



Oriole Park at Camden Yards **2022 Ground Rules** Date: April 10, 2022

RULE #1: Ball striking surfaces, pillars, or facings surrounding dugouts: **Out of Play**





RULE #2: The metal support pipe and pole caps are recessed and

- behind the outfield wall:Ball in flight: Home Run
- Bounding Ball: Out of Play







RULE #3: Batted ball in flight striking grounds crew shed roof in right field and rebounding onto the playing field: **Home Run**





RULE #4: Batted ball in flight striking on top of the out-of-town scoreboard in right field, the top of the wall between the out-of-town scoreboard and the right field foul line, or the railing above this area:





RULE #5: A ball striking the facing of the out-of-town scoreboard in right field, including the top corner, and rebounding onto the







RULE #6: Fair bounding ball striking railing above cement wall down right field line in foul territory: **In Play**

1B iPad Cameras:





A ball that strikes the camera and rebounds onto the playing field is live and in play unless it becomes lodged in the padding or is otherwise deemed unplayable



1B iPad Cameras (Cont.):



A ball that strikes the camera behind the netting and enclosed padding is live and in play unless it becomes lodged or is otherwise deemed unplayable (i.e. goes completely through the netting).
