BIRDLAND BITES: The Birds continue a six-day, six-game road trip tonight against the Mariners (1-0, 2 to play) and Athletics (3 to play)...The O's have won seven of their last nine games after going 3-16 in their previous 19.

🦅 Baltimore has won a season-best four straight games, its longest single-season streak since June 26-29, 2024 (4 G)...The O's last won five straight from June 7-12, 2024 (6 G).

🦅 **Tomoyuki Sugano** recorded his fourth start of 7.0+ innings (W, 7.0 IP, 5 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 5 K, HR), one of seven AL pitchers to have at least four such outings (BOS' Crochet & HOU's Valdez: 6, KC's Bubic & NYY's Fried: 5, TB's Littell & DET's Skubal: 4)...The only O's hurler with more such starts in 2024 was Corbin Burnes (9).

🦅 Orioles starters have made four straight quality starts for the first time since September 10-14, 2024 (Suárez, Kremer, Eflin, Burnes)...They have not accomplished the feat in five straight since July 5-9, 2023 (Kremer, Bradish, Irvin, Wells, Gibson).

🦅 The Birds have allowed two runs or fewer in a season-best four straight games, their longest single-season run since June 8-12, 2024 (5 G).

🦅 Baltimore has won three straight road games and is 6-5 away from Camden Yards since May 9 after dropping six straight from April 26-May 8...The Birds last won four straight on the road in a single season from June 7-10, 2024, sweeping the Rays in a four-game set at Tropicana Field.

🦅 Five different Orioles were responsible for the five runs driven in last night (Cowser, Holliday, Kjerstad, O'Hearn, Uriás)...It marked the eighth time this season at least five different players recorded 1+ RBI (last: 5, 5/21 at MIL)...The O's season high is six players with 1+ RBI, done twice (3/29 at TOR & 4/19 vs. CIN).

🦅 The Birds grounded into a season-high-tying three double plays last night (3x, last: 5/24 [G2] at BOS)...Their 46 GIDP are sixth most in MLB after having only 71 GIDP in 2024.

🦅 The Orioles have drawn at least one walk in 137 straight games since July 2, 2024, the longest active stretch in the majors ahead of the Braves (81 G) and Blue Jays (70 G)...It's the second-longest such streak in franchise history behind a 155-game stretch from June 23, 1955-June 24 (G1), 1956.

MOO-VING RIGHT ALONG: **Colton Cowser** homered yesterday in his return from the 60-day Injured List (left thumb fracture), extending his career-opening on-base streak against Seattle to seven games since August 11, 2023...He is 8-for-20 (.400) with two doubles, one homer, four RBI, and seven walks against three strikeouts during the run.

🦅 He is the first Oriole to reach safely in each of his first seven career games against the Mariners since **Manny Machado** (9 G) from September 17, 2012-August 4, 2013.

🦅 Last night, Baltimore improved to 19-5 in games that Cowser has homered in his career, including winners of five straight and 12 of 15 since June 27, 2024.

START ME UP: In 13 games since May 20, Baltimore starters have gone 6-1 with a 2.40 ERA (19 ER/71.1 IP), the fourth-lowest ERA by any starting staff in the majors during that period...The O's rotation entered that stretch with a 6.03 ERA (175 ER/226.2 IP), second highest in MLB ahead of the Rockies (6.95).

🦅 Overall, Baltimore pitching owns a 4.16 ERA (58 ER/125.1IP) since May 19, ranking 20th in the majors...Removing infielder **Emmanuel Rivera's** outing (1.0 IP, 8 ER) on May 23 at Boston, however, the collective ERA falls to 3.62, which would rank 11th in MLB.

A MAY TO REMEMBER: **Ryan O'Hearn** slashed .365/.450/.542 (35-for-96) with five doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI, and 13 walks in 26 games last month, ranking among MLB leaders in batting average (5th) and on-base percentage (7th), while his .992 OPS ranked sixth in the AL...His .365 batting average and .450 on-base percentage were each the highest marks by an Oriole in the month of May (min. 100 PA) since **Brian Roberts** (.385, .485) in 2007.

🦅 His career-best and active 19-game on-base streak is tied for the third-longest active run in the majors and tied **Gunnar Henderson** (4/23-5/14) for the longest run by an Oriole this season...The last Oriole with a 20-game on-base streak was Henderson (36 G) from May 22-June 29, 2024.

🦅 O'Hearn has an MLB-best four games with 3+ hits since May 21, outpacing CLE's Steven Kwan, ATH's Brent Rooker, and ATH's Jacob Wilson (each 3 G)...He has five such performances overall in 49 games this year after having two across 142 games in 2024.

🦅 Overall, O'Hearn ranks among MLB leaders in batting average (4th, .335), on-base percentage (4th, .423), and OPS (6th, .961)...The .335 AVG would be the second-highest single-season mark in franchise history (since 1954) behind **Melvin Mora** (.340, 2004), while the .423 OBP would be third behind **Bob Nieman** (.442, 1956) and **Ken Singleton** (.438, 1977).

ROLE REVERSAL: The Birds have permitted 89 home runs, the second highest mark in the majors behind the Athletics (94 HR)...Over their last nine games, however, they have only allowed seven long balls after allowing 26 over their previous 13 games.

🦅 The O's have allowed one home run or fewer in five straight games, one shy of their season-long six-game stretch to open the season from March 27-April 2.

RISPY BUISNESS: O's pitching has limited the opposition to a .184 (14-for-76) clip with runners in scoring position since May 24, the fifth-lowest mark in the majors during that period behind the Rangers (.150), Mets (.155), Rays (.163), and Giants (.184)...Baltimore entered that period with a .290 opponent RISP average, fourth highest in MLB ahead of Colorado (.299), Miami (.298), and Washington (.294).

🦅 Offensively, the Birds have totaled an MLB-best 225 at-bats with runners in scoring position since May 8, ahead of the Red Sox (220 AB) and Cubs (217 AB)...Their .231 RISP average during that period ranks 19th in MLB...Comparatively, the Cubs rank second (.323), while the Red Sox rank 24th (.218).

EMERALD CITY CLASH: The O's and Mariners continue a six-game season set tonight in Seattle...The clubs will meet for a three-game series at Oriole Park at Camden Yards from August 12-14...Baltimore is 9-3 against Seattle since June 24, 2023, including a 5-2 mark at T-Mobile Park.

🦅 Orioles President of Business Operations **Catie Griggs** spent three seasons with the Mariners as President of Business Operations...She led the charge as T-Mobile Park became the first venue to host both MLB All-Star Week (2023) and the NHL Winter Classic (2024) within a calendar year.

🦅 **John Russell**, Manager of the Mariners Triple-A affiliate Tacoma Rainiers, served as Orioles Bench Coach from 2011-18.

QUICK HITS: Set to make his 11th start of the season and the 27th of his career...Threw a career-high 103 pitches on May 6 at Minnesota...At 25 years, 53 days old, is the youngest Orioles pitcher and third-youngest player on the active roster behind Jackson Holliday (21-182) and Gunnar Henderson (23-340)...Was the first Oriole pitcher to make his major league debut in 2024 when he started on June 6 at Toronto, and became the first Oriole to throw at least 100 pitches in his MLB debut since Wei-Yin Chen on April 10, 2012 vs. New York-AL...Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Yennier Cano, LHP Juan Rojas, and RHP Juan Núñez from the Minnesota Twins in exchange for RHP Jorge López and cash considerations on August 2, 2022...Originally selected by the Minnesota Twins in the third round (No. 98 overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Nebraska.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss on May 28 vs. St. Louis after allowing five runs on eight hits (1 HR), three walks, and a wild pitch with a season-high-tying nine strikeouts in 4.2 innings...Surrendered three straight extra-base hits (2 2B, HR) to open the fifth inning before recording an out...Has failed to complete 5.0 innings in five of his 10 starts this season...Threw 96 pitches, 56 strikes.

SEA YA LATER: Set to make his first career start against Seattle and the fourth of his career against an AL West opponent...Has gone 1-1 with a 12.27 ERA (15 ER/11.0 IP) through his three prior starts against the division...Allowed a career-high eight runs in his July 6, 2024 start at Oakland.

👉 Will be making his first start against the AL West this season...Last faced the division on August 23, 2024 vs. Houston, when he did not factor in the decision after allowing five runs on eight hits (2 HR), two walks, and one hit batter with three strikeouts in 5.0 innings.

ROAD RAGER: Povich is 1-2 with a 3.04 ERA (8 ER/23.2 IP) in four starts on the road compared to 0-2 with a 7.24 ERA (22 ER/27.1 IP) in six home outings...Only one of his nine homers surrendered this season have come in a road start (5/6 at MIN).

👉 Opponents are slashing .274/.300/.358 (26-for-95) off him on the road compared to .291/.381/.564 (32-for-110) at Oriole Park...His .564 slugging percentage at home is the fifth-highest mark among all MLB pitchers.

👉 Both of his quality starts this season have come on the road (4/6 at KC & 4/24 at WSH).

RIGHTY TIGHTY, LEFTY LOOSEY: Right-handed batters are hitting .296/.363/.480 (45-for-152) with seven doubles and seven home runs against him, compared to lefties slashing .245/.293/.434 (13-for-53) with two doubles, one triple, and two home runs.

👉 Lefties went 4-for-8 with two extra-base hits against him on May 28 vs. St. Louis, tied for his most hits surrendered against left-handers in a single start in his career (also 6/24/24 vs. CLE).

👉 Has held righties to a .214 average (18-for-84) through his last six starts since April 24 after allowing a .397 average against (27-for-68) to right-handers across his first four.

👉 Povich has countered left-handed hitters primarily with his four-seam fastball (32.2%), limiting to them a 1-for-11 (.091) clip with zero extra-base hits and five strikeouts...All 123 changeups he has thrown have come against righties, and it has been his most effective offering, limiting them to a .136 (3-for-22) mark while producing a 35.4 percent whiff rate.

FIRE IN THE HOLE: This season, batters in the seventh to ninth holes are slashing .263/.344/.281 (15-for-57) with a double and seven walks while batters one through six are slashing .291/.346/.541 (43-for-146) with 18 extra-base hits (8 2B, 1 3B, 9 HR) and 13 walks (1 IBB)...All of his home runs on the year have come against the top six hitters.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win after tossing 7.0 scoreless innings on four hits and one walk with six strikeouts...Marked his ninth career start of 7.0+ scoreless innings (last: 8/9/24 at TB)...Became the second Oriole to toss 7.0 scoreless frames this season, joining Dean Kremer (5/2 vs. KC).

vs. SEATTLE: Set to make his third career start against the Mariners...Has gone 1-0 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER/11.0 IP) through his two prior starts against the club...Last faced Seattle on September 10, 2023 at Tropicana Field with Tampa Bay, earning the win after allowing three runs on seven hits and two walks with six strikeouts in 5.0 innings.
