TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs former Reds Media Relations intern **Zach Weber's Mets** and the fourth game (1-2) of a 6-game homestand that includes a weekend series loss to the **Diamondbacks** (1-2).

- Following Wed's game here vs the **Mets**, the Reds will return to **New York** for a brief 3-game road trip against the **Yankees** (6/19-6/21).

TOUGH SLEDDING: The Reds have dropped 8 of their last 10 games and 12 of their last 16.

- Following the 6/6 loss at **StL**, fell below .500 for the first time since they were 0-1 to open the 2026 season...enter tonight's game a season-high 4 games under .500 for the second time (also: Fri, 32-36).
- Went 20-11 (.645) to begin the year...entered May a season-high 9 games over .500 and in first place in the NL Central (+1.0)...ended the month 2 games over .500 and in fifth place (-6.0).
- Beginning 5/1, have gone 13-26 (.333).

STRUGGLING AGAINST PEERS: The Reds are 2-13 (.133) vs their NL Central counterparts and 16-27 (.372) vs all National League opponents.

- Of their 25 games remaining until the All-Star break, 19 will be against National League teams, including 13 within the Central Division.

LOSSES AFTER LEADING: The Reds have lost 18 games this season in which they held a lead, including each of their last 7 losses.

- 16 of those 18 total losses have occurred since 5/2.
- Have lost 11 games in which they were tied or led after the bottom of the 7th inning, including each of their last 3 losses.

DECIDED BY 2 RUNS OR FEWER: The Reds yesterday dropped to 19-11 (.633) in games decided by 2 runs or fewer...those 19 wins rank T4th in the majors.

- Won each of their first 12 games decided by 2 runs or fewer.
- Are 11-8 this season in 1-run games.

BRING 'EM ON: The Reds own a 22-24 record (.478) this season against opponents entering play with a .500-or-better winning percentage but are 13-27 (.327) vs teams currently at or above .500.

- Have dropped 21 of their last 28 games vs teams entering play with a .500-or-better winning percentage.
- Have the toughest remaining schedule in the majors based on opponents' winning percentage (.535)...the **Mets** are second (.532).

MISSED OPPORTUNITIES: Over their last 12 games since 6/1, Reds batters are 12-for-89 with runners in scoring position (.135/.240/.258, 19r, 3hr).

- Overall with runners in scoring position Cin is slashing .215/.313/.367.

FOR STARTERS: Reds starting pitchers have combined for a 3.30 ERA (57.1ip, 24r/21er) over the club's last 11 games (since 6/2 vs **KC**), the third-lowest mark in the majors during that time.

POWER SURGE: The Reds have homered 67 times over their last 47 games (since 4/21 at **TB**), sixth-most in the majors during that time and just 5 fewer than the **WSox**, who've hit a Major League-leading 72hr in that span.

- Are on pace to hit 205 homers this season, which would be the 10th time in franchise history they'd reach the 200-HR mark.
- Have hit 18 homers to the opposite field this year, most in the majors.
- Have hit 52 homers at **Great American Ball Park** in 2026, T1st among all Major League teams at their home venue (also: **Bal & Ath**)...have homered in 13 straight home games.
- 135 of their 293 runs scored this year have come via HR (46.1%, 3rd).
- Are 1 of 3 teams in the majors to boast 5 players with 9 or more HR (also: **NYN** and **Ath**).

SERIES NOTES:

- The Reds and **Mets** are meeting for the second time in 2026...Cin took 2 of 3 at **Citi Field** from 5/25-5/27.
- Last season, the final Wild Card spot in the National League Postseason field came down to the Reds and **Mets**...although the 2 clubs each finished the year with an 83-79 record, Cin earned its first trip to the Postseason since 2020 by virtue of winning the season series.
- Dating back to 9/24/13, the Reds are 27-47 vs **NYM**, including a 14-game losing streak from 9/7/14 to 9/7/16 that ranks as Cin's longest-ever skid against the **Mets** and was its longest against any team since a 16-game losing streak vs **AZ** from 5/8/01 to 8/13/03.
- The **Mets'** .609 winning percentage (42-27) at **Great American Ball Park** is the highest of any National League team.

NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM: The Reds have avoided being swept in 43 consecutive home series (min. 1g)...it's their longest such streak since 9/19/11-9/25/13 when the Reds eluded a series sweep at **Great American Ball Park** in a franchise-record 52 consecutive home series.

- The Reds avoided the sweep in all 26 of their series last year at **GABP**...only the Cin teams of 1940, 1943, 1944, 1994, and 2012 ran the home schedule without being broomed.

NOELVI? NO PROBLEM: In yesterday's 5-3 loss vs **AZ**, **OF Noelvi Marte** belted his third home run in as many games when he hit a 448-foot solo shot off **Zac Gallen** in the 6th inning.

- Marked the longest home run hit by a Reds batter this season and the longest since **Elly De La Cruz** hit a 451-footer on 5/27/25 at **KC**.
- Marte's** became the longest homer hit here at **GABP** since **Rece Hinds** hit a 454-foot HR on 7/13/24 vs **Mia**.

ALL-STAR BALLOTS: Major League Baseball opened fan voting for the 2026 All-Star Game, using a 2-phase system to select all starters.

- Fans can cast their ballots online and via mobile devices on all MLB platforms, including the MLB App, the MLB Ballpark App, and at MLB.com/Vote.
- Phase 1 runs 6/3-6/25 with up to 5 votes per day; top finalists advance.
- League leaders in Phase 1 automatically earn starting spots.
- Elly De La Cruz** is currently in third place among NL shortstops with 473,485 votes...he trails **Wsh's CJ Abrams** (579,796) and **LAD's Mookie Betts** (567,566).
- Eugenio Suárez** (DH) and **Sal Stewart** (1B) are among the top 10 vote-getters at their respective positions.
- Phase 2 runs 6/29-7/2 with reset totals to choose the rest of the starters.
- Full All-Star rosters will be announced on 7/4.
- The 2026 Midsummer Classic will be held on 7/14 in **Philadelphia**.
