### New York City

The Braves welcome the Mets to Truist Park for three games this week, the last scheduled games for Atlanta versus teams from New York City this season.

In 13 total games against the Mets and Yankees this season, Atlanta is 11-2 and has outscored them, 100-45 (+53).

Seven of the 13 total games have come in the last 10 days, and Atlanta went 6-1 in those seven games. The Braves went 3-1 at Citi Field in Queens last weekend, and swept the Yankees at Truist Park last week.

The Braves also took two-of-three from San Francisco this weekend. The Giants were founded in 1883 as the New York Gothams in Manhattan before moving to California in 1957.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Mets tonight open a three-game series with what is the 11th of 13 games between the teams this season...The two last met just eight days ago in the conclusion of a four-game set at Citi Field.

- A** Atlanta is 8-2 in 10 games with New York this season...The Braves have won 14 of the last 17 games with New York dating to last season, outscoring the Mets 124-61 (+63) over the stretch.
- A** The Braves went 10-9 against the Mets last season, taking the season set from their N.L. East rivals for the fifth consecutive season...They also went 10-9 in 2021, 7-3 in 2020, 11-8 in 2019 and 13-6 in 2018...Since the start of the 2018 season, Atlanta is 59-37 (.623) against New York overall.
- A** Atlanta swept the only three games between the teams at Truist Park this season, June 6-8, and has won seven straight with New York at home dating to last season...Since Truist Park opened in 2017, the Braves are 33-22 (.600) against the Mets here.
- A** RH Allan Winans is set to make just the third start of his major league career but his second against New York, as the 6-foot-2, 165-pound right-hander pitched 7.0 scoreless innings in Game 1 of a doubleheader with the Mets last weekend...He earned his first career win in the start...In two total turns with Atlanta this season, he has allowed just two earned runs in 11.1 innings.
- A** LH David Peterson has made nine appearances and eight total starts in his career against Atlanta, going 3-4 with a 4.83 ERA (22 ER/41.0 IP)...In his only such start this season, April 28, he allowed five hits and four runs over 5.0 innings in a rain-shortened, complete-game loss...The 6-foot-6, 240-pound native of Denver, CO, is 3-7 with a 5.45 ERA (44 ER/72.2 IP) in 20 games for the Mets this season.

**LOSS:** The Braves fell to the Giants, 4-3, yesterday afternoon to snap Atlanta's five-game winning streak...It was the Braves' first loss at Truist Park this month.

- A** Entering play, the Braves had won each of their first seven home games in the month of August, including the first five games of the current homestand...Despite the loss, Atlanta is 28-7 (.800) with a +109 run differential over its last 35 games at Truist Park, dating to May 28.
- A** Austin Riley's first-inning swipe of second base marked the 100th stolen base by Atlanta this season...It is the first time the club has recorded at least 100 stolen bases in a season since 2012 (101)...The only teams with active droughts of at least 10 seasons are San Francisco (2012), Minnesota (2012) and Baltimore (2007).
- A** Kirby Yates allowed a run in the top of the ninth to take the loss, his first of the season...He entered play 7-0, the most wins without a loss in the National League.
- A** Marcell Ozuna went 0-for-4 to snap his career high-tying 16-game hitting streak.

**PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** Eddie Rosario was named today by Major League Baseball as the National League Player of the Week, the second such honor of his career (August 12, 2017 with Minnesota)...He batted .458/.519/.917 during the week, with three homers and 10 RBI in seven games.

- A** Rosario hit a go-ahead, two-run home run in the eighth inning on Saturday night, his 19th of the season...He has homered three times on Atlanta's current homestand, also doing so on Monday and Wednesday vs. New York (AL).
- A** Rosario is the franchise-record sixth different Braves player to earn Player of the Week honors this season, tying the single-season record across baseball since the award was first introduced in 1973...He joins Sean Murphy (May 6), Michael Harris II (June 17), Ronald Acuña Jr. (July 1), Austin Riley (July 22) and Matt Olson (August 12) as winners.
- A** The Braves are the seventh team to ever have six different players earn the award in a single season, and the first since the 2007 Red Sox.
- A** Six of Atlanta's nine regulars have been named N.L. Player of the Week this season, including the entire starting outfield...No other N.L. team has more than three individual winners this season (Cincinnati).
- A** Research courtesy of MLB's JJ Michalski.

**HEART & HUSTLE:** 3B Austin Riley tonight is being honored as Atlanta's Heart & Hustle winner for the 2023 season...The Heart & Hustle Award recognizes one player on each major league team who demonstrates a passion for the game of baseball and best embodies the values, spirit and traditions of the game.

- A** Riley is batting .279/.338/.509 with an .847 OPS on the season, with 24 doubles, 29 homers and 77 RBI...His 4.3 bWAR is highest by a third baseman in baseball.
- A** He leads all primary N.L. third basemen in hits (137), homers (29, tied), runs (89) and OPS (.847), and his 77 RBI trail just the Cardinals' Nolan Arenado (85).
- A** Since his first full season in 2020, no other N.L. third baseman has more hits (529) or homers (108) than Riley.

**VERSUS LEFTIES:** Atlanta is set to face two left-handed starters this series, with David Peterson set to start tonight and José Quintana scheduled for Wednesday.

- A** Atlanta is 15-7 (.682) against left-handed starters this season, the best such record in the National League and behind just the Rays (16-7, .696) for best in baseball.
- A** The Braves' 22 starts against lefties are tied with the Yankees for the fewest in baseball.
- A** Atlanta as a team is batting .293/.357/.534 with an .891 OPS against left-handers this season, all of which are best in baseball.

#### Today's Game

- A* Set to make his third major league start and second against New York (NL).
- A* Earned his first win in his last start, scattering four hits and fanning nine hitters over 7.0 scoreless innings against the Mets.
- A* Winans became the first player in Braves franchise history (1901) to strikeout at least nine hitters without allowing a run over 7.0 innings pitched in one of his first two career appearances.
- A* Winans is now the 25th player to do so in major league history (1901), the first since Sixto Sánchez on August 28, 2020 with Miami, and he is the third oldest rookie on the list to do so...Joined Atlanta teammate Collin McHugh as one of the 25 players in baseball history to do so.
- A* He is one of nine pitchers in franchise history to toss at least 7.0 scoreless frames in one of his first two career outings and first since Larry McWilliams on July 17, 1978, which also happened in Game 1 of a doubleheader against the Mets.
- A* Made his debut on July 22 at Milwaukee.
- A* Gave up two runs over 4.1 innings pitched with five strikeouts.
- A* Was the fourth starter to make his debut with Atlanta this season.
- A* Went 8-3 with a 2.79 ERA in 15 starts and five relief appearances with Triple-A Gwinnett this year.
- A* Is 5-0 and pitching to a 2.35 ERA in eight starts and two relief appearances since the beginning of June.
- A* Went 3-3 while sporting a 3.31 ERA in April and May.
- A* Was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for July 3-9.
- A* Went 1-0 while scattering two hits through a combined 11.0 innings pitched of one-run ball with 13 strikeouts between a start and a relief appearance.
- A* Went 1-5 with a 3.08 ERA (22 ER in 64.1 IP), 1.18 WHIP, .239 BAA, and 9.09 SO/9.0 IP ratio across three levels in 2022.
- A* His season was cut short due to a right flexor injury.
- A* Is 8-8 with a 3.00 ERA in 30 appearances (24 starts) since joinin the Braves' organization.

- A* Selected by the Atlanta Braves in the 2021 Rule 5 Draft.
- A* He was originally the New York Mets' 17th-round pick (500) in 2018 out of Campbell University, NC.
- A* Was a member of the Campbell University Camels baseball team between 2016-18.
- A* Named the 2018 Big South Pitcher of the Year.
- A* Also named to the 2018 First Team All-Big South.
- A* Played at Frontier High School in Bakersfield, CA, earning a First Team All-Conference selection twice.

# Braves Bullpen Briefs

**Brad Hand • LHP • 6-3 • 224 • 33 yrs • #45**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0 **Holds:** 3 **1st Batter/Retired:** 46/26 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 22/5

- Has held left-handed hitters to a .183 BAA this season...Right-handers are batting .326.
- In his last 13 games overall, has pitched to a 3.00 ERA (4 ER/12.0 IP).
- Was acquired on August 1 prior to MLB's trade deadline in exchange for minor-league RHP Alec Barger.
- Pitching arsenal includes a sweeper (47.5%), four-seam fastball (33.9%) and a sinker (18.6%).
- Prior to joining the Braves, made 40 relief appearances for the Rockies this season, pitching to a 3-1 record and a 4.54 ERA (18 ER/35.2 IP)...He struck out 41 batters and walked 16.
- Has been selected to three All-Star teams: 2017, 2018 & 2019...Hand is in his 13th major league season.
- During the abbreviated 2020 season, he led baseball with 16 saves and paced the American League with 21 games finished.

**Raisel Iglesias • RHP • 6-2 • 190 • 33 yrs • #26**

**Saves/Opp:** 22/24 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 42/33 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- Across 20 games since June 25, has pitched to a 0.95 ERA (2 ER/19.0 IP), while going 13-for-13 in save opportunities... Since that date, is one of two MLB closers with at least 10 saves without erring (also Kenley Jansen, BOS).
- Since July 26, is one of three National League relievers with a 0.00 ERA and at least 10 outings.
- On May 10, allowed a home run for the first time since June 12, 2022 with the Angels – a homerless span of 45 games and 42.2 innings...It was the fifth-longest active homerless streak by a reliever in the majors.
- On May 5 was activated from the IL after missing Atlanta's first 32 games with a strained right shoulder...Pitched in four spring training games, compiling a 4.50 ERA (2 ER/4.0 IP) in four outings.
- In 2022, had a 2.47 ERA in 67 games with 17 saves and 15 holds between Atlanta and Los Angeles (AL)...After the trade deadline, led N.L. with a 41.7% chase rate (swings out of the zone)...Trailed only CLE's E. Clase.
- Allowed just one earned run in 28 relief appearances after becoming a member of the Braves...His 0.34 ERA during that span dating to the trade deadline is the lowest in baseball (min. 20 appearances).

**Joe Jiménez • RHP • 6-3 • 277 • 28 yrs • #77**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/1 **Holds:** 10 **1st Batter/Retired:** 45/33 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 16/8

- Has pitched to a 1.33 ERA (4 ER/27.0 IP) over his last 27 games, dating to May 27...Among National League relievers since that date, his ERA ranks fourth (min. 25 games).
- Pitched 62 games for DET last year, going 3-2 with a 3.49 ERA (22 ER/56.2 IP), striking out 77 and walking 13.
- Acquired from Detroit on Dec. 7, 2022 in exchange for OF Justyn-Henry Malloy and LHP Jake Higginbotham.
- Named to the A.L. All-Star team in 2018 during his first full major league campaign.
- Last season, his 12.23 strikeouts per 9.0 innings ranked fifth in the American League among pitchers with at least 50.0 innings, and his 1.4 fWAR for the season matched his career high.

**Pierce Johnson • RHP • 6-2 • 202 • 32 yrs • #76**

**Saves/Opp:** 13/15 **Holds:** 5 **1st Batter/Retired:** 54/33 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 9/2

- Hasn't allowed an earned run in 11 appearances since joining Atlanta...Across 11.1 innings, owns a 0.00 ERA with 13 strikeouts and three walks in that time.
- Since July 26, is one of three National League relievers with a 0.00 ERA and at least 10 outings.
- Across 23 games since June 21, has pitched to a 1.61 ERA (4 ER/22.1 IP).
- Pitching arsenal includes a curveball (56.3%), four-seam fastball (37.1%) and a slider (6.6%).
- Was acquired on July 24 from Colorado in exchange for pitchers RHP Tanner Gordon and RHP Victor Vodnik.
- Struck out 20 through 11.1 innings in June, a 15.88 SO/9 that led the National League and ranked second in the majors (min. 10 games).

**Collin McHugh • RHP • 6-2 • 190 • 34 yrs • #32**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0 **Holds:** 7 **1st Batter/Retired:** 37/27 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 32/8

- Out of his 32 inherited runners this season, only eight have scored (25.0%)...Among National League relievers with at least 30 inherited runners, that percentage ranks sixth.
- His 2.49 ERA over the past three combined seasons (since 2021) is the seventh lowest in baseball (min. 125 games).
- 2023 is his 11th MLB season...Finished 2022 with a 2.60 ERA and a 3-2 record in his first season with Atlanta.
- In 48 outings (59.0 IP) after May 6 last season, he pitched to a 1.98 ERA.
