REDBIRD RUNDOWN: The defending 2019 NL Central Champion St. Louis Cardinals wrap up their five-day, eight-game Windy City road trip with this afternoon's doubleheader against the Chicago Cubs at Wrigley Field ... The Cardinals opened their Chicago road trip by taking two of three from the White Sox this weekend ... the 3rd of 10 scheduled doubleheaders of 2020 (3rd DH in last 5 days), St. Louis is in the midst of playing 53 games over the final 44 days of the season.

ON DECK: Beginning tomorrow, St. Louis opens a 12-game homestand against the Cincinnati Reds (4G), Kansas City Royals (3G), Pittsburgh Pirates (2G DH), and Cleveland Indians (3G) ... Their last home game was Sunday, July 26 vs. Pittsburgh, 2003 ... The 12-game homestand is the team's longest since a 12-gamer from May 26-June 8, 2003.

JACK IS BACK: Jack Flaherty's outing today marks 24 days of rest since his Opening Day start vs. Pittsburgh (July 24) ... The right-hander makes his 11th career appearance (10th start) vs. the Cubbies today, tying Milwaukee for his most against any opponent ... Since his Major League debut (Sept. 1, 2017), no opposing pitcher has fanned more Cubs than Flaherty's 59 strikeouts in 50 IP (10.62 SO/IP).

GOLDY-LOCKS AND THE THREE CUBBY BEARS: In his first 11 games this season, Paul Goldschmidt ranks 6th in the NL in batting average (.359, 14-39), 8th in on-base pct. (.436), 14th in OPS (.970), and 3rd in BABIP (.429) ... Among active MLB leaders against the Cubs, Goldy, ranks 1st in career OPS (1.130), 2nd in on-base pct (.431) and slugging pct. (.622), and 3rd in batting average (.332).

THE DIRTY DOZEN: Jesus Cruz joined Ricardo Sánchez, Nabil Crismatt, John Nogowski, Roel Ramírez, Seth Elledge, Rob Kaminsky, Dylan Carlson, Jake Woodford, Max Schrock, Kwang Hyun Kim, and Kodi Whitley as the 12th Cardinal to make MLB debuts this season (10th in last five games), tying Miami for most in MLB ... Eight Cardinals made MLB debuts last season, while this year's dozen are the club's most since 2013 ... 13 MLB debuts would tie the 1997 Cardinals squad (T-7th-most in franchise history).

DESIGNATED TO HIT: Since the beginning of interleague play (1997-present), the Cardinals lead MLB teams in batting average (.298) and on-base pct. (.371), and rank 2nd to the Red Sox (.513, .881) in slugging pct. (.507) and OPS (.878) from their designated hitters ... Cardinals DHs rank among 2020 MLB leaders in batting average (5th, .306), on-base pct. (4th, .390), slugging pct. (7th, .528), and OPS (6th, 918).

COME ON DOWN!: Twenty-four Cardinals have pitched in the first 11 games, already surpassing their total of 23 from the entire 162 game schedule in 2019 (including position player Jedd Gyorko) ... The group of Cardinals pitchers rank 2nd in MLB behind the Marlins (30) and Pirates (25).

BIRD BYTES: Matt Carpenter's next career walk (645) ties Cardinals Hall of Famer Jim Edmonds for 8th in franchises history ... Andrew Miller has yet to allow a run at Wrigley Field in the regular season, running his scoreless streak to 10 appearances (9.1 IP) Monday; Miller's last run allowed came in Game 4 of the 2016 World Series with Cleveland ... Jesus Cruz (86) and Génesis Cabrera (92) are the only players in MLB history to exclusively wear their respective uniform numbers in a game ... Last night's 4:09 game time was the 2nd-longest nine-inning game at Wrigley Field between the Cardinals and Cubs in history (since 1901), only trailing the 9-8 Cardinals win last season on Sept. 21 (4:24).

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (August 19, 1998): Mark McGwire and Ray Lankford each homered off Terry Mulholland in the 10th inning of a 8-6 Cardinals victory over the Cubs at Wrigley Field. McGwire's two homers that day gave him 49 for the season, one more than Sammy Sosa, who also homered in the extra-inning affair.

CHICAGO CONNECTIONS

Dexter Fowler played two seasons (2015-16) with Chicago...was a member of 2016 World Series champions.

Paul DeJong graduated from Antioch (Ill.) Comm. High School...played college baseball at Illinois State University (2013-15) while majoring in biochemistry and pre-medicine.

Daniel Ponce de Leon was selected by the Cubs in the 14th round of the 2013 MLB Draft, but failed his physical due to concerns about the ulnar nerve placement in his right elbow.

Kolten Wong (August 13, 2016 at Wrigley Field), **Dakota Hudson** (July 28, 2018 at Busch Stadium), **Tyler O'Neill** (April 19, 2018 at Wrigley Field), **Andrew Knizner** (June 2, 2019 at Busch Stadium), **Tommy Edman** (June 8, 2019 at Wrigley Field), **Ricardo Sanchez** (August 17, 2020 at Wrigley Field), **Nabil Crismatt** (August 17, 2020 at Wrigley Field), and **Jesus Cruz** (August 18, 2020 at Wrigley Field) made MLB debuts against the Cubs.

Mike Maddux's younger brother, **Greg Maddux**, was a Hall of Fame pitcher for Chicago for parts of 10 seasons (1986-92, '04-06)...originally selected by the Cubs in the 2nd round of the 1984 MLB draft.

Tommy Edman (junior) and **Nico Hoerner** (freshman) were teammates at Stanford Univ. in 2016.

Cubs VP of Scouting **Dan Kantrovitz** previously served as the Cardinals Scouting Director (2012-14)...was also a Cardinals 25th round draft pick out of Brown University in 2001...took his first job in MLB as the Cardinals Scouting Coord. (2004).

Jason Heyward played the 2015 season with St. Louis...originally traded by Atlanta with **Jordan Walden** to St. Louis for **Tyrell Jenkins** and **Shelby Miller** (Nov. 17, 2014).

As compensation for the departure of Heyward signing with the Cubs, **Dakota Hudson** was selected by St. Louis with the 34th overall pick in the first round of the 2016 MLB draft.

TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his second start of the 2020 season and his first against the Cubs this season. Today marks his 69th career appearance and 68th start.
- Last start was on Opening Day vs. Pittsburgh (July 24) and has 24 days of rest between starts, is a career 1-3 with a 4.75 ERA in 13 starts with 6+ days rest.
- Is 8-1 with an 0.90 ERA in 11 career starts in August. Has posted a .141 opp. BA and allowed just 33 hits in 70.1 innings with 85 strikeouts (0.73 WHIP; 10.92 K/9 IP).
- Since 1920, Flaherty has the lowest career ERA (0.90) and opponent BA (.141) in the month of August (min. 10 starts).
- Has the 4th-lowest day game ERA (2.47) among active pitchers with 20 or more starts, trailing only (Jacob deGrom 1.84, Mike Clevenger 2.27 & Clayton Kershaw 2.40).
- Enters today with a .201 opponent BA since his MLB debut on Sept. 1, 2017, 4th-lowest in MLB over that period (Hader .142, Verlander .183, Cole .196).

LAST TIME OUT

- Made his first career Opening Day start, coming vs. PIT (7/24). Tossed 7.0 innings for his 20th career win. Allowed two runs following 6.2 scoreless before a two-RBI single by Jacob Stallings in the 7th inning broke his career high streak of 25.2 scoreless innings (9/19/19).
- Carried a shutout through 5.0+ innings for the 14th time over the past two seasons.
- At age 24.283, became the 16th youngest Cardinal to make an Opening Day start (since 1904) and youngest since Joe Magrane (Age 24.275) on April 3, 1989 vs. the New York.

- Finished 4th in the National League Cy Young award voting, 13th for NL Most Valuable Player award, and was one of five starting pitchers on the All-MLB Second Team.
- Finalist for the Rawlings Glove Glove award. Was one of eight NL pitchers (and three Cardinals) to record a perfect fielding percentage.
- Established single-season career highs in wins (11), innings pitched (196.1), strikeouts, quality starts and starts.
- His 231 strikeouts ranked 6th in franchise single-season history, trailing only Bob Gibson (1964, 1965, 1968, 1969, 1970).
- Set Cardinals single-season records in strikeouts/ 9 IP (10.59) and percentage of swings that missed (30.7) (in data since 1988). His .192 opponent batting average was 2nd to only Bob Gibson (.184) in 1968.
- Struck out 231, walked 55 and recorded a 2.75 ERA. Since 1885, became only the third pitcher younger than 24-years old to record a season of at least 230 strikeouts, while permitting 55-or-fewer walks to go along with an ERA of 2.75-or-better, joining Clayton Kershaw (2011) and Mark Prior (2003).

CAREER

- In 67 career starts, is 19-7 when receiving 2 runs of support or more, and 15-1 when receiving 3 runs or more.
- At age 24.283, was the 16th youngest Cardinal to make an Opening Day start (since 1904) and youngest since Joe Magrane (Age 24.275) on April 3, 1989 vs. the New York Mets.
- Has struck out 433 batters over his first 67 career games, the most ever by a Cardinal and 12th-most in National League history (since 1908).
- Recorded five double-digit strikeouts games in 2019 and has eight for his career. His eight games with 10+ strikeouts in his first 67 career games are a Cardinals record.
- Is the 3rd Cardinal in franchise history to strike out 180 or more in two of his first three career seasons (2018-19), joining Dizzy Dean (1932-33), and Lance Lynn (2012-13).

- Makes his 10th career start (11th app.) vs. the Cubs, tied for his most against any opponent (MIL).
- Earned the win in his last start vs. CHI (9/29/19) throwing a mere 69 pitches over 7.0 scoreless innings of two-hit ball, coming on the final day of the 2019 season clinching the Cardinals first Division Title since 2015.
- Has held the Cubs to five hits or less in all five starts at Wrigley Field, and has not allowed more than five hits in any of his 10 career appearances vs. CHI, including six appearances of three hits or less.
- Since his MLB debut in 2017, has recorded the most strikeouts against the Cubs of any opposing pitcher with 59 over 10 appearances.
- First career appearance vs. CHI came in 2017, tossing a scoreless inning of relief in a 10-2 loss at Busch Stadium.
