Andrew Vaughn enters the day on a 10-game hitting streak in which he is batting .436 (17-for-39) with 4 HR and 12 RBI.....Vaughn has posted a .465 OBP/.795 SLG/1.260 OPS during the streak.....he is a game away from tying the longest hitting streak of his career (11g from 5/27-6/11, 2024).

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is game 5 (4-0) of a 6-game road trip to Washington (3-0) and Atlanta (1-0).....following this trip and an off day on Thursday, the Brewers return home for 6 games against New York-NL (3g) and Pittsburgh (3g).

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

AT HOME: The team is 36-20 at home, going 13-5-0 in series play.....are 24-11 in the last 35 home games and 13-4 in the last 17.....had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 7/7-7/13.

ON THE ROAD: The team is a Major League-best 32-24 on the road, going 9-7-2 in series play.....are 22-6 in the last 28 road games and 10-1 in the last 11 contests with a current 5-game winning streak, tying a season high (4x).....also had 5-game road winning streaks from 5/25-6/2, 6/19-7/2 and 7/6-7/21.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

COACHES: Associate manager Rickie Weeks (2nd season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (7th season), assistant pitching 6 strategy coach Jim Henderson (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (2nd season), lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf (1st season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (4th season), hitting coach Eric Theisen (1st season), assistant coach Daniel de Mondesert (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd coach season), first base coach Julio Borbón (1st season), third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role)

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made 20 replay challenges this season, going 13-7....their last challenge (won) came on 8/4 at Atlanta as an out call at first base involving Andrew Vaughn was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons (2018-24) and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row.....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseaso eight straight seasons (2017-24), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include 2020.....the Brewers have 734 wins since 2017 (4th in MLB/2nd in National League).

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: All-Star Freddy Peralta, 29, will make his 24th start of the season and first against the Braves.....Peralta last started last Wednesday vs. Chicago-NL and took a 10-3 loss (4ip, 5h, 5r, 5er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 85 pitches).....the team is 14-9 in his starts.....he has 9 quality starts.....opponents are batting .207 (96-for-463, 15hr).....he had a 7-game winning streak over 9 starts snapped in his last outing.....it was also his first home loss of the season.....Peralta was acquired from Seattle with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

RIGHT SAID FRED: Peralta is tied for the Major League lead with Garrett Crochet (BOS) and Max Fried (NYY) with his career-high-tving 12 wins (also 2023).....he is also among National League leaders in opponent AVG (7th, .207), H/9IP (7th, 6.88), ERA (10th, 3.08) and WHIP (10th, 1.13).

FREDDY K-RUEGER: Peralta has 1.083 career strikeouts, trailing only Yoyani Gallardo (1.226) and Ben Sheets (1.206) on the all-time franchise list.

CAREER: Is 65-41 with a 3.69 ERA and 1 save in 201 games/152 starts (880ip, 361er).....is in his eighth Major League season, all with the Brewers (2018-25).....is 57-39 with a 3.67 ERA as a starter (796ip, 325er) and 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA in relief (84ip, 36er).....was an All-Star in 2021 and 2025.....was the Opening Day starter in 2024 and 2025.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 38-20 with a 3.32 ERA in 107 games/79 starts (474.2ip, 175er)....is 7-1 with a 2.13 ERA in 12 starts this season (67.2ip, 16er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 27-21 with a 4.13 ERA in 94 games/73 starts [405.1ip, 186er].....is 5-4 with a 4.19 ERA in 11 starts this season [58ip, 27er].
