THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
JUNE 7
2018 - The Astros open a 10-game road trip with a 5-2 win over the Rangers in Arlington...in the contest, **2B Jose Altuve** goes 3x4, **DH Evan Gattis** picks up three RBI and **RHP Gerrit Cole** works 6.0 innings of one-run ball...the win was the first of an undefeated road trip that took the club from Arlington (4-0) to Oakland (3-0) to Kansas City (3-0)...this marks the longest undefeated road trip in club history.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros, who have won 10 of their last 15 games, will play the final game of their nine-game homestand today as they go for a sweep of the visiting A's...**RHP Mike Burrows** will make his team-leading 13th start of the season today and his first against the A's...he'll be opposed by A's rookie **LHP Gage Jump**, who's making just his third Major League start.

ABOUT BURROWS: The 26-year old **RHP Mike Burrows** has been the only starting pitcher in the Astros Opening Day rotation to make every scheduled start this season, which has given him the team lead in starts (12), innings (68.1) and strikeouts (57)... Burrows is new to the organization in 2026, having been acquired from the Pirates this offseason as part of a three-team, six-player trade in which the Astros sent **OF Jacob Melton** and minor league **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays, while the Rays sent **IF Brandon Lowe**, **OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates.

WITH A WIN: The Astros need a win today to secure a winning homestand as they enter today's game 4-4 on the current 'stand...a win would also give the Astros their first sweep of the A's since sweeping a four-game series in Houston from May 13-16, 2024.

ABOUT THE RECORD: In an early look at the standings, at 30-36, the Astros have matched the win total of the A's (30-34) and Twins (30-36) and have just one fewer win than the Rangers (31-33), Orioles (31-34) and Blue Jays (31-34), three teams that are directly ahead of them in the standings...should the Astros win today, it would move their record to five games below .500, a mark they have not been at since they were 8-13 on April 17.

THE LAST 21: Since May 15, the Astros are 13-8 thanks in large part to their pitching, which has produced a 3.51 ERA (73ER/187IP) and a .192 opponent average, which ranks second in the Majors in that span...their bullpen has been even better in those last 21 games, working to a 2.93 ERA (23ER/70.2IP) and posting a league-best .167 opponent average.

TODAY'S PLAY BALL CLINIC: The Astros are celebrating PLAY BALL Weekend presented by Nike this weekend at the ballpark...today, as part of the weekend, the Astros Youth Academy hosted a PLAY BALL Clinic at Daikin Park for 75 Special Olympics Texas athletes...all participants were also given tickets to attend today's game.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY ROBERT!: The Astros would like to wish a Happy Birthday to esteemed radio broadcaster **Robert Ford**...he shares the same birthday with Yankees great **Thurman Munson** and former Astros **Vince Velasquez** and **Roberto Petagine**.

SATURDAY SPECIAL: The Astros scored a season-high in runs yesterday with a 13-2 victory over the A's...**DH Yordan Alvarez** (1x3, 4RBI) hit the club's first grand slam of the season, **LF LaMonte Wade Jr.** (3x5, 3RBI) finished a triple shy of the cycle, and **2B Jose Altuve** (1x2) ripped a solo homer in the rout...**RHP Tatsuya Imai** (2ER/5IP) earned the win, fanning eight in his 5.0 innings.

YESTERDAY'S ROSTER MOVES: Announced yesterday, **C César Salazar** accepted his outright assignment to Triple A Sugar Land and **OF Rhylan Thomas** was unconditionally released...both players were designated for assignment on Thursday.

MAKING THE PLAYS: The Astros have committed the fewest errors in the AL (24) and have posted the best fielding percentage (.989) in the AL, topping the A's (.989) and Royals (.989) by a few percentage points...among all Major League teams, only the Padres (20) and Dodgers (22) have committed fewer errors than the Astros.

VS. THE A'S: The Astros and A's will wrap their three-game series today with the two club's not seeing each other again until a three-game series in Houston from Aug. 21-23...the Astros are 3-2 vs. the A's in 2026 and are looking to reverse their luck vs. the A's this season after going 5-8 against them in 2025...that marked the Astros first season series loss to the A's since the 2020 season (3-7).

ON THE LEADER BOARD: **DH Yordan Alvarez** leads the Majors in OPS (1.084), SLG (.654) and total bases (153) and leads the AL in home runs (22) and RBI (48)...also in the AL, he ranks tied for first in extra-base hits (35), second in batting average (.316), second in OBP (.430), second in hits (74), fourth in runs (45), and tied for fifth in walks (43).

YORDAN'S SLAM: **DH Yordan Alvarez** hit his fifth career grand slam yesterday and shockingly, the first of his career at Daikin Park...Alvarez now ranks fifth in franchise history in grand slams, trailing only **2B Jose Altuve** (7), **3B Alex Bregman** (7), **OF Carlos Lee** (7), and **1B Jeff Bagwell** (6).

YOR-GONE!: **DH Yordan Alvarez** hit his 192nd career regular season home run yesterday, which moved him into sixth in Astros history in home runs, surpassing **3B Alex Bregman**.

KEYSTONE FLIGHTS: **2B Jose Altuve** hit the 260th home run of his career yesterday and his 240th while playing the second base position, surpassing **2B Lou Whitaker** for the 10th-most home runs by a second baseman in MLB history...per Elias, Altuve now immediately trails **2B Ian Kinsler** (246) and **2B Joe Gordon** (246) on that all-time list.

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: **1B Christian Walker** ranks second the AL in RBI with 46, trailing only teammate **DH Yordan Alvarez** (48)...Walker also ranks fifth in the AL in extra-base hits (28), fifth in total bases (122), tied for sixth in home runs (16), and 10th in SLG (.504)...in the field, Walker has not committed an error in 65 games.

BACK WITH A VENGEANCE: **SS Jeremy Peña** is batting .338 (23x68) with three home runs, 12 RBI and a .917 OPS in 18 games since being activated from the IL on May 18...the Astros are 11-7 since his return.

LAST START 6/2 vs. PIT: Got the nod in Tuesday's series-opener vs. former club, the Pirates, and allowed 6 runs (5 ER) on 8 hits through 5.0 innings with 5 walks and 3 strikeouts, surrendering a pair of home runs...his 5 walks marked a career high, surpassing 4 walks on July 5, 2025 at SEA.

ABOUT BURROWS: The 2nd-year starter is making his team-leading 13th start of the season after opening the year as the Astros No. 2 starter...also leads the Astros in innings pitched (68.1) and strikeouts (57)...is the only member of the Astros Opening Day rotation to avoid the Injured List; **RHP Hunter Brown** (right shoulder strain), **RHP Cristian Javier** (Grade 2 right shoulder strain), **RHP Tatsuya Imai** (right arm fatigue) and **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (right shoulder inflammation).

UNCLE CHARLIE: Has held opponents to a .161 average (5x31) with his curveball this season, throwing the pitch at a 14.9-percent rate...conversely, opponents batted .318 (7x22) against his curveball last season when he threw the pitch at an 11.9-percent rate.

VS. ATH: Is set to make his 2nd career start vs. the A's...tossed 4.0 scoreless innings with 3 strikeouts and allowed 5 hits without surrendering a walk vs. the A's on Sept. 21, 2025, at PNC Park...did not factor into the decision of an 11-0 win for the Pirates.

THE JOURNEY: A native of Waterford, CT, Burrows was committed to the University of Connecticut out of high school...the Pirates selected him in the 11th round of the June 2018 draft and signed him to an over-slot bonus to sign and forego his commitment to UConn...spent 6 seasons (2018-23) in the Pirates minor league system before finally debuting in 2024 with a single appearance...pitched the majority of the 2025 season at the Major League level and flashed potential before the Pirates flipped him to Houston this offseason.

THE TRADE: After spending eight seasons (2018-25) in the Pirates organization, the Astros acquired Burrows this offseason in a 3-team, 6-player trade...as part of the deal, the Astros traded **OF Jacob Melton** and minor leaguer **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays...meanwhile, the Rays traded **IF Brandon Lowe**, **OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates, and Burrows got dealt to the Astros.

CONNECTICUT CONNECTION: Native of Connecticut, Burrows is in a small fraternity of Major Leaguers from the Constitution State...only four other Connecticuter's have played for the Astros in their franchise history: **C Brad Ausmus** (1259g), **OF George Springer** (795g), **RHP Bill Dawley** (157g) and **RHP Josh Zeid** (48g).

2025 RECAP: Pitched most of the season with the Pirates, making 23 appearances (19 starts) and going 2-4 with a 3.94 ERA (42ER/96IP)...struck out 97 hitters in 96.0 IP...had two Major League stints on the year, from April 24-25 and from May 21 thru the end of the year...recorded a strong second half with the Pirates, posting a 3.27 ERA (20ER/55IP) in 13 games (10 starts)...in that span, allowed 1-or-fewer runs in 7 of his last 8 appearances, posting a 2.22 ERA (7ER/28.1IP) in those games, which spanned from Aug. 16 thru the end of the year...did not allow a homer over a 26.1-inning span from Aug. 16-Sept. 21...finished tied for third in the NL in strikeouts by a rookie (97).

LAST APPEARANCE (6/4 vs. PIT): Had a solid bounce-back outing on Thurs. night vs. PIT, striking out 3 batters while working around 1 walk in a scoreless 1.0 inning...surrendered 3 runs on 2 hits with 1 walk and 2 strikeouts on Tues. night vs. PIT.

TURN THE PAGE: Prior to his outing on May 29 vs. MIL, he had logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28, striking out 7 while holding opponents to a .148 average (4x27) over that span...his 9-game scoreless streak is the longest by an Astro this season.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: Ranks 7th all-time in appearances (340) among relievers in Astros history, and is closing in on **RHP Ryan Pressly** (342) for 6th on that list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (476)...with his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history.

DAIKIN PARK RANKINGS: With 3 strikeouts on Thurs. night vs. PIT, he surpassed **RHP Octavio Dotel** (247) for the 2nd-most by a reliever in Daikin Park history...his 249 strikeouts at Daikin Park trail only **RHP Brad Lidge** (287) for the most by a reliever in the venue's history...also has 182.0 IP in his career at Daikin Park, trailing **Dotel** (190.1) for the 3rd-most innings pitched by a reliever in the venue's history.

CAREER: In 340 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.93 ERA (114ER/350IP) with 476 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.24 K/9 and a 0.77 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.

VS. ATH: In 32 career regular-season appearances vs. the A's, he's posted a 2.45 ERA (10ER/36.2IP), a 0.93 WHIP, 10.31 SO/9IP and a .165 opponent batting average...his 32 appearances vs. the A's are the 2nd-most among active players, behind only former teammate **RHP Ryne Stanek** (36).
