TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Padres match up in Game two of this three-game series tonight with SF looking to secure a series victory behind rookie **LHP Kyle Harrison**.

- SF needs to win four of its five remaining games to secure a winning record this season, and three of five to finish .500 (81-81).
- The Giants are seeking a fourth-straight series victory here at home...their last home series loss came at the hands of the Braves from August 25-27 (lost two-of-three).

CUPCAKE OR COOKIE?: Major League Assistant Coach **Taira Uematsu** celebrates his 40th birthday today.

HOME SWEET HOME: SF is 44-32 (.579) at home this year, the eighth-best home record in the Majors...this is in contrast to its 34-47 (.420) road record, which is 25th in MLB.

- Stats, LLC notes that SF's 15-6 (.714) mark at home vs. NL West teams is the best divisional record in the Majors, leading Atlanta (16-7, .696) and Los Angeles-NL (18-8, .692).
- The home divisional record is also the Giants' third-best since divisions formed in 1969.

ARE YOU, ARE YOU COMIN' TO THE TREE?: The Giants postseason odds on *Fangraphs* have dwindled to 0.1% entering today's game after their tough road trip.

Five games remain on the Giants' regular season schedule and they enter today 4.5 games behind the Cubs for the third and final Wild Card spot in the NL...the Giants also trail the Marlins by 3.5 games and the Reds by 2.0 games.

WEAPON X: RHP Logan Webb fired his second career complete game (both this season) and is one of seven pitchers in the Majors this season to throw multiple complete games.

- Webb's 216.0 innings now pace the Major Leagues by 12.1 innings ahead of Arizona's Zac Gallen (203.2)...the Rocklin native is trying to become the first Giant to lead the Majors in innings pitched since Gaylord Perry did so in 1970.
- His 3.25 ERA is fourth-lowest in the National League behind Blake Snell (2.25), Kodai Senga (2.96) and Justin Steele (3.00) but the only one of those three to rank in the top-10 in the NL in innings pitched is Snell (10th) at 180.0, 36 fewer than Webb.
- ▶ Webb's 4.9 fWAR enters the day tied for fifth-best in the Majors and tied for third-best in the NL behind Zack Wheeler (5.8, leads MLB overall) and Spencer Strider (5.4).
- After last night's no-walk performance, Webb's BB/9ip ratio this year is down to 1.29...the last Giants pitcher to throw as many innings as Webb with a BB/9ip ratio that low was Juan Marichal in 1968 (1.27) (SIS).

BE LIKE MIKE: OF Michael Conforto logged his 11th gamewinning RBI of the season last night with his 8th-inning, goahead single.

 Conforto's 11 game-winning RBI are tied for most on the team with OF Joc Pederson.

DRIP, DROP: SF dons the City Connect Creamsicle jerseys one last time in 2023 tonight.

- The Giants are 26-9 with a +57 run differential all-time when wearing the City Connects since they were introduced in 2021.
- ▶ This season, SF is 9-3 in the Tuesday-night drip.

KYYYYYLE: LHP Kyle Harrison makes his seventh career MLB start tonight and second since being recalled last week.

- ► Harrison held the Dodgers to two runs on three hits over 5.1 innings last Thursday at Chavez Ravine in a no-decision.
- It'll be his first time facing an opponent for the second time as the youngster faced San Diego on September 2 and Petco Park (L, 5.2ip, 6h, 6r, 6er, 4hr).
- 30 of Harrison's 31 strikeouts at the MLB level have come at the hands of right-handed batters...Harrison struck out his first (and only) lefty in MLB so far last time out (LAD's Freddie Freeman).
- Righties are hitting .200 (17x85) with five homers off of Harrison in his brief MLB stint...lefties are 12-for-31 (.387) with three homers.

HE MUST WORKOUT...: IF Marco Luciano has hit safely in each of his five games since being recalled last week, going 6-for-16 (.375) with two doubles and three walks.

- In a very small sample size (he's played only nine MLB games total), Luciano has an average exit velocity of 95.1 mph according to Statcast.
- ▶ For comparison's sake, **OF Joc Pederson** leads SF with a 92.4 mph average exit velo this year (18th-best in MLB).
- For what it's worth (again, very small sample) but OF Tyler
 Fitzgerald has also hit the ball hard in his first five games (91.5 mph average exit velo).

ROOK TO BISHOP FOUR: Speaking of rookies, the Giants have had 422 combined games this year started by rookies (397 starts from position players and 25 from pithcers)...according to *Stats, LLC* that total is the third-highest in the SF-era.



WITH THE GIANTS: Made his MLB debut on Aug. 22 at Philadelphia...was selected in the third round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of De La Salle High School (Concord, CA).

TODAY'S GAME: Slated to make his second-career start against San Diego after allowing four home runs (six earned runs) at Petco Park during his start on Sept 2...Harrison's four homers allowed made him one of three Giants rookies since 2000 to allow four or more home runs in a game (**Kevin Correia** allowed four on Sept. 21, 2003 at LAD and **Matt Cain** allowed four on May 5, 2006 at PHI).

LAST OUTING: Harrison put together one of the better starts of his young career on Thursday at Los Angeles-NL...took a no-decision while allowing two runs on three hits with two strike outs and a walk...Harrison's two runs came on a J.D. Martinez solo home run and Kike Hernández sacrifice fly.

MATCHUPS: Harrison's rough start against San Diego earlier this month saw him allow homers (among active players) to Juan Soto, Xander Bogaerts and Garrett Cooper...the lefty also faced San Diego's Triple-A affiliate El Paso twice this season (April 4 and 9), where he faced Fernando Tatis Jr. (0x0, 3bb) and Matthew Batten (0x1, 2bb) in both his starts.

THE PUNCHES...: His strikeout rate has nearly cut in half over his last few starts, as he struck out 21 batters over 15.1 innings in his first three games (12.33 K/9) and has since struck out 10 through 14.1 innings over his last three starts (6.28 K/9).

THE WAIT IS OVER: Harrison struck out the first left-handed batter of his career in his last start after catching Freddie Freeman looking in the 1st inning...he had struck out 29 straight righties to start his career before that strikeout to Freeman.

THE HOMERS...: After allowing a 4th inning homer to J.D. Martinez in his last start, Harrison has given up the most home runs (eight) in a player's first six career games in franchise history...Harrison has allowed 19 total runs at the big league level so far...12 of those 19 have been scored on homers (63.1%).

BACK ON TOP: The top of the order hasn't fared well against Harrison in his six career games, as opponents who are 1-3 in the lineup are batting .174 (8x46) against him (*Stats, LLC*)...that average is the third-best in MLB since the start of August (min. 50 batters faced).

THINGS LEFT TO LEARN?: Since his debut with SF, however, lefties have given Harrison quite a bit of trouble...they've gone 12-for-31 (.387) off Harrison with five XBH (two doubles, three homers)... righties at the MLB-level are 17-for-85 (.200) vs. Harrison with eight XBH (two doubles, one triple, five homers).

GRAB SOME PINE, MEAT: Harrison logged 14 strikeouts through his first 30 career batters faced, the third-most by a starter since 1901 (other: WSH's Stephen Strasburg with 17 in 2010, MIL's Freddy Peralta with 15 in 2018)...he also became the only left-handed pitcher in the modern era to strike out 40% or more of the batters he faced through his first two starts (*OptaSTATS*).

RAKING IN THE AWARDS: In addition to being the No. 1 ranked player in the SF system on *MLB.com*, Harrison is the game's No. 20 overall prospect and top left-hander...he has earned 10 awards on MiLB.com including two Triple-A Pitcher of the Week awards this year.

TIME ON THE IL: After returning from a hamstring strain on July 31, Harrison pitched in four Minor League games, three for Triple-A Sacramento, posting a 3.86 ERA (4er, 9.1ip) with 13 strikeouts at Triple-A...he suffered a moderate hamstring strain on July 5 while training in between starts and did not pitch in the Futures Game.

JOINING THE PARTY: The lefty was the Giants' third draft pick from the 2020 draft to make his debut, joining C Patrick Bailey and IF Casey Schmitt.

HE'S NOT ALONE: Harrison was the 11th out of the 12 Giants to make their MLB debut this season, and fourth pitcher...he also became the first Giants pitcher to start in his MLB debut since **RHP Logan Webb** on August 17, 2019 at Arizona.
