TODAY'S GAME: The Giants look to salvage the series with a win in today's finale vs. the Royals...SF is 1-4 on this six-game road trip after going 1-2 vs. Seattle before dropping the first two here in KC.

- ▶ Now 101 games into 2026, SF is 42-59 (.416), which is the fourth-lowest winning percentage in MLB, ahead of only the Royals (42-60, .412), Angels (40-61, .396) and Rockies (40-62, .392).
- ▶ SF's 59 losses through its first 101 games are its most in a season since 2017 (39-62 through 101 games)...it marks just the seventh time since 1900, and the fourth time in the SF era (since 1958) that the Giants had 59+ losses by the 101-game marker (2026, 2017, 1985 and 1984).

VS. THE ROYALS: The Giants and Royals have faced off 30 times in the regular season, with SF going 11-19 (.367) in those matchups...the .367 winning percentage is SF's second-lowest against any active MLB team, behind only the 8-19 (.296) mark vs. the Yankees.

- ▶ SF has won five of its last nine games vs. the Royals dating to April 9, 2023...the Giants have outscored the Royals 29-22 in that span.
- ▶ Royals starter Seth Lugo has an opposing slash line of .384/.392/.877 with 11 doubles, two triples and seven homers allowed on the first pitch of an at-bat...the Giants are batting .322/.331/.550 with an .880 OPS on the first pitch.
- ▶ **IF Luis Arraez** is one of eight players all-time to have 76+ hits through their first 56 career games vs. the Royals, joining Ichiro (82), Albert Pujols (79), Plácido Polanco (79), Álex Rodríguez (79), Rubén Sierra (79), Johnny Damon (78) and Magglio Ordóñez (76)...Arraez is a career .374 (76x203) hitter vs. the Royals.

TODAY'S STARTER: RHP **Landen Roupp** is set to make his second start of the second-half today...he earned the win as he allowed just two hits and three walks over 7.0 shutout innings at Seattle in SF's 7-0 win on July 17...Roupp tied his career-high (also April 26 vs. MIA) with 13 ground balls induced.

- ▶ Roupp has won each of his last two starts after snapping his career-long seven-game losing streak...he's allowed just five hits over last two starts...the last SF starter to pitch 15.0+ innings with five or fewer hits allowed over a two-game span was **Blake Snell** August 2-7, 2024.
- ▶ This will be his second career start vs. the Royals...in his one career start against KC on September 21, 2024, he allowed three hits and three walks over 5.0 shutout innings en route to earning the win.
- ▶ Roupp's curveball has a whiff rate of 34.6%, a putaway rate of 27.6% and a run value of +6, all highest among all his pitches...KC's .738 OPS vs. curveballs is fourth-best in MLB.

CLOSE CALLS: SF has a +1 run differential on this road trip (18-17) with three of its four losses being decided by one run.

- ▶ The Giants are 9-15 (.375) in one-run games this season (27th in MLB)...their 15 one-run losses are two shy of the MLB lead held by Toronto, Detroit, the Angels and the Mets.

THE BRYCE IS RIGHT: IF **Bryce Eldridge** has reached base 87 times this season, which is the most times reaching base for a Giants rookie in a single season since **Tyler Fitzgerald** reached base 114 times in 2024.

WHAT'S ON DECK?: The Giants will head home following today's game, enjoy an off day on Thursday, and then start a six-game homestand that has a three-game series vs. the Angels (Friday-Sunday) and Brewers (Monday-Wednesday)...Thursday's off day is SF's last until August 6 (13 straight days with a game).

- ▶ The Giants are in the midst of a stretch in which they are facing three consecutive AL opponents (Mariners, Royals and Angels)...SF faces Interleague opponents in eight of its 11 series following the All-Star break, also visiting the Rangers, Guardians and Red Sox and hosting the Tigers and Astros within the next month.
- ▶ SF's 9-17 (.346) record in Interleague play this season, which is the lowest Interleague record in the Majors in 2026.

ROUPPER: Roupp is in his third season with San Francisco...the 27-year-old was the Giants' 12th round pick in 2021 out of UNC Wilmington.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win as he opened the second half for the Giants...allowed just two hits and three walks over 7.0 shutout innings at Seattle in SF's 7-0 win on July 17...Roupp tied his career-high (also April 26 vs. MIA) with 13 ground balls induced.

VS. KANSAS CITY: Made his one career start against the Royals on September 21, 2024, allowing three hits and three walks over 5.0 shutout innings en route to earning the win.

LET'S MAKE IT 3 IN A ROW: Roupp has won each of his last two starts after snapping his career-long seven-game losing streak...he's allowed just five hits over last two starts...the last SF starter to have 15.0+ innings with five or fewer hits allowed over a two-game span was **Blake Snell** August 2-7, 2024.

SINK IN: His success has deeply depended on how his sinker performs...in his last two starts, Roupp has held opponents to just one hit in 11 at-bats ending in his sinker...In his first six starts this season, in which he went 5-1, opponents slashed .114/.264/.159 with two extra-base hits (zero homers) and a .423 OPS vs. his sinker...during the team's 11-game losing streak in his starts, opponents slashed .365/.460/.662 with 13 XBH (four homers) and a 1.122 OPS.

WHERE'S THE K COUNTER LOCATED?: He has 106 strikeouts in 104.0 innings in 2026 with his 24.4% strikeout rate currently standing as a career-best (21.7% rate in 2024 and a 21.4% rate in 2025)...the 24.4% strikeout rate is 12th-best in the NL among qualified pitchers.

WHAT'S THE COUNT?: Roupp's 17.6 pitches per inning is the third-highest mark in MLB among pitchers with at least 100.0 innings pitched this season, behind only COL's Michael Lorenzen (18.3) and NYM's Freddy Peralta (18.2)...Roupp's 4.21 pitches per batter faced is also the second-highest in MLB (min. 100.0ip) behind only Toronto's Dylan Cease (4.26 pitches per batters faced).

NO EAR PLUGS NEEDED: The righty's 28.8% hard hit rate this season is the lowest in the Majors by (min. 250 batted ball events) and his 2.5% barrels per plate appearance is also the lowest in MLB...Roupp's 51.2% ground ball rate in 2026 is seventh-highest in MLB (among qualified pitchers).

CALLING CARD: Since entering the Majors in 2024, Roupp's go-to out pitch has been his curveball...this season, Roupp's curveball has a whiff rate of 34.6%, a putaway rate of 27.6% and a run value of +6, all highest among all his pitches...the +6 run value is tied for the fourth-highest in the Majors...Roupp's 47 strikeouts with a curveball this season are tied for fifth-most in MLB.

CLUTCH UP: With two outs and RISP, opponents are batting just .143 (5x35) with a .545 OPS vs. Roupp...the .143 opposing batting average with two outs and RISP is seventh-best in the NL among qualified pitchers while the .545 OPS is 11th-best.
