SNAKEBITES

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 12-2 @ Tigers last night.

- Corbin Carroll hit his career-high-tying 14th triple (also: 2024) to leadoff the game...since 2010, the most triples in a season is 16 (Jose Reyes/NYM and Shane Victorino/PHI)...since 2000, he is the fifth MLB player with consecutive 14+-triple seasons (2024-25), joining Dexter Fowler/COL (2010-11), Reyes/NYM (2005-06), Carl Crawford/TB (2004-06) and Carlos Guzman/MIN (2000-01).
- **Ketel Marte** had his third multi-hit game in his last 6...has hit safely in 4 straight games and in 5 of his last 6 games, batting .364 (8-for-22)/.462 OBP/.500 SLG/.962 OPS with 1 homer, 2 RBI and 4 walks (3 K).
- **Jake McCarthy** hit safely in his third straight game... batting .333 (4-for-12) with 2 doubles and 1 triple.

CARROLL'S 40 CAREER TRIPLES & FIVE IN JULY: Corbin Carroll, since the divisional era (1969), is the seventh player to reach 40+ triples in their first 436 career games, joining Dexter Fowler/COL (40, 2012), Curtis Granderson/DET (40, 2008), Jose Reyes/NYM (40, 2006), Carl Crawford/TB (40, 2005), Juan Samuel/PHI (43, 1986) and Garry Templeton/STL (42, 1979).

- Since he entered the Majors in 2022, no player has more triples (40), trailed by Jarren Duran/BOS (31) and Bobby Witt Jr./KC (31).
- With his 5 triples in July, is the fifth D-back all-time to collect 5+ triples in a month, joining Chris Owings (5 in Aug. 2016), David Peralta (franchise-high 6 in July 2015), Stephen Drew (5 in July 2009) and Eric Byrnes (5 in May 2007).
- Carroll and Zach McKinstry/DET (June 2025) are the only players to hit 5+ triples in a month this season.

LEADOFF TRIPLES: Corbin Carroll's 10 leadoff triples are the most by a player through their first 436 career games (since 1901)...dating back to 2017, no player has totaled more than 6 leadoff triples:

SLUGGING LEADOFF: Among MLB players in the leadoff spot [min. 150 PA], **Corbin Carroll** ranks in triples (1st, 11), homers (2nd, 20, behind Shohei Ohtani-LAD/34), .SLG (3rd, .600, behind Byron Buxton-MIN/.610 and Ohtani-LAD/.605), and OPS (5th, .930).

• Among MLB leadoff this season (min. 150 PA), Carroll's 26.9% barrel pct. ranks atop the group:

DANGEROUS FROM 1-2 SPOTS: From the 1-2 lineup spots, the D-backs lead the Majors in OPS (.876), OBP (.360), SLG (.516), extra-base hits (104), total bases (450), RBI (131) and triples (15)...are second in homers (49, behind Dodgers/52).

ON-BASE PAIR: Since July 1, **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base in 21 of his 24 games, hitting .302 (26-for-86)/.419 OBP/.407 SLG/.826 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 15 RBI and 15 walks (10 K)...his 44 times on base in the span rank second in the NL, behind Fernando Tatis Jr./SD (46) and tied for eighth in the Majors.

• **Ketel Marte**, since July 1, has reached base safely in 15 of his 18 games (18 hits, 12 walks, 11 strikeouts) with 3 doubles, 3 homers and 5 RBI.

TRENDING VS. INTERLEAGUE: Corbin Carroll has hit safely in 5 straight interleague matchups (July 21-23 vs. Astros and July 28-29 @ Tigers)...batting .300 with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 2 RBI, 1 walk, 1 stolen base and only 3 strikeouts.

 Since 2023, Carroll's 12 triples in interleague matchups are second in the Majors, behind Jarren Duran/ BOS (13).

ON THE ROAD: Ketel Marte, since June 1, has reached in 22 of his last 25 road games, hitting .368 (35-for-95)/.459 OBP/.663 SLG/1.123 OPS with 7 doubles, 7 homers, 18 RBI and 16 walks (13 K).

• **Eugenio Suárez**, since July 7, has reached safely in 8 of his 11 games with 8 hits, including 2 doubles and 3 homers, 6 RBI, 3 walks and 3 hit-by-pitches.

LEADERBOARD CHECK-IN: Eugenio Suárez, since June 1, ranks among MLB leaders in homers (1st, 21), RBI (1st, 45), extra-base hits (2nd, 28), total bases (2nd, 117), SLG (3rd, .669) and OPS (4th, 1.001).

- **Ketel Marte**, since June 1, ranks among MLB leaders in OPS (8th, .958).
- **Corbin Carroll**, since June 1, ranks among MLB leaders in triples (1st, 8).

JULY FREE PASSES: Since July 1, the D-backs' 81 walks rank third in the NL, behind the Braves (90) and Mets (82), while their 9.0 pct. walk rate ranks fifth in the NL, behind the Braves (10.0), Mets (9.6), Reds (9.2) and Cubs (9.1).

ON DECK - ATHLETICS: Following today's series finale, the D-backs head west to Sacramento for their final 3-game series of the road trip against the Athletics.

- The D-backs have won each of their last 2 series vs. Athletics (2-1 from June 28-30, 2024 @ home; 2-1 from May 15-17 on the road).
- During Spring Training, the D-backs played 2 games vs. Athletics in Las Vegas (March 8-9), home of their Triple-A affiliate, the Aviators, splitting the matchups.

NEXT STARTER: RHP MERRILL KELLY (9-6, 3.22)

- On July 26 @ Pirates, took the loss after allowing 1 earned run over 6.2 innings on 6 hits (1 BB, 3 K).
- Has allowed 2 runs or fewer in 4 straight starts...in the span, is 2-2 with a 1.82 ERA (5 ER in 24.2 IP), opponent .167 AVG (14-for-84), 0.93 WHIP and 18 strikeouts.
- Will make his third career start vs. Athletics...earned the win in his last start on the road on May 15, 2023 (W; 1 ER in 7.0 IP, 4 H, 1 BB, 9 K).

HOW HE STARTED: D-backs' second-round pick (No. 56) in the 2019 draft.

- Named D-backs' 2021 Minor League Pitcher of the Year after going 7-4 with a 3.17 ERA (41 ER in 116.1 IP) with 163 strikeouts (T-4th in MiLB) over 22 starts between High-A Hillsboro and Double-A Amarillo.
- Attended the University of Oregon...as a junior in 2019, was First-Team All-Pac-12, led the conference with 104 strikeouts and finished fourth in the nation with a 14.40 K/9 IP.
- A Nevada native, attended Basic High School in Henderson where he was a shortstop and pitcher.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: Making his 13th start (seventh road).

- Has won 3 straight day starts, going 3-0 with a 1.45 ERA (3 ER in 18.2 IP), opponent .143 AVG, 0.64 WHIP, 3 walks and 13 strikeouts.
- In his last 8 starts, is 4-0 (team is 7-1) with a 1.99 ERA (11 R-10 ER in 45.1 IP), opponent .182AVG/.327 SLG, 0.93 WHIP and 35 strikeouts.
- In his last 4 road starts (team is 3-1), is 1-0 with a 2.61 ERA (6 ER in 20.2 IP), opponent .145 AVG and 16 strikeouts.
- Has allowed 2 runs or fewer in 10 of his 12 starts (5-2, 2.80 ERA).
- In 10 July starts (7 quality) dating back to July 31, 2023, has gone 5-0 with a 2.47 ERA (17 ER in 62.0 IP), opponent .198 AVG/.599 OPS, 0.97 WHIP and 45 strikeouts...the D-backs are 9-1 in those starts and have outscored their opponents 71-24.
- Since 2022, his 18 starts of 6.0+ innings with 90 pitches or fewer are the most by a D-back starter, ahead of Zac Gallen (16).

LAST START: Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed the game's lone hit (T. Pham triple in the second) with 2 walks and 4 strikeouts on July 25 @ Pirates.

VS. TIGERS: Third career start, second @ Comerica Park.

- Won his lone start @ Comerica Park on June 10, 2023, tossing 5.2 scoreless innings on 4 hits with 2 walks and 4 strikeouts.
- In 2 career starts, is 1-1 with a 7.45 ERA (8 ER in 9.2 IP) and 8 strikeouts.

VS. AL CENTRAL: In his last 2 starts, is 1-0 with a 1.50 ERA (2 ER in 12.0 IP), opponent .125 AVG/.386 OPS, 0.67 WHIP, 3 walks and 12 strikeouts.

• Has allowed 1 run or fewer in 3 of his last 5 starts (2-1; 4.23 ERA).

FREE PASSES ARE LIMITED: Has allowed 1 walk or fewer in 6 of his 12 starts.

 Has yielded 2 walks or fewer in 23 of his last 27 starts since June 14, 2024 (155.2 innings, 616 BF).
