A Call to Arms

Aaron Civale, who was acquired via trade from Tampa Bay yesterday, will become the 16th different pitcher to start a game for the Brewers this season, the most in the Major Leagues and an all the fitse free this respects. and one shy of the franchise record of 17 set in 1969 as the Seattle Pilots.

Star Power

William Contreras (catcher) and Christian Yelich (outfield) will be in the National League starting lineup at the 2024 All-Star Game.....this is the eighth time in franchise history and first time since 2014 that the team has had multiple All-Star starters..... Carlos Gómez (LF), Jonathan Lucroy (C) and Aramis Ramírez (3B) started in the 2014 Midsummer Classic.

Star Catcher
William Contreras will become just
the third catcher in franchise history
to start an All-Star Game.....Contreras to start an All-Star Game.....Contreras will join **Ted Simmons** (1984) and **Jonathan Lucroy** (2014)....Simmons and Contreras were voted to start by the fans.....this will be the second career All-Star start for Contreras as he started at DH in 2022.

Born Again Christian Christian Yelich has made his third career All-Star Game (also 2018-19) and will be starting for the second time (2019).....prior to this season, Yelich was the last Brewer to start in an All-Star Game

AT HOME: The Brewers are 27-13 at home, going 10-2-1 in series play.....the team has gone 22-6 in its last 28 home games after a 5-7 start.....the Brewers had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 5/29-6/10.....the team has won its last nine home eries.....their last home series loss came from 4/26-4/28 against the Yankees (1-2)

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 25-22 on the road, going 7-6-1 in series play.....the team has gone 12-18 in its last 30 road games after a 13-4 start.....the team had a season-high 4-game road winning streak from 4/9-4/13.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23. replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing **Bud Black** in June (42-54).....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the vinningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff..... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach) and Charlie Greene (bulloen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 21 replay challenges this season, going 13-8....their last challenge (won) came on 7/3 at Colorado as a safe call at first base involving Michael Toglia was overturned (pickoff).

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #36 - RHP TOBIAS MYERS (12g, 11gs, 5-2, 3.26)

MYERS AT A GLANCE: Tobias Myers, 25, will be making his 13th appearance and 12th start of the season.....Myers last pitched last Saturday vs. Chicago-NL in a start and had no decision in the Brewers' 5-3 loss (6ip, 7h, 3r, 3er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr, 1hbp, 2bk, 82 pitches).....he is 4-0 with a 1.44 ERA in his last 5 starts (31.1ip, 20h, 5r, 5er, 8bb, 24k, 2hr).... he is in his fourth stint with the team [4/17, 4/22-5/9 and 5/21-5/31 and 6/5-current].....the team is 6-5 in his starts.....he has 4 quality starts.....opponents are batting .230 [49-for-213, 9hr].....Myers made his Major League debut in a start on 4/23 at Pittsburgh and took a 2-1 loss (5ig. 4h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 4k, 1hr, 1wg, 83 gitches).....he also went 1-1 with a 1.45 ERA in 5 games/3 starts at Triple-A Nashville this season (18.2ip, 13h, 3r, 3er, 7bb, 24k, 2hr)....he signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on 11/10/22.

LAST SEASON: In his first season in the organization, Myers went 10-5 with a 4.93 ERA in 29 games/26 starts between Double-A Biloxi (27g. 26gs) and Triple-A Nashville. (2g).....he led all Brewers Minor League pitchers in wins (10), strikeouts (175) and innings pitched (140.2).....he led the Southern League in strikeouts (168) and innings pitched (137.2) and tied for second in wins (10).....also surrendered a league-leading 30 HR.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Has gone 43-37 with a 4.24 ERA in 141 games/123 starts (620.1ip. 601h. 331r. 292er. 213bb. 636k. 83hr)....has pitched for six organizations: Baltimore (2016-17), Tampa Bay (2017-21), Cleveland (2022), San Francisco (2022), Chicago-AL (2022) and Milwaukee (2023-24).....did not play in the 2020 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic.....was selected by Baltimore in the sixth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Winter Haven (FL) High School.....Myers committed to the University of South Florida prior to being drafted.
