AROUND THE HORN

LOCK IN 2027 TICKETS NOW: D-backs 2027 Advantage Memberships feature Postseason ticket priority, along with discounted ticket plans, preferred seat priority and more, and are available now by placing a deposit at dbacks.com/membership...the 2027 schedule is packed with fan favorites and holiday staples including Mother's Day in May, Father's Day in June and the 4th of July, monthly NL West matchups and exciting Interleague action.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs have won 5 of their last 6 games vs. Dodgers and look to secure their first season series win since 2018.

- The D-backs are 7-4 in their last 11 games and 17-9 in their last 26 games.
- The D-backs' 17 wins since July 9 are tied for second most in the Majors (also: Braves), behind the Red Sox (22).
- **Eduardo Rodriguez** has allowed 2 or fewer earned runs in 8 of his last 10 outings and posted 7 quality starts...is 5-2 (team 8-2) with a 2.97 ERA (22 R-19 ER in 57.2 IP), 18 walks and 35 strikeouts in that span.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** has hit safely in 8 of his last 9 games at a .405 clip (15-for-37)/1.072 OPS with 1 double, 2 triples, 1 homer, 5 RBI and 3 walks, including 5 multi-hit efforts.
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 19 straight home starts vs. Dodgers since 2023, batting .293 (22-for-75)/1.005 OPS with 8 doubles, 6 homers, 11 RBI and 9 walks.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 2-1 vs. Dodgers in 10 innings last night.

- **Brandon Pfaadt** recorded his fourth straight quality start, tossing his second 7.0-inning shutout (ND, 2 H, 2 BB, 2 K) in his last 3 bids.
- **Corbin Carroll** hit a game-tying RBI triple in the bottom of the ninth inning to make the game 1-1.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** hit his career-best sixth triple of the season in scored the tying run in the ninth.
- **Gabriel Moreno** had a pair of singles.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are tied for the second NL Wild Card spot with the Phillies (WC2), 6.0 games behind the Cubs (WC1) and 1.0 game ahead of the Padres.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The D-backs have won or split 7 of their last 8 series (2-2 @ Padres, 3-0 @ Dodgers, 2-1 vs. Cardinals, 2-1 vs. Athletics, 1-2 @ Nationals, 2-1 @ Pirates, 2-1 @ Guardians, 2-2 vs. Padres)...does not include the 1-game makeup win on July 23 @ Cardinals.

ANSWERBACKS: The D-backs' 36 comebacks lead MLB, ahead of the Cubs (35), Braves (33) and Brewers (33).

- The 36 comeback wins through 117 games are the most in franchise history (34 in 2017, 34 in 2013, 33 in 2002).

TRIPLES LEADER: **Corbin Carroll's** 56 career triples are most among active players (602 G), ahead of Mike Trout/LAA (55 in 1,746 G) and Starling Marte/KC (55 in 1,585 G)...his 13 triples this season are 4 shy of matching his career-best 17 from 2025.

HOME SWEET HOME: The D-backs' .576 home win pct. (34-25) is sixth in the NL, behind the Braves (.661, 39-20), Brewers (.645, 40-22), Cubs (.593, 35-24), Marlins (.593, 35-24) and Dodgers (.589, 33-23).

- The D-backs are 7-4 in their last 11 home games since July 18...in that span, they rank among the Majors in OPS (3rd, .834), SLG (3rd, .475), OBP (3rd, .360), walks (3rd, 50) and AVG (7th, .277).

BATS AFTER THE BREAK: Since July 26, the D-backs rank among NL leaders in hits (T-3rd, 114), extra-base hits (T-3rd, 40) and times on base (T-4th, 171).

STARTING PITCHERS: D-backs starting pitchers, in their last 12 bids, own a 2.18 ERA (21 R-17 ER in 70.1 IP), opponent .227 AVG (58-for-255), with 23 walks and 48 strikeouts.

DIVISION WINS: The D-backs' .632 division win pct. (24-14) ranks third in MLB, behind the Braves (.676, 25-12) and Brewers (.667, 22-11).

NOOTBAAR'S NEW DIGS: **Lars Nootbaar** has reached base safely in his first 5 games as a D-back (3 H, 4 BB/.333 OBP) since being acquired on Aug. 3 from the Cardinals, including reaching base 2+ twice.

RECORD VS. LEFTY STARTERS: Vs. opposing lefty starters, the D-backs' .667 win pct. (18-9) is tied for the Major League lead with the Rays (22-11).

- The D-backs are 9-5 vs. lefty starters at home.

OFFENSE VS. LEFTIES: Vs. lefties, the D-backs rank among MLB leaders in AVG (1st, .276), triples (T-1st, 10), fewest strikeouts (1st, 201), OBP (2nd, .341), SLG (3rd, .440) and OPS (3rd, .781).

SEEING SOUTHPAWS WELL: Vs. left-handed starters, **Corbin Carroll** is hitting .390 (39-for-100)/1.225 OPS with 4 doubles, 8 triples, 6 homers, 21 RBI and 10 walks.

- **Ryan Waldschmidt** has reached base safely in 12 straight games vs. lefty starters, hitting .419 (18-for-43)/1.075 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 7 RBI and 2 walks.
- **Ildemaro Vargas**, in his last 6 games vs. lefty starters, is hitting .455 (10-for-22)/1.024 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 RBI and 1 walk.

VS. DODGERS: The D-backs are 6-3 in their last 9 meetings and look to clinch back-to-back series wins for the first time since 2024 (May 20-22 and July 2-4)...swept their last 3-game series @ Dodgers from July 10-12.

- With a win, the D-backs would take their first season series from the Dodgers since 2018.

- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base in 13 of his last 15 home games vs. Dodgers, hitting .353 (18-for-51)/.892 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 6 RBI and 3 walks.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base in 8 straight games vs. Dodgers, batting .333 (10-for-30)/.878 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 RBI and 6 walks.
- **Tim Tawa**, in his last 6 games vs. Dodgers, is hitting .435 (10-for-23)/1.263 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 7 RBI and 2 walks, including 4 games reaching base 2+ times.

ON DECK VS. ROCKIES: The D-backs are 21-4 in their last 25 home games vs. Rockies...took 3 of 4 in their last series @ Chase Field.

- The D-backs have won 8 straight home series vs. Rockies since Aug. 2022 and 13 of their last 14.
