A GLANCE: The Yankees will continue their seven-game homestand tonight with the third game of a four-game set vs. Oakland (1-1 thus far)...are 3-2 on the homestand after winning two-of-three games vs. Tampa Bay this past weekend and splitting their first two games vs. Oakland...after this homestand, will embark on a seven-game road trip to Milwaukee (Fri.-Sun.) and Baltimore (4/29-5/2).

• Have won four of their last diverse. AT A GLANCE: The Yankees will continue their seven-game

- Have won four of their last six games.
 Their 16-8 record (.667) is the third-best record in the Majors, trailing only Cleveland (17-6, .739) and Atlanta (16-6, .727)... their 16 wins are tied for the second-most in the Majors,
- trailing only Cleveland (17). Marks just the fourth time in the last 21 years (since 2004) the Yankees went 16-8 or better to start a season (went 18-6 in 2022 and 16-8 in 2010 and '20).

 With a win tonight, it would also mark just the third time in
- the last 21 years (since 2004) and the fourth time in the last 24 years (since 2001) the Yankees have gone 17-8 or better to start a season (went 20-5 in 2003, 18-7 in 2022 and 17-8
- The Yankees are in the midst of a 17-day stretch without an off day (4/19-5/5)...are 3-2 so far. Have won six of their seven completed series this season.

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees defeated the Athletics, 4-3, on Tuesday at Yankee Stadium...**RHP Marcus Stroman** (5.1IP, 7H, 3R/ER, 1BB, 9K, 2HR, 1WP) earned his second win of the season...**1B Anthony Rizzo** (1-for-3, 1R, 1HR, 2RBI) hit a two-run HR in the first inning...**DH Giancarlo Stanton** (1-for-4, 1R, 1 double, 2RBI) hit a go-ahead, two-run double in the first inning...SS Anthony Volpe (1-for-3, 1HP) and CF Aaron Judge (1-for-3, 1R, 1 double, 1HP) both reached base twice...RHP Ron Marinaccio (1.0IP, 1BB, 1K, 1BK), LHP Caleb Ferguson (1.0IP, 1K), RHP Dennis Santana (0.2IP) and RHP Clay Holmes (SV, 1.0IP, 2K) combined to toss 3.2 scoreless innings of relief.

Improved to 6-2 following a loss this year.

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters have posted a 2.93 ERA (129.0IP, 42ER) in 24 starts this year, the third-lowest ERA in the Majors, trailing only Boston (1.80) and Philadelphia (2.22)... have allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 21 of their 24 starts, 2ER-or-fewer in 16 starts and 1ER-or-fewer in 11 starts...have not allowed more than 4ER in any start this season.

Also rank fourth in the Majors in opponents' SLG (.358), and sixth in opponents' BA (.231) and opponents' OPS (.672).
Yankees starters have allowed just 7R/6ER over their last six starts (since 4/17), posting a 1.51 ERA (35.2IP, 6ER) with 40K.
Yankees starters have recorded 9K in three of their last four starts (Nestor Cortes – 9K on 4/20 vs. Tampa Bay, Luis Gil – 9K on 4/21 vs. Tampa Bay and Marcus Stroman – 9K on 4/23 vs. Oakland)...marks just the fourth time in the last six seasons (since 2019) that Yankees starters have recorded nine-ormore strikeouts at least three times over a four-game span more strikeouts at least three times over a four-game span (also three times in a four-game span from 9/17-21/23, three times in a four-game span from 9/9-12(G2)/23 and in three consecutive games from 5/11-13/21).

MATCHING UP: Since 2022, the Yankees are 11-4 in their last 15 games vs. Oakland...are 17-7 in their last 24 games vs. the

- A's (since 8/31/19)...have won or split each of their last seven completed series (5-0-2) against Oakland (since 8/30/19).

 Are 11-2 in their last 13 games vs. Oakland at Yankee Stadium (since 8/31/19) and 15-4 in their last 19 games against the A's in the Bronx (since 5/27/17).
- Have won each of their last six completed series vs. Oakland at Yankee Stadium (since 2017).

PITCH PERFECT: Yankees pitchers have posted a 2.95 ERA (216.2IP, 71ER) this year, the fourth-lowest ERA in the Majors, trailing only Boston (2.60), Detroit (2.82) and Cleveland (2.94)...their 2.95 ERA is their second-lowest through the Yankees' first 24 games of a season in the last 43 years since 1982 (2.62 ERA in 2022).

 Have held opponents to 3R-or-fewer in 15 of 24 games this year (are 11-4 in those games)...are 14-4 this season when holding their opponent to 4R-or-fewer.

STANTON ISLAND: DH/OF Giancarlo Stanton hit a go-ahead, two-run double in the first inning on Tuesday vs. Oakland... TANTON ISLAND: DH/OF Glancario Stanton nit a go-anead, two-run double in the first inning on Tuesday vs. Oakland... nine of his 17H this season have gone for extra bases (four doubles/5HR)...has reached base in 12 of his last 14 games (since 4/6), hitting .286/.352/.592 (14-for-49) with 9R, 3 doubles, 4HR, 11RBI and 5BB over that span.

BATTERS' EYE: Yankees batters lead the Majors with a 4.14 pitches per plate appearance ratio.

CLOSE CALLS: The Yankees have had 16 of their 24 games decided by 2R-or-fewer, going 11-5 in those games...their 16 such games are the most in the Majors...**are 8-2 in one-run games**...their 10 one-run games are tied with Oakland and Detroit for the most in the Majors.

• The Yankees have had 19 of their 24 games decided by 3R-or-fewer the most such games in the Majors.

- 3R-or-fewer, the most such games in the Majors. Each of their last nine games, 10 of their last 11 games and 11 of their last 13 games have been decided by 2R-or-fewer.

PEN PALS: Yankees relievers did not allow a hit over 3.2 scoreless innings of relief on Tuesday vs. Oakland...the Yankees bullpen owns the sixth-lowest ERA (2.98) in the Majors, trailing only Detroit (1.62), Cleveland (2.05), Seattle (2.60), Oakland (2.81) and Minnesota (2.82).

The Yankees are 9-0 this season when they lead after six innings, 13-0 when leading after seven innings and 13-0 when leading after eight innings.

THE GREAT JUAN: OF Juan Soto has reached base safely in 21 of his 24 games this season, hitting .319/.432/.538 (29-for-91) with 15R, 5 doubles, 5HR, 20RBI, 19BB, 1SB and 1SF...has reached base multiple times in 14 of those games

- Is batting .500/.583/1.056 (9-for-18) with 1 double, 3HR, 17RBI, 5BB and 15F with RISP this season...with RISP, leads the Majors in SLG and OPS (1.639), is tied for third in BA (tied for first in AL) and fifth in OBP (third in AL).
- Ranks second in the Majors in OBP (.432, first in AL), tied for second in WAR among position players (1.6 FanGraphs, tied for first in AL), third in times on base (48, first in AL) and walks (19, second in AL), tied for sixth in RBI (20, tied for fourth in AL) and 10th in OPS (.971, fifth in AL).

HOLMES SWEET HOLMES: RHP Clay Holmes recorded his Major League-leading ninth save of the season on Tuesday after tossing a scoreless ninth inning...**has not allowed an** earned run in 12 appearances this season (12.01P, 3R/0ER, 1BB, 10K, 2HP).

- His nine saves match the most by a Yankees pitcher through the club's first 24 games of a season in franchise history (since saves became an official stat in 1969), matching Andrew Miller's nine saves in 2015 and Mariano Rivera's nine saves in 2011 and '13.
- Has converted 15 of his 16 save opportunities since 9/12/23-G1 at Boston.
- His 12.0IP are the most among Major League relievers who have not allowed an earned run this season.

SCHMIDT'S CREEK: RHP Clarke Schmidt will make his fifth start of the season tonight...is 1-0 with a 3.15 ERA (20.0IP, 7ER) with 23K in four starts this year...the Yankees are 4-0 in his starts this year.

▶ Since the start of 2023, his 29 starts of 3R-or-fewer allowed

are the third-most in the Majors, trailing only Sonny Gray (32) and Blake Snell (30)...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in 24 of his last 27 starts (since 5/19/23).

COMEBACK KIDS: Eight of the Yankees' 16 wins are come-From-behind wins...their eight comeback wins are tied with Baltimore, Cleveland and Detroit for the second-most in the Majors, trailing only Atlanta (nine).

THREE'S COMPANY: The Yankees are 16-2 (.889) this season when scoring at least 3R, the best such record in the Majors.

NOBODY BEATS THE RIZZ: INF Anthony Rizzo hit a two-run HR in the first inning on Tuesday vs. Oakland...has reached base in 19 of his 24 games this season.

April 24, 1923: The Yankees record the first shutout in Original Yankee Stadium history, a 4-0 win over the Washington Senators. Sad Sam Jones tosses a complete-game shutout (9.0IP, 5H, 1BB, 4K) and Babe Ruth goes 3-for-3 with 1HR and 3RBI.

April 24, 1917: Yankees left-hander George Mogridge pitches the first no-hitter in franchise history in a 2-1 victory at Boston (3BB, 3K). It will mark the last time the Yankees have a lefty throw a no-hitter until Dave Righetti turns the trick on 7/4/83 vs. Boston.

TOMORROW IN YANKEES HISTORY

April 25, 1999: In front of a sold-out Yankee Stadium and many of Joe DiMaggio's former teammates, a monument in honor of the Yankee Clipper is unveiled in Monument Park. RHP Clarke Schmidt will make his fifth start of the season tonight vs. Oakland...the 28-year-old will make the start on regular four day's rest...made his fourth start of the season on Friday vs. Tampa Bay and did not record a decision despite allowing just 1ER over 5.1IP (7H, 0BB, 7K, 1HR, 1HP)... tossed a career-high 102 pitches (previous: 99 on 8/26/23 at Tampa Bay and 9/6/23 vs. Detroit)...marked his sixth straight start with 3ER-or-fewer allowed (since 9/25/23 vs. Arizona)...since the start of 2023, his 29 starts of 3R-or-fewer allowed are the third-most in the Majors, trailing only Sonny Gray (32) and Blake Snell (30)...in 2023, went 9-9 with a 4.64 ERA (159.0IP, 169H, 91R/82ER, 46BB, 149K, 24HR) in 33 games (32 starts) with the Yankees...allowed 3R-or-fewer in 20 of his final 23 starts (5/19-9/30), 22 of his final 26 starts (5/3-9/30) and 23 of his final 28 starts (4/23-9/30)...tossed at least 5.0 innings in 18 of his final 23 starts (5/19-9/30) and 21 of his final 28 starts (4/23-9/30) after not doing so in his first four starts of the season... has made three career Opening Day rosters (2022-24)...was selected by the Yankees in the first round (16th overall) of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of South Carolina.

LAST TIME OUT: Allowed just 1ER over 5.1 innings on Friday vs. Tampa Bay (7H, 0BB, 7K, 1HR, 1HP)...tossed a career-high 102 pitches (previous: 99 on 8/26/23 at Tampa Bay and 9/6/23 vs. Detroit).

ON A ROLL: Over his last 28 outings (27 starts) since 5/19/23, is 9-5 with a 3.95 ERA (139.0IP, 140H, 66R/61ER, 40BB, 124K, 18HR).

- Has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in each of his last six starts (since 9/25/23 vs. Arizona), including 2ER-or-fewer in five of those starts.
- Going back to last season, the Yankees have won eight of his last nine starts (since 9/6/23 vs. Detroit), including each of his last six starts (since 9/25/23 vs. Arizona).
