in Cincinnati...A victory this afternoon would give the Pirates back-to-back wins at Great American Ball Park for the first time since doing so in 2019 on March 31 and May 27.

ON THE BUMP: Connor Overton is making his fifth appearance with the Pirates this afternoon, his third against the Reds...He made his first big league start against Cincinnati on 9/16 at PNC Park and threw 3.0 scoreless innings (42 pitches/31 strikes)...He also tossed a 1-2-3 inning of relief last Monday night at Great American Ball Park...Overton did not allow a run in the first 13.2 innings of his big league career before allowing four runs as a starter in 2.2ip Thursday in Philadelphia...Connor also had a two-run single off Aaron Nola in his first career plate appearance on Thursday.

END OF THE ROAD: The Pirates are playing their final road game of the 2021 season today...Today also brings an end to the longest road trip of the season; a 10-game, 11-day trip to Miami (2-1), Cincinnati (1-1) and Philadelphia (1-3).

THE FINAL STAND: The Bucs will close out the season with a six-game homestand against the Cubs and Reds starting tomorrow night...The Pirates have gone 6-3 in their last nine games played at PNC Park and 10-6 in their last 16...They have also gone 4-0-1 in their last five series played on their home turf and are 34-41 overall at PNC Park this season.

HOT COLE: Cole Tucker reached base safely four times in five plate appearances Sunday and has hit safely in seven of his last nine games (11-for-30, .367)...Tucker hit the first pitch of the game Sunday for a home run - his second career homer leading off the first inning and his first big league home run since leading off the game on 8/3/20 at Minnesota with a homer.

PIRATES GOLD: Bryan Reynolds has played the most innings (1092.2) in center field among all National League players and has also had the most chances (316) at that position this season...His .948 zone rating is the best among all center fielders in the Majors...Kevin Newman, who began the season with an N.L.-record 76-game errorless streak, leads all Major League shortstops in fielding percentage (.993), making just three errors in 128 games (436 TC)...According to FanGraphs, Bucco catcher Jacob Stallings leads all Major League players with 21 Defensive Runs Saved...Stallings is also the only catcher without a passed ball among those with at least 500 innings caught.

61 BUCS: A total of 61 different players have appeared in at least one game for the Pirates in 2021, a club record for most players used in one season (previous mark was 55 players in 2016)...In addition, there has been a club-record 36 different players who have pitched in at least one game in 2021 (previous mark of 34 was established in 2019).

MINOR MATTERS: The Greensboro Grasshoppers beat the Bowling Green Hot Rods (Tampa Bays Rays affiliate), 6-5, last night and now lead their best-of-five High-A East Championship Series, two-games-to-one...Game 4 is scheduled for tonight in Bowling Green at 7:35 EDT...The Bradenton Marauders captured the Low-A Southeast title Friday night with a sweep of the Tampa Tarpon in their best-of-five series.

COMING THRU IN A PINCH: Wilmer Difo connected for his third pinch-hit home run of the season Friday night and the ninth of the season by the Pirates - the most by the club since 2019 (10)...Difo ranks second among Major League players with 15 pinch-hits this season, the most by a Pirates player since Delwyn Young had 16 in 2010...As a team, the Pirates rank seventh in MLB with 54 pinch hits, tied for sixth in pinch-hit RBI (35) and are fifth with nine pinch-hit home runs.

SEPTEMBER REIGN: Ke'Bryan Hayes is hitting .312 (24-for-77) in 18 games played this month and holds a career average of .346 during the month of September...In his 42 career games played during the season's final month, Hayes has gone 56-for-162 with 11 doubles, two triples, six home runs and 21 RBI...Among all National League players with at least 150 at bats in September of last season and 2021, Hayes' .346 average ranks second behind Freddie Freeman (.356).

ON THE MEND: Infielder/outfielder Michael Chavis is currently on a rehab assignment with Triple-A Indianapolis; he homered Saturday and Sunday and has gone 10-for-28 (.357) with three homers and eight RBI in eight games...Chavis has been on the 10-day injured list since 8/31 (retro to 8/29) with a right elbow strain.

THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE: The Pirates have gone six straight games and 54 innings without an error and enter today's tilt with the second-best fielding percentage in the N.L. (.988) and the fourth-best in all of baseball...Dating back to 5/9, the Pirates have made the fewest amount of errors in the Majors (43).

STRATTON HIS STUFF: Chris Stratton has made a career-high 65 appearances and ranks fifth among all National League relief pitchers with 76.1 innings pitched this season...His 106.1 innings pitched over the last two seasons are tied with Chad Green for the most among all Major League relievers.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

September 27, 1970: In front of 50,469 fans, the Pirates clinched the National League East Division title with a 2-1 victory over the Mets at Three Rivers Stadium. Dock Ellis was the winning pitcher and Dave Giusti notched his 26th save as the Pirates swept the three-game series from New York. Roberto Clemente and Richie Hebner had two hits apiece for the Bucs.

MITCH KELLER: The 25-year-old righthander will be making his 22nd start of the season tomorrow night... His last start was a 6-2 victory over the Reds in Cincinnati last Tuesday (5.2ip/7h/2r/2er/4bb/2so)...Has gone 3-5 with a 4.86 ERA (46.1ip/25er) in nine starts since being recalled on 7/31...Went 1-1 with a 3.21 ERA (28.0ip/10er) in eight appearances (six starts) with Triple-A Indianapolis after being optioned there on 6/12...Has gone 2-1 in his last six starts after losing four straight and seven of his eight previous decisions.
