### WHAT'S BREWING?

#### The Quest for 162-0

The Brewers are seeking to start a season 3-0 or better for the 10th time in franchise history and for the first time since going 4-0 to start 2024.

#### Sweep Home Chicago

The Brewers are looking to sweep the White Sox in a series of at least 3 games for the 11th time in franchise history....their last sweep came from 5/31-6/2, 2024 in Milwaukee (3g).... the team has swept Chicago six times at home and four times on the road.

#### A Note on Sproat

Brandon Sproat will be making his Brewers debut this afternoon in search of is first Major League win.... Sproat made his big league debut last season with the Mets and went 0-2 with a 4.79 ERA in 4 starts after he was promoted in September.

#### They're Out of Our League

The Brewers are 104-58 (.642) since 2022 in Interleague Play, which marks the best record in the Major Leagues.

#### Put a Sock in It!

The Brewers have gone 14-2 in their last 16 games against the White Sox.

#### Who's on First?

With the absence of Andrew Vaughn, the only right-handed hitters currently on the active roster with big league experience at first base are veteran Gary Sánchez (7g, 1gs, 16.2 innings) and William Contreras (1.0 inning).

#### Men of Steal

The Brewers last night produced at least 7 stolen bases in a game for the fifth time in franchise history.

#### Body By Jake

Jake Bauers has hit .357 (25-for-70) with 4 HR and 15 RBI in his last 29 games dating back to last season, including the postseason....he is also coming off a Spring Training in which he batted .462 (18-for-39) with 7 HR and 9 RBI in 15 games.

**THIS AFTERNOON'S GAME:** Is the third game (2-0) a 6-game, 7-day homestand against Chicago-AL (2-0) and Tampa Bay (3g) to open the 2026 season....following this homestand and an off day next Thursday, the team begins its road schedule with a 6-game trip to Kansas City (3g) and Boston (3g).

**MANAGER:** Pat Murphy (326g, 192-134, .589) is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25)....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

**COACHES:** Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator Jason Lane (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator Jim Henderson (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (8th season), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (3rd season), lead hitting coach Eric Theisen (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach Matt Erickson (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach Juan Sandoval, hitting coach Guillermo Martinez, hitting coach Daniel Vogelbach and first base coach Spencer Allen are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

**2025 IN REVIEW:** The Brewers went 97-65 to finish in first place in the NL Central, 5.0 games ahead of the Cubs....Milwaukee had the best record in baseball for only the second time in franchise history (1982) and set a franchise record for regular-season wins....the team beat the Cubs, 3 games to 2, in the National League Division Series before getting swept by the Dodgers in the National League Championship Series.

**BREWING SUCCESS:** The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

**BREWING CONSISTENCY:** The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 765 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (856), Astros (807) and Yankees (791).

**at CHI:** Are 88-110 all time, going 26-37 at Rate Field and 62-73 at old Comiskey Park....went 2-1 last season and have gone 7-1 in their last 8 games in Chicago.

**SPROAT AT A GLANCE:** Brandon Sproat, 25, will be making his Brewers debut....Sproat was acquired from the Mets with INF/OF Jett Williams on January 21 in exchange for RHP Freddy Peralta and RHP Tobias Myers....he entered the 2026 season as the fifth-best prospect in the Brewers organization according to *Baseball America*....Sproat was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Florida.

**LAST SEASON:** Sproat entered the 2025 season as the second-best prospect in the Mets organization according to *Baseball America* with his changeup rated best in the system....he went 8-6 with a 4.24 ERA in 26 games/25 starts at Triple-A Syracuse....he was named International League Pitcher of the Month for July (5gs, 2-0, 0.67era).... Sproat was selected by the Mets on September 7 and went 0-2 with a 4.79 ERA in 4 starts....he made his Major League debut on 9/7 at Cincinnati and carried a no-hitter into the sixth inning but took a 3-2 loss (6ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, 4bb, 7k).

**CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD:** Sproat has not pitched in Milwaukee.

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 0-2 with a 5.91 ERA in 2 starts (10.2ip, 7er).

**CAREER vs. WHITE SOX:** Sproat has not faced the Chicago, Illinois White Sox.

**ODDS & ENDS:** Sproat graduated from Pace (FL) High School, where he played football (quarterback) during his freshman and sophomore years in addition to four years of baseball....he enjoys golf, hunting, fishing and the outdoors.
