TODAY'S TRANSACTION: The Reds today sent **OF Jake Fraley** (left calf tenderness) on a rehabilitation assignment at AAA-Louisville.

TODAY'S GAME:

- Is Game 2 (0-1) of a 3-game homestand vs **Fredy Quevedo Jr.'s Cubs**.
- The Reds are coming off a brief 3-game trip at **Pit** where they went 1-2.
- Following tomorrow's matinee vs **Chc**, the Reds will embark on a 7-day, 6-game trip at **KC** (Mon-Wed) and against these very same **Cubs** at **Wrigley Field** next weekend.

SERIES NOTES: The Reds and **Cubs** are meeting for the first time in 2025...the teams will square off again next weekend at **Wrigley Field** and 2 more times after that (8/4-8/6 at **Chc** & 9/18-9/21 at **Cin**).

- Cin went 8-5 last season vs **Chc**, and won 3 of the 4 series.
- The Reds are 188-186 vs **Chc** since 2003 and 85-104 since 2014.
- The Redlegs are 97-86 all-time vs the **Cubs** at **Great American Ball Park**, having won 19 of the last 32g here against their division rival.

ELLY MAKING HISTORY: **SS Elly De La Cruz** last night vs **Chc** collected his 300th career hit...at 23 years, 132 days, became the fifth-youngest Red among those who debuted since 1900 to produce 300 hits (*courtesy Elias*).

- De La Cruz** is the fastest Major Leaguer by appearance (310g) since **RBI** became an official stat in 1920 to reach 300 hits (300), 150 **RBI** (153), and 100 stolen bases (118) for his career, surpassing **Fla's Hanley Ramirez** (328g, 2005-2008)...(*courtesy Elias*).
- on 5/11 at **Hou** appeared in his 300th career game, becoming the first Major Leaguer since 1900 with at least 115 extra-base hits and 115 stolen bases through his first 300 career games (*courtesy Elias*).

REIGNING PLAYER OF THE WEEK: **OF Will Benson** on Mon was named National League Player of the Week for 5/12-5/18...for the week, he batted .526 (10-for-19) with 5 HR, 10 **RBI**, a .591 **OBP** and a 1.368 **SLG**...it's his first career selection and the first award for a Red since **Rece Hinds** last July.

- Since his promotion from AAA-Louisville on 5/9, has hit safely in 8 of 11 apps (12-for-32, .375/.459/.938) and has homered 5 times in his last 7 games, including a career-high 4-game HR streak from 5/15-5/18.

STEER CLEAR: **INF/OF Spencer Steer** last night vs **Chc** extended his career-high hitting streak to 11 games (14-for-39, .359).

- It's the second-longest active hitting streak in the majors, behind **Cle's José Ramírez** (16 games).
- Steer** has reached safely in 14 straight games, also a career-high.
- From Opening Day (3/27) through 5/7, **Steer** was slashing .186/.262/.297...in 14 games since then has produced at a .314/.352/.471 clip to raise his overall line to .225/.288/.349.
- Has posted a .761 **OPS** this year vs starting pitchers, including a 1.089 **OPS** vs starters over his last 14 apps (.414/.433/.655).

REHABBERS: Updates on the following Reds who are currently on rehabilitation assignments in the club's minor league system:

- RHP Rhett Lowder** (right forearm strain) on Sun continued his rehab assignment for AAA-Louisville vs **Gwinnett** (1ip, 1bb, 4bf, 12TP)...he was returned from his assignment yesterday with a left oblique strain.
- INF Christian Encarnacion-Strand** (low back inflammation) began his rehab assignment Thu (5/22) with R-ACL Reds and has made 2 apps (2-for-7, 1 2B, 2rbi, 3k).
- OF Jake Fraley** (left calf tenderness) begins his rehabilitation assignment tonight vs **Gwinnett**.

HARD TO SWALLOW: The Reds have lost 9 games this season in which they held a lead (25-9), including last night vs **Chc** (up 4-0 & 6-2, lost 13-6).

- Last night's was Cin's fourth loss when leading after 6 innings and their first loss when leading by at least 4 runs after 6 innings since 6/4/22 vs **Wsh** (led 7-3, lost 10-8).
- The Reds are 0-21 this year when trailing after 6 innings...their last win in such a scenario came on 9/17/24 vs **Atl** (trailed 5-4 after 6, won 6-5).
- The Reds have 6 comeback wins this season...only **Mil** (5), **CWS** (4) and **Pit** (4) have fewer.
- The Redlegs are 5-8 in 1-run games (.385) this season and 20-36 (.357) in 1-run games since the beginning of last year.

LATE & CLOSE

Late and Close refers to game situations in the 7th inning or later with the batting team tied, ahead by 1, or the tying run on base, at bat or on deck...here's how Reds batters rank in those situations in 2025:

'CITY SLICKERS: Reds pitchers have limited opponents to a hard-hit percentage of .391, which ranks second-best in the majors (*hard-hit pct measures the pct of pitches put in play at an exit velocity over 95 mph*).

- Reds starting pitchers allowed 180 batted balls put in play at or above 100 mph...only **Det** (178), **LAD** (177), **Mil** (176), and **Phi** (173) starters have fewer.
- Cin starters allowed just 10 in-play batted balls with an exit velocity at or above 110 mph this season...only the **Pirates** (8), **Orioles** (8), and **Brewers** (7) have allowed fewer.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the 3-0 win on 5/18 vs Cle (5.0ip, 4h, 0r, 3bb, 5k, 1hb, 96TP).

- Had not issued a base-on-balls to any of his previous 45 batters until he gave up back-to-back walks to Carlos Santana and Gabriel Arias in the 1st inning...streak started on 5/1 vs StL (walk to Jordan to lead off the 4th inning).
- 28 of his 96 pitches were thrown in the 1st inning.
- It was his ninth career scoreless start of at least 5.0 innings, third-most by a Cin pitcher through their first 53 starts since 1901, fewer than only Gary Nolan (11g, 1967-68) and Ewell Blackwell (11g, 1946-47).

MAY 13: Did not factor in the decision in the 5-1, 10-inning loss on 5/13 vs CWS (6.0ip, 4h, 1r/1er, 0bb, 7k, 96TP).

- Gave up Edgar Quero's 4th inning RBI-single to end his streak of having not allowed an ER in 13.1 straight innings.
- For the second consecutive start did not walk a batter.
- Was his second quality start of the season, his first since 4/18 at Bal...was his 20th career quality start.

MAY 6: Did not factor in the decision in the 2-1, 10-inning loss on 5/6 at Atl (5.0ip, 4h, 0r, 0bb, 8k, 91TP).

- Was his first scoreless outing of the season and his first since pitching 7.0 shutout innings vs Col on 7/8/24.
- Was his first career appearance in which he held his opponent without a run and walk.
- Was the first game in which he pitched that the Reds lost.

MAY 1: Collected a no-decision in series finale 9-1 win vs StL on 5/1 (4.0ip, 3h, 1r/0er, 4bb, 3k, 74TP).

- Did not return after a 1 hour 37-minute rain delay in the middle of the 4th inning.
- Was his 50th career appearance/start.
- Was the 12th time since his debut in 2023 that he's allowed fewer than 2 runs in a start at Great American Ball Park.
- Following the game, an official scoring change redesignated the run he allowed in the top of the 3rd inning as an unearned run (was originally deemed an earned run).

250 STRIKEOUTS: Is the fifth-fastest Reds pitcher by appearances (48) since 1900 to reach the 250 strikeout mark (Hunter Greene 36g, Nick Lodolo 38g, Luis Castillo 44g, Gary Nolan 46g)...(*courtesy Elias*).

- Collected his 250th strikeout on 4/18 at Bal (Tyler O'Neill, 6th inning).

NO HITS IN THE FIRST: Has not allowed a hit in the 1st inning in any of his last 9 starts dating back to 8/12/24, it's the longest such streak in the majors... according to *Elias*, the 1st inning hitless streak matches Jim Maloney (9/17/68-4/30/69) for the longest-such run by a Reds pitcher in the expansion era (since 1961)...he last allowed a first inning hit in Mia's 6-4 win on 8/7/24 at loanDepotPark (Derek Hill grand slam).

HE EARNED IT: His 3.54 ERA (282.1ip, 115r/111er) through his first 53 career starts is third-lowest by a Reds left-handed starter behind only Don Gullett (3.09, 1970-73) and Ross Grimsley (3.27, 1971-72).

LIMITING HARD CONTACT: Among all pitchers with at least 35.0 innings, his hard-hit percentage of .268 is the lowest/best in the majors...*hard-hit percentage measures the percentage of pitches put in play at an exit velocity over 95 mph*.

EASY AS 1-2-3: Is holding top of the order batters (1, 2, 3) to a .176/.250/.275 slash line (9-for-51, 1hr, 6 hard-hit pitches).

STINGY WITH THE HOMERS: Hasn't allowed a home run since 4/25 at Col (Jordan Beck, 3rd inning), a span of 21.2 innings and 93 batters without a round-tripper.

PERSONAL: Graduated from Halifax County High School (South Boston, VA), the same school attended by All Elite Wrestling champion **“Hangman” Adam Page** and Major League pitcher **Jeremy Jeffress**...was named 2017 Gatorade Virginia Player of the Year...was a 4-year member of the Halifax swim team...at the University of Virginia became only the second pitcher in school history to record at least 300 strikeouts.
