TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros continue their 10-game road trip with the first game of a three-game series against the Colorado Rockies at Coors Field in Denver, CO. **RHP Cody Bolton** will make his first career start this evening opposite **RHP Ryan Feltner** and the Rockies.

ABOUT BOLTON: **RHP Cody Bolton** is set to make the first start of his career...made his only appearance with the Astros on March 31 vs. BOS, in that outing he allowed one run on three hits and one walk with five strikeouts in three innings...marked his first career save...last season, he split the season between the Mariners, Guardians and Astros organizations...appeared in one MLB game with the Guardians (3ER/2IP) and 11 minor league games between the three organizations...the right-handed pitcher has pitched in each of the last four Major League seasons with the Pirates (2023), Mariners (2024), Guardians (2025) and Astros (2026)...has combined to go 1-0-1 with a 5.60 ERA (28ER/45IP) in his 35 career appearances, all coming in relief... has recorded 45 strikeouts in his 45.0 innings of work.

SUSTAINED SUCCESS: Dating back to the 2015 season, the Astros have made nine postseason appearances in 12 seasons, winning seven division titles, four AL pennants (2017, 2019, 2021, 2022) and two WS titles (2017, 2022)...in that span, the Astros became the only team in history to advance to seven consecutive ALCS (2017-23) and posted the second-most wins in the Majors (982), trailing only the Dodgers (1,043).

NEW FACES: The Astros focused their offseason efforts on acquiring pitching, landing **RHP Mike Burrows** and **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** in trades and **RHP Tatsuya Imai** and **RHP Ryan Weiss** off the international free agent market...they also added a Rule 5 pick in **RHP Roddery Muñoz**, the Astros first Rule 5 selection since the 2017 Rule 5 Draft.

AT THE HELM: Manager **Joe Espada** is in his third season as the Astros skipper...in 2025, for the second consecutive season, Espada and his staff were forced to deal with an extremely high number of injuries...despite an ever-changing roster that often was missing key players, to his credit, Espada managed to navigate his club to an 87-75 record, finishing in a tie for the final AL Wild Card berth (lost tiebreaker to DET).

ROAD WARRIORS: Tonight is the fourth game of a 10-game road trip for the Astros...after this three-game set at COL, they will travel to Seattle for a four-game series at T-Mobile Park (Fri-Mon)... the Astros are 1-2 so far on this trip...Houston went 41-40 on the road last season.

YESTERDAY'S GAME: The Houston Astros were defeated by the Athletics, 10-12, yesterday at Sutter Health Park in West Sacramento, CA...**RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (4.0 IP, 5 H, 3 ER, 3 BB, 4 SO) made his second start of the season...**DH Yordan Alvarez** (1x4, HR, 2 RBI, 2 BB), **1B Christian Walker** (1x5, HR, 2 RBI) and **CF Jake Meyers** (2x4, HR, RBI, BB) each homered for the Astros.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY: The Astros would like to wish **LHP Bennett Sousa** a happy 31st birthday.

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVES: The Houston Astros have reinstated **RHP Enyel De Los Santos** from the 15-day IL and **IF Isaac Paredes** from the Bereavement List...to make room for them on the active roster, the Astros have designated **RHP Roddery Muñoz** for assignment and optioned **IF Shay Whitcomb** to Triple A Sugar Land.

AL PLAYER OF THE WEEK: **LF Yordan Alvarez** was named the American League Player of the Week for the week of March 30-April 5...Alvarez batted .471 (8x17) with two doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, seven walks and a 1.733 OPS for the week...marked the fourth time that Alvarez has been named the AL Player of the Week.

AGAINST THE ROCKIES: The Astros and Rockies each other tonight for the first of six scheduled matchups in 2026...the Astros went 4-2 against the Rockies in the in 2025, including a 2-1 record at Coors Field...the Astros own a 110-87 all-time record against the Rockies...the Rockies will travel to Daikin Park for a three-game series from April 14-16.

LEAGUE LEADERS: The Astros lead the Majors in runs (70), doubles (28) total bases (168), hits (98), walks (61), OBP (.396) and OPS (.880)...individually, **LF Yordan Alvarez** leads the Majors in OBP (.578) SLG (.900) and OPS (1.478), while ranking tied for first in runs (10) with teammate **IF Jose Altuve**...**1B Christian Walker** leads the Majors in doubles (6).

HOT START: The Astros have scored 70 runs this season, which is the most in the Majors...the 70 runs are also the most in the first 10 games to begin a season in franchise history, directly ahead of the 2004 season, where there Astros scored 68 runs in the first 10 games of the season.

YORDAN'S UPCOMING MILESTONES: **LF Yordan Alvarez** recorded his 174th career home run yesterday at ATH...the home run tied him with franchise icon **OF George Springer** for seventh on the Astros all-time list...next up on the Astros all-time list is **3B Alex Bregman** (191 HR).

WALK THIS WAY: **LF Yordan Alvarez** walked a career-high tying four times on Saturday at ATH...marked the second time in his career, he's recorded a four-walk game, also Aug. 20, 2019 vs. DET...Alvarez also tied the franchise record for walks in a nine inning game...the last Astros player to record four walks in a nine inning game was **3B Alex Bregman** on June 3, 2023 vs. LAA...**1B Jeff Bagwell** holds the franchise record for walks in a single game with six on Aug. 20, 1999 at MIA, but the game went 16 innings.

FREE PASSES: The Astros hitters recorded a combined 24 walks in their last two games, which is the second-most in a two-game span in franchise history...the franchise record is 25 walks from April 28-29, 2000 at the Milwaukee Brewers.

LAST APPEARANCE: in his only official pitching appearance this season, worked the final 3.0 innings on March 31 vs. BOS to pick up his first career save in the Astros 9-2 win...tossed 50 pitches in the outing (34 strikes)...marked the Astros first 3.0-inning save since **LHP Colton Gordon** (4IP) picked up the save on Sept. 12, 2025 at ATL.

ABOUT BOLTON: Right-handed hurler is making his first Major League start tonight despite having 4 years of Major League action under his belt...has appeared in Major League games with the Pirates (2023), Mariners (2024), Guardians (2025) and Astros (2026) making 35 career relief appearances...has combined to go 1-0-1 with a 5.60 ERA (28ER/45IP) in the Majors...joined the Astros by signing a 2-year minor league contract on July 24, 2025...finished his 2025 season at Triple A Sugar Land.

BOLTON IN 2026: broke camp with Triple A Sugar Land, but did not pitch in the Space Cowboys opening series before being selected to the Astros Major League roster on March 30...pitched once since his selection, on March 31 vs. BOS.

SPRING TRAINING: was a non-roster invite at Astros Spring Training...made 1 appearance for the Astros on Feb. 22 vs. STL (1ER/0.2IP)...was reassigned to minor league camp on March 2.

VS. THE ROCKIES: has faced the Rockies once in his career, in Game 2 of a doubleheader on April 21, 2024 at COL...tossed a scoreless inning for the Mariners in their 10-2 win.

BOLTON'S JOURNEY: the California native was selected by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the 6th round of the 2017 Draft...traded to the Mariners on Nov. 2, 2023, and then to the Guardians on April 8, 2025...was released by the Guardians on June 6, 2025...was injured at the time of his release...signed by the Astros to a 2-year minor league contract on July 24, 2025...finished his season in the Astros organization.

COMMANDER CODY: is just the third player with the first name of Cody to appear in a game with the Astros...he joined **IF Cody Ransom** (19g in 2007) and **C Cody Clark** (16g in 2013).

CAREER: has appeared in the Majors with Houston in each of the last seven seasons (2019-25)...owns a 16-13 record with 17 saves, a 2.82 ERA (104ER/332.1IP) and 454 strikeouts in 332.1 Major League innings...among relievers in club history, ranks 4th in strikeouts (454), 7th in appearances (321) and 12th in innings (332.1).

LAST APPEARANCE: surrendered 4 runs on 5 hits with 1 strikeout and 2 walks yesterday at ATH (44 pitches-26 strikes)...prior to yesterday's outing, he'd posted a 0.37 ERA (1ER/24.1IP), 0.66 WHIP and .100 opponent batting average (8x80) over his last 11 MLB appearances dating back to last season (since Aug. 31, 2025)...leads Astros relievers with 3 appearances of 2.0 or more IP this season.

OPENING DAY: made his 1st career Opening Day roster this season...pitched on Opening Day vs. LAA, tossing 2.1 innings of 1-run ball, allowing his only run on a solo homer by Mike Trout...dazzled hitters with an uptick in velocity, including throwing a 98.8 mph 4-seam fastball on a strikeout of **IF Yoán Moncada**...marked the hardest pitch thrown in his career.

2025 SEASON: went 3-1 with a 1.69 ERA (6ER/32IP), a 0.88 WHIP, .152 opponent average and 9.84 SO/9IP through 11 Major League appearances (three starts)...also made 22 total appearances (19 starts) with Triple A Sugar Land this season, going 5-8 with a 5.27 ERA (58ER/99IP)...recorded a 21.0-inning scoreless streak from Aug. 23 through the end of the 2025 season.

ABOUT BLUBAUGH: entered the 2026 season as the Astros No. 4 prospect and as having the "Best Slider" according to *Baseball America*.

OFF THE IL: was activated from the 15-day IL (right knee strain) prior to today's game and will be making his season debut with his 1st appearance...takes the roster spot of RHP Roddery Muñoz, who was designated for assignment.

REHAB ASSIGNMENT: was scoreless over 4 minor league appearances (4.1 IP) as part of his rehab assignment, including 2 with Triple A Sugar Land and 2 with Double A Corpus Christi...most-recently appeared with Corpus Christi on Friday vs. Frisco, working a perfect 1.0 inning with 1 strikeout (11 pitches-10 strikes)...made just 1 official Spring Training appearance (March 20 vs. MIA) before being shut down with his knee strain.

2025 SEASON: was a strong contributor out of the Astros bullpen in the second half after signing an MLB contract on Aug. 7...recorded a 4.03 ERA (10 ER/22.1 IP) and 9.7 SO/9IP through 22 appearances with the Astros...posted a 1.13 ERA (2ER/16.0IP) through his first 16 appearances with the Astros last season...began the year with ATL, where he posted a 4.53 ERA (22ER/43.2IP) through 43 games before being designated for assignment on July 30.
