NATIONALS NEWS

MEET THE METS
The Washington Nationals open a four-game series against the New York Mets on Monday night...Washington has won three consecutive series over New York since Aug. 19-21, 2025, including a series victory earlier this season at Citi Field, April 28-30...The Nationals have won or split their last three home series against the Mets since July 1-4, 2024.

- The Nationals are in a stretch of 16 straight games without a day off that started on May 12 at Cincinnati... Washington's next day off is scheduled for May 28 at home...The Nationals are 4-2 during this stretch so far.

WINNING WAYS
Coming off a series victory over the Baltimore Orioles, the Nationals have won four of six, seven of 11, eight of 13 and 12 of 20 games since April 25...They have won five of their last seven series and have won five of their last seven home games after starting the season 3-12 through their first 15 home games.

- In the 12 wins, the pitching staff has recorded a 2.51 ERA and a .207 opponents' average.
- Per Baseball-Reference.com, the Nationals have the hardest strength of schedule in Major League Baseball with their opponents averaging 0.3 runs per game more than the league average team.

HOMER HAPPY
Washington's 20 home runs since May 6 are the most in the National League and behind only the Chicago White Sox (21) for the most in Major League Baseball...Following the Nationals are the Philadelphia Phillies (18)...The Nationals have homered at least once in nine of the 11 games since May 6.

- Daylen Lile's** four homers are tied for fourth in Major League Baseball over this stretch.
- With homers on Saturday and Sunday, **Jacob Young** has gone deep in back-to-back games for the first time in his career...His five home runs in 168 plate appearances this season are a career high...It took him 1,002 plate appearances to hit five total home runs from 2023-25.

SPEAKING OF DAYLEN...
Daylen Lile is hitting .348 (16-for-46) with .696 slugging percentage (4 2B, 4 HR), 11 RBI, three walks, two stolen bases and 10 runs scored in his last 12 games...He's hit safely in 10 of the 12 and has reached safely in 11 of the 12.

- Lile is 12-for-30 (.400) with two doubles and four homers (.867 SLG) in his last seven games.
- Thanks to this stretch, Lile is now tied for sixth in the National League with 12 doubles.

OUT OF THIS WORLD
CJ Abrams ranks among National League hitters in RBI (3rd, 38), on-base percentage (6th, .388), OPS (8th, .918), wRC+ (8th, 155) and wOBA (8th, .399).

- He is hitting .338 (24-for-71) with seven doubles, a triple, two homers, 17 RBI, seven walks, two stolen bases and 13 runs in his last 18 games...He's reached safely in 15 of the 18 (.397 OBP) and is slugging .549 during the stretch.

PRETTY OFFENSIVE
The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 5.43 runs per game and with 255 runs scored this season.

- Washington has scored 39 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 97 runs in the seventh inning or later.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 27 times this season, the most in Major League Baseball.

GOOD WOOD
James Wood leads MLB with an average exit velo of 96.5 MPH ahead of **O'Neil Cruz** (96.0).

- Wood is one of three players in Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (3) and **O'Neil Cruz** (3).
- Wood's 29 barrels (at least 98 MPH exit velo/26 degree launch angle) are the most in MLB ahead of **Kyle Schwarber** (26) and his 56 batted balls over 100 MPH are tied for second in MLB behind **O'Neil Cruz** (58).

ACE OF BASES
The Nationals are the best baserunning team according to Baseball Savant...They lead Major League Baseball with five baserunning runs (*A Statcast metric designed to express the overall value of a baserunner, measured in runs created (or lost) via stealing bases and taking extra bases on the basepaths.*)

- According to FanGraphs, Washington leads Major League Baseball in their baserunning metric, baserunning runs above average, at 4.8...Baserunning runs above average is *all encompassing baserunning statistic that turns stolen bases, caught stealings, and other base running plays (taking extra bases, being thrown out on the bases, etc) into runs above and below average.*
- Nasim Nuñez** leads Major League Baseball with four baserunning runs and is third with 3.2 baserunning runs above average...His 19 stolen bases lead the National League are second in Major League Baseball behind Cleveland's **Jose Ramirez** (20).

FARM REPORT

STREA-KING TO ROCHESTER
Shortstop **Seaver King** has reached base safely in all 34 games this season, the second-longest active streak in Minor League Baseball and the third-longest streak in MiLB overall this season...He was promoted to Triple-A Rochester on Monday...King ranks in Washington's system in triples (1st, 3rd), average (2nd, .336), hits (2nd, 46), doubles (T3rd, 10), runs (T3rd, 33) and extra-base hits (4th, 18).

CAREER

Tall right-hander from the University of Oklahoma developed into a reliable member of Washington's starting rotation and a leader in the clubhouse.

- Ranks tied for first in Major League Baseball with 75 starts since the start of the 2024 season with San Francisco's **Logan Webb** and New York's **Freddy Peralta**...His 410.1 innings pitched since 2024 are seventh most.
- After making 33 starts in 2024 and 2025, he joined **Max Scherzer** (2015-16) as the only two pitchers in Nationals history to start at least 33 games in back-to-back seasons.
- Had the "Best Control" in Washington's system, per *Baseball America*, entering the 2023 season.

LAST START

Irvin tossed 3.0 innings, allowed five earned runs on four hits and four walks with four strikeouts against the Cincinnati Reds on May 13.

VS. NEW YORK

Irvin is set to make his ninth career start against the Mets, the most of any opponent...He holds a 2-4 record against New York with a 4.71 ERA (26 ER/49.2 IP).

CURVIN' IRVIN

Opponents are batting just .129 (4-for-31) against Irvin's curveball...The .129 opponents' slugging percentage ranks third best among all qualified pitchers for the curveball.

- He has not given up an extra-base hit on his curveball this season.

2025

Was tied for second in Major League Baseball with 33 starts and ninth in the National League with 180.0 innings pitched.

- Matched a career high with 8.0 shutout innings against San Francisco on May 24...The game was completed in 1 hour, 52 minutes, tied for third fastest game in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...Irvin has pitched in two of the top six fastest games in Nationals history.
- Tossed 7.1 innings on April 25 vs. New York (NL)...Allowed one earned run on five hits with four strikeouts and one walk.
- Worked 7.0 innings or more in four starts this season...He went 3-0 in those games.
- Went 6-5 in games he completed 6.0 innings...Pitched to a 4.32 ERA in those 16 games.
- The Nationals 15 wins in his starts were the most for any Nationals starter.

2024

In first full Major League season, his 33 starts were tied for the most in MLB...Led Washington and ranked fifth in the National League with 187.2 innings pitched.

- Also led the Nationals and ranked 10th in the National League with a 1.20 WHIP...Tied MacKenzie Gore for the team lead with 10 wins.
- Led Major League pitchers with six defensive runs saved, according to FanGraphs.com and Sports Info Solutions.
