RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a season-long, 10-game, 10-day homestand against the Nationals (1-0, two to play), Royals (four to play), and Diamondbacks (three to play) today at Tropicana Field...snapped a three-game skid last night, but have dropped five of their last seven games...are an AL-worst 8-15 in their last 23 games (May 24-pres.) on the heels of a 22-4 stretch (April 22-May 22)...have lost 8.5 games on the AL East-leading Yankees during that timeframe, whom they now trail by 3.0 games for the division lead...could fall a season-high-tying 4.0 games back with a loss today and a Yankees win vs. CIN...are 1-0 on a stretch of 23 games in 24 days leading into the All-Star break (June 19-July 12), with the lone off day coming on June 29...had the best record in the AL for 35 straight days between May 9-June 12, which included eight consecutive days atop the majors from May 18-25...have spent 41 days in first place in the AL East, 32 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth.

- ★ The Rays overcame a pair of early Nationals solo homers in last night's 5-2, series-opening win...Jonathan Aranda tallied a go-ahead, three-run homer in the 3rd inning for his 13th go-ahead RBI, fourth in the AL to NYY Cody Bellinger (15), ATH Nick Kurtz (14), and NYY Ben Rice (14).
- ★ It marked their 18th comeback victory, tied for fourth most in the AL...they have come from behind in three of four and eight of their last 13 victories (May 17-pres.) compared to three of their previous 17 wins (April 22-May 15)...the Rays have scored first once in their last seven games (June 12-pres.).
- ★ Griffin Jax (5.0IP, 4H, 2ER, 5SO) earned his first win as a starter since Oct. 2, 2021 at KC as a member of the Twins and the Rays bullpen retired 12 of 14 BF, combining for 4.0 scoreless frames, their second most this season behind June 8 vs. BOS (5.0IP).
- ★ With a win today, the Rays would claim their fourth straight series win over the Nationals (2023-pres.) and earn their eighth win in their last nine sets at Tropicana Field...they would also improve to 3-2-0 in their last five Interleague series after losing their first five.
- ★ The Rays have gone 12-3-1 in the previous 16 series they won the opening contest, claiming each of their last eight such sets at home.
- ★ With last night's victory, the Rays remained undefeated (6-0) in their throwback Devil Rays uniforms...they are 3-2 when wearing their City Connect jerseys.

ALL ARANDA BASES—Following his three-run homer last night, Jonathan Aranda has 51 RBI on the season, tied for fifth most in the AL and the most by a Rays hitter through the club's first 72 games since Evan Longoria (52) in 2010...he has 28 RBI in 33 games at Tropicana Field, tied with Ben Zobrist (2009) and Jorge Cantú (2005) for second most by a Ray through his first 33 home games to begin a season behind Isaac Paredes (29) in 2023...with 29 RBI in 31 home games, Yandy Diaz needs 1 RBI in his next two games at the Trop to surpass Paredes' mark...the Rays are 24-9 when Aranda records an RBI (14-4 at home, including six straight wins) and 18-21 in all other games.

THE BAKE SHOW—Bryan Baker worked a perfect 9th inning on 13 pitches last night for his 19th save, tying SD Mason Miller for second most in the majors to CLE Cade Smith (24)...it was his AL-leading 12th save of 15 pitches or fewer, tied with AZ Paul Sewald for second most in the majors to STL Riley O'Brien (13)...Baker has converted eight straight and 15 of his last 16 save opportunities—the eight-save streak is tied for the fourth-longest active run in the AL...he has worked a season-high 11 consecutive scoreless outings, tied for the second-longest streak of his career behind a 15-game run from April 2-May 4, 2023...his streak of 11.0 consecutive scoreless innings is the second-longest active run among AL relievers behind HOU Steven Okert (14.0)...he would need three saves over the Rays next 10 games to tie Fernando Rodney (22, 2012) for the most before the end of June in team history.

DEEP BALL DIVE—Both Nationals runs last night were plated on solo homers...over the last four games, nine of the 12 runs the Rays have allowed have come on 6 HR...across their last 18 games (May 30-pres.), 50.6 pct. (43) of the 85 runs against the Rays have come on 28 HR, the second-highest percentage in the AL—only the Yankees (54.3%) staff has a higher mark over that span...conversely, 34.8 pct. (23) of the 66 runs the Rays have scored across that timeframe have come on 14 HR, fourth lowest in the majors...only the Rangers (29.8%), Royals (31.2%), and Cardinals (32.3%) have lower marks.

★ Since May 13, the Rays have homered in 13 of 16 games at Tropicana Field compared to four of their 15 road games...they are 7-1 when tallying multiple long balls at home.

★ Overall, the Rays are 11-3 in games they record multiple homers and 16-1 when out-homering their opponent...they have gone a combined 30-7 when equaling or surpassing their opponent's home run total compared to 12-23 when they are out-homered.

★ Junior Caminero (15), Jonathan Aranda (12), and Yandy Diaz (12) are one of three AL trios with 12 HR or more apiece, joining groups from the Athletics (Kurtz, Langeliers, Soderstrom) and White Sox (Montgomery, Murakami, Vargas)...the three have combined for 39 of the Rays 60 homers (65.0%).

DOMESTIC SWEET DOME—The Rays MLB-leading 25-9 home record marks the second-best home start in franchise history behind 2023 (28-6)...they have won 21 of their last 26 games at Tropicana Field (April 22-pres.), their best stretch at home within a single season since April 8-May 26, 2023 (21-5)...since May 13, the Rays are 11-5 at home (2nd in AL/4th in MLB) compared to 3-12 in road affairs (30th in MLB)...on the year, the 288-point discrepancy between their home (24-9/.735) and road (17-21/.447) winning percentages is the largest in the majors...they rank second in MLB in home RISP average (.292), third in batting average (.266), fourth in on-base pct. (.343), and fifth in OPS (.763)...the Rays are in a stretch of 19 home games within a 28-game span from May 29-June 28, going 8-11 thus far (6-4 at home).

★ They have recorded double-digit hits in three straight home games for the first time since a five-game streak from Aug. 16-31, 2024.

★ The Rays are 12-0 against the AL East at Tropicana Field, MLB's longest season-opening, home winning streak over division rivals since the 2009 Dodgers won their first 12 home games vs. the NL West...among AL clubs, only the 2003 Royals (13-0) have had a longer streak in the divisional era (since 1969)...they are 13-9 against all other opponents at home.

★ Junior Caminero has hit safely in a career-high 15 straight home games (May 16-pres.), MLB's second-longest active home hitting streak to ATH Zack Gelof (18G) and the fourth-longest streak by an AL batter this season behind Gelof, NYY Cody Bellinger (16G, April 13-May 20), and HOU Yordan Alvarez (16G, March 27-May 4)...the last Ray with a longer single-season streak was Avisail Garcia (16G) from May 10-June 29, 2019.

★ Caminero is batting .415 (22-for-53) with 9 XBH, 11 RBI, 14 BB vs. 9 SO, and 11 R during the streak, reaching base safely in 36 of 67 PA (.537 OBP)...min. 50 PA, he leads MLB in home on-base pct. since the streak began on May 16 while ranking fifth in OPS.

★ Diaz has reached base safely in 17 straight home games (May 5-pres.), tied for MLB's third-longest active streak behind SD Fernando Tatis Jr. (19G) and Gelof (18G)...he is slashing .394/.453/.773 (26-for-66) with 4 2B, 7 HR, and 20 RBI at Tropicana Field during the streak.

★ Kevin Kelly has recorded 16 scoreless outings (17.0IP) at Tropicana Field, the third-longest season-opening streak at home by a Rays reliever behind Jake McGee (19G) in 2012 and Trevor Miller (17G) in 2008...per Stats Perform, the 17-0-IP streak at home is the third longest to begin the season in MLB this year, trailing NYY Brent Headrick (18.2, active) MIA Tyler Phillips (18.1), and is tied for the longest to open a campaign in Rays history (see table on the right).

FROM D.C. TO TB—The Rays and Nationals meet for their lone series of 2026 this weekend...the Rays swept a three-game set last year from Aug. 29-31 at Nationals Park, their fifth time sweeping Washington, first since April 3-5, 2023 at WSH...they have won a franchise-record five straight games over the Nationals dating back to June 30, 2024 and nine of 10 since the clubs began meeting annually in 2023...min. 10 games, the 9-1 (.900) record vs. the Nats since 2023 is second best in the majors by any team against a single opponent, trailing the Brewers over the White Sox (11-1/.917)...the Rays have won the last three sets between the clubs and are 5-3-3 in series play under Kevin Cash (since 2015)...since losing their first series with the Expos from June 5-7, 1998 in St. Petersburg, the Rays are undefeated (4-0-3) in their last seven home sets against the Nationals/Expos franchise.

★ The Rays 12-16 mark in Interleague play is tied for ninth in the AL/tied for 21st in the majors, but their 30-14 intraleague record leads MLB.

★ Nationals Manager Blake Butera served as the Rays senior director, player development from 2024-25 as part of an eight year stint working in the organization (2018-25) before joining Washington this past offseason...he spent two seasons as a player in the Rays system from 2015-16 after the Rays selected him in the 35th round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft...Nationals General Manager Anirudh Kilambi began his career working in the Rays front office (2015-21).

★ Zack Littell (2023-25), Curtis Mead (2023-25), and Richard Lovelady (2024) are former Rays.

★ Bench coach Michael Johns was the Rays first base coach from 2024-25 following over 15 years holding various roles in the organization's player development system, guiding Triple-A Durham (2023) and Class-A Charlotte (2015) to league championships as manager...catching coach Bobby Wilson, a Dunedin, Fla. native who attended Seminole High School and St. Petersburg College, played 53 games for the Rays from 2015-16...assistant hitting coach Shawn O'Malley, a 2006 Tampa Bay draftee (5th round), played eight seasons in the Rays minor league system (2006-13)...outfield and baserunning coach Chris Prieto served as Rays first base coach from 2022-23.

★ Nick Fortes is a career .298 (28-for-94) hitter with 8 XBH and 16 RBI in 34 games against the Nationals...Ben Williamson is 5-for-11 (.455) in three games.

TODAY'S START—Ian Seymour is scheduled to take the mound today for his third start and 29th appearance of the season...marks his eighth career start and 48th career appearance...selected in the second round (57th overall) of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of Virginia Tech.

- ✦ Has a 1.42 ERA (6.1IP, 1ER) across four career appearances on Saturdays, his lowest mark on any day of the week in his career.
- ✦ Is 1-0 with a 5.51 ERA (16.1IP, 10ER) with 15 strikeouts during 12 day outings in 2026 compared to a 4.50 ERA (22.0IP, 11ER) and 26 strikeouts in 16 night appearances.
- ✦ Seymour is 4.2 innings shy of 100.0 innings pitched in his career.
- ✦ The Rays are 2-0 in his starts this season.
- ✦ If he were to permit a home run today, would become the first Rays southpaw to surrender homers in four straight contests or more since **Tyler Alexander** (6G) in 2024.

LAST TIME OUT—Last saw action on June 14 at LAA, allowing two earned runs on two hits across 3.1 innings of relief...surrendered a solo homer to **Donovan Walton** in the 5th inning, allowing homers in three straight outings (June 2-pres.) for the first time in his career.

- ✦ Marked his most innings pitched out of the bullpen since Sept. 23, 2025 at BAL (4.OIP).
- ✦ Generated a season-high 11 whiffs, tied for fourth most in any appearance during his career.

LAST START—In his second start of the campaign, Seymour threw a season-high 4.0 innings with a season-high five strikeouts on June 8 vs. BOS (4.OIP, H, R, BB, 5SO, HR)...his lone blemish came on a **Marcelo Mayer** solo home run in the 3rd inning...struck out **Jarren Duran** in the 3rd inning for his 100th career strikeout...retired 12 of 14 batters faced.

- ✦ Marked his most innings pitched since Sept. 23, 2025 at BAL (also 4.OIP).
- ✦ Generated nine whiffs, his second most this season behind June 14 at LAA (11)...tied Mason Englert (June 3 vs. DET) for the most whiffs by a Rays reliever this season.

NATURDAYS ARE FOR THE BOYS—His lone appearance against the Nationals was a start on Aug. 31, 2025 at WSH, posting 5.0 innings and allowing one earned run on four hits with a career-high-tying eight strikeouts.

- ✦ Has logged a 2-0 career record with a 4.68 ERA (25.OIP, 13ER) and 31 strikeouts across 16 appearances (two starts) against NL East clubs...is 1-0 with a 5.68 ERA (12.2IP, 8ER) and 12 strikeouts opposite NL East foes during 11 appearances (one start) in 2026.
- ✦ Is 2-0 with a 4.68 ERA (25.OIP, 13ER) and 31 strikeouts across 16 Interleague appearances (two starts) in his career...has gone 1-0 with a 5.68 ERA (12.2IP, 8ER) and 12 strikeouts in such matchups this season.

TROPS OF JUPITER—Seymour is making his second start and 16th appearance at Tropicana Field this year...is 1-0 with a 2.95 ERA (21.1IP, 7ER) and 20 strikeouts at home this season as opposed to a 2-0 mark with a 7.41 ERA (17.OIP, 14ER) and 21 strikeouts in 13 road outings...since the making his major league debut in 2025, Seymour has posted a 3.07 ERA (41.OIP, 14ER) with a 1.05 WHIP and 38 strikeouts across 21 home outings (three starts).

- ✦ Has a 2.70 ERA across his last 20.0 innings pitched inside Tropicana Field (14 appearances) since April 10, logging a .121 (8-for-66) opp. average with 8.55 strikeouts per 9.0 innings during that stretch.

IT'S NOT A SWORD—Boasts a 30.5 pct. whiff rate this season, ranking fourth among AL southpaws (min. 500 pitches) behind only BOS **Jovani Morá** (32.5%), KC **Cole Ragans** (31.7%), and NYY **Brent Headrick** (31.5%)...his whiff rate ranks second among Rays arms (min. 500 pitches) behind **Griffin Jax's** 30.7 pct. clip in 2026...according to Baseball Savant, Seymour's whiff rate is in the 87th percentile of all major league pitchers.

MAJOR LEAGUE RECAP—In his rookie season in 2025, made 19 appearances (five starts) over three stints with the Rays (June 8-10, July 8-30, & July 31-end of season)...began in a relief role before transitioning to the starting rotation, earning the starting nod in five of his final seven appearances after his first 12 came out of the bullpen.

- ✦ Made his first career start Aug. 25 at CLE, tossing 5.0 IP of one-hit ball with 8 SO and 1 BB, joining **Brendan McKay** (June 29, 2019 vs. TEX) as the only Rays to permit two baserunners or fewer across 5.0 IP or more in their first career start...was the first left-hander to start a game for the Rays since **Tyler Alexander** on Sept. 26, 2024, snapping a 133-game streak of right-handed starters that was second longest in team history, trailing Oct. 3, 1999–June 5, 2001 (234G)...his 8 SO tied **Taj Bradley** (April 12, 2023 vs. BOS) for third most by a Ray in his first career start, trailing **Matt Moore** (11) on Sept. 22, 2011 at NYY and **Wade Davis** (9) on Sept. 6, 2009 vs. DET.
- ✦ Made his major league debut on June 9, 2025 at BOS and earned the win after pitching the 10th and 11th innings...he allowed one run (OER) with two walks (1 IBB) and two strikeouts in the outing...he was the fourth Ray to earn the win in relief in his major league debut, joining **Seth McClung** (March 31, 2003 vs. BOS), **Doug Waechter** (Aug. 27, 2003 at SEA), and **Andrew Bellatti** (May 9, 2015 vs. TEX).
