THE GRAPEFRUIT GANG: The defending Grapefruit League champion St. Louis Cardinals will wear special green hats on St. Patrick's Day as they face the visiting Houston Astros at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium this afternoon ... One week from today, St. Louis will break camp in Florida and play the division-rival Chicago Cubs in a pair of Spring Training games (March 25-26) at Sloan Park in Mesa, Arizona before opening the 2024 regular season at the Los Angeles Dodgers (March 28-31).

HAPPY ST. PATRICK'S DAY: The Cardinals are 6-7-1 on St. Patrick's Day (3-2 in Jupiter) referencing Spring Training info dating back to 2006.

- Last season, the visiting Cardinals topped the Miami Marlins, 16-2, at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium thanks to a nine-run second inning.
- Since 2006, St. Louis and Houston have played once on St. Patrick's Day, a 4-4 tie in West Palm Beach in 2021.
- Today marks the first St. Patrick's Day holiday that St. Louis has been the home team since 2011.

SPRING BREAKOUT: The Cardinals play their 2nd Spring Breakout Game at 10 a.m. ET this morning against the Astros before St. Louis and Houston face off in Grapefruit League play.

- · The Cardinals and Reds are the only two MLB teams with two Spring Breakout games.
- · St. Louis is one of five MLB clubs that made all of their top 10 prospects available, with 26 of the Cardinals Top 30 prospects participating (MLB Pipeline).

### IN THE TRAINING ROOM:

- RHP Sonny Gray, who suffered a mild right hamstring strain on March 4, will pitch in a simulated pregame situation at the Cardinals Complex today.
- OF Lars Nootbaar has two non-displaced fractured ribs on his left side from colliding with an outfield wall.
- OF Tommy Edman (offseason right wrist surgery) and RHP Keynan Middleton (right forearm strain) are expected to begin the season on the Injured List.

CARDINALS MANAGER OLIVER MARMOL SIGNED THRU 2026: The Cardinals announced on Friday that the team has signed Manager Oliver "Oli" Marmol to a contract extension through the 2026 season.

- Marmol, 37, has piloted the team over the past two seasons (2022-23), earning an NL Central title in his first season with a Cardinals team that won 93 games.
- It was the team's first division title since 2019, and at age 36, Marmol became the youngest manager to lead his team to the postseason since 1948 when Lou Boudreau led Cleveland to a World Series title at age 31.

## TODAY'S PITCHERS

## #52 • Matthew Liberatore • LHP • 24 yrs

- Making his 5th appearance (4th start) of the Spring today.
- Made his Major League debut for the Cardinals in 2022 and has appeared in 31 games (18 starts).
- Major League debut came at PIT (5/21/22) at PNC Park tossing 4.2 innings in a no decision.
- Has held opposing left-handed batters to a .193 BA (16-83, HR) over his career, 2nd-lowest mark among Cardinals pitchers from 2022-23 with 95 or more batters faced (Ryan Helsley, .173).
- Started the second game of the 2023 London Series vs. CHI (6/25/23) after Jack Flaherty was a late scratch. Pitched 2.1 IP and did not factor into the decision as the Cardinals rallied for a 7-5 win.
- 2021 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

### #56 • Ryan Helsley • RHP • 29 yrs

- Making his 6th appearance of the season. Has allowed just two hits and no runs.
- Named a 2022 National League All-Star, voted as one of two relief pitchers to the All-MLB Second Team, and finished 12th in the NL Cy Young Award voting.
- Since the beginning of the 2022 season, ranks 2nd among qualified MLB relievers in ERA (1.69), average against (.145), opponent OBP (.229), opponent slugging (.247), opponent OPS (.476). baserunners/9 (7.82), hits/9 (4.44), and WHIP (0.86), and 3rd in strikeout pct. (37.9).
- Ranked 3rd among qualified 2022 MLB relievers in strikeout rate (39.3%) behind Edwin Diaz (50.2%) and Devin Williams (40.0%).LHP JoJo Romero.

### #59 • JoJo Romero • LHP • 27 yrs

- Making his 7th appearance of the spring.
- Has held left-handed batters to a .111 BA (6-54) with one home run allowed (Oneil Cruz, at PIT, 9/10/22) through his 42 appearances since joining the Cardinals, marking the lowest opponent average vs. LHB among Cardinals pitchers in that span with at least three LHB faced.
- In 2023, set career bests in games pitched (27), games finished (13), wins (4), saves (3), ERA (3.68), innings pitched (36.2), strikeouts (42), WHIP (1.06) and strikeouts/9 IP (10.3).
- Struck out the side on 12 pitches in his MLB debut at Atlanta (8/21/20), becoming the 2nd Phillie since 1957 to strike out the side in his MLB debut.

### #65 • Giovanny Gallegos • RHP • 32 yrs

- Making his 7th appearance of the spring today. Has struck out eight over 6.0 IP, including at least one batter in each appearance
- Has fanned 321 in his 270 outings with St. Louis, the 3rd-most by a Cardinals reliever in his first 270 games with the franchise behind Trevor Rosenthal (379), and Al Hrabosky (351).
- Has made 268 relief outings since 2019, 12th-most in MLB and the most by a pitcher exclusively
- Has converted double-digit saves in three straight seasons (14 in 2021, 14 in 2022, and 10 in 2023), becoming the first Cardinal to do so since Trevor Rosenthal (2014-17).
- Sports the 5th-lowest WHIP in Major League Baseball (0.95) since being acquired by the Cardinals at the 2018 MLB trade deadline (July 28, 2018), trailing Jacob deGrom (0.84), Liam Hendricks (0.88), Justin Verlander (0.92), and Yusmeiro Petit (0.94).
