THE WORD ON THE 'BIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals begin a six-game road trip tonight with the opener of a three-game series with the New York Mets at Citi Field ... The Cardinals visit Target Field this weekend for a three-game Interleague series with the Minnesota Twins ... Before yesterday's off day in the Big Apple, the Cardinals enjoyed a 6-3 homestand against the Cubs (2-1), Rangers (1-2), and Reds (3-0).

FLIGHT PATTERN: Winners of four straight, St. Louis enters today in 2nd place in the National League Central, 5.5 games back of Milwaukee ... For the second consecutive season, the Cardinals sport a 35-28 record through the first 63 games.

CHURCH ACTIVATED, SCOTT II OPTIONED: Prior to tonight's series opener in Queens, the Cardinals announced that they activated OF **Nathan Church** from the 10-Day Injured List and optioned OF **Victor Scott II** to Memphis (AAA) following Sunday's game ... Church, who has missed the last 15 games with a left shoulder strain, was 1-for-11 with a homer in a three-game injury rehab assignment with Memphis (AAA).

TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS: Since the team landed in Gotham, **Dustin May**, **Matthew Liberatore**, **Kyle Leahy**, **Hunter Dobbins**, and **Iván Herrera** visited Major League Baseball's Central Offices in Manhattan, while **Michael McGreevy** and **JJ Wetherholt** toured MLB Network studios in Secaucus, NJ and appeared on *MLB Central* with **Robert Flores**, **Lauren Shehadi**, **Alex Avila**, and former Met **Cliff Floyd**.

POND SCUM: The Cardinals have lost five straight at Citi Field (April 28, 2024-present), their longest skid here since Citi Field was built in 2009 and 3rd-longest overall losing streak in Queens behind a pair of Shea Stadium losing streaks of seven games (June 22, 1969-May 27, 1970) and 11 games (Sept. 13, 1987-April 3, 1989).

HEIR JORDAN: **Jordan Walker** leads St. Louis is batting (.303), hits (73), home runs (16), slugging (.560), OPS (.922), RBI (47), extra-base hits (30), and stolen bases (10) ... The 24-year-old Walker, who is currently on pace for 41 HR and 26 stolen bases, needs 14 home runs and 20 stolen bases over the final 99 games to become the first Cardinal with a 30-30 season in franchise history ... The last Cardinal with a 20/20 season was **Tommy Pham** (23-25) in 2017 ... Walker and Washington's **James Wood** (17-11) are the only two Major League players this season with 15+ HR and 10+ SB.

CARDIAC CARDS: St. Louis leads Major League Baseball in extra inning victories (7) and last at-bat wins (11), while ranking tied for 2nd in one-run wins (12), and tied for 3rd in walk-offs (5) and comeback victories (19) ... 23 of the 35 Cardinals wins have been by two runs or fewer, most in MLB.

UNDER THE BRIGHT LIGHTS: St. Louis is 23-13 (.639) in night games this season, 3rd-best record in MLB behind Atlanta (.723, 34-13) and Tampa Bay (.657, 23-13) ... The Mets rank 20th in MLB with a 16-19 (.457) record in night tilts ... St. Louis is 11-5 road night games, but has dropped its last three.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (June 9, 1963 and June 9, 1985): **Tim McCarver** and **Terry Pendleton** each hit an inside-the-park grand slam for the Cardinals against the Mets on the same date, 22 years apart ... Both occurred in New York in the second games of Sunday doubleheaders ... McCarver's inside-the-parker was off **Larry Bearnarth** in the 10-4 Redbirds win at the Polo Grounds, while Pendleton's in 1985 came off **Joe Sambito** in the Cardinals 8-2 victory at Shea Stadium.

Masyn Winn made his MLB debut against the Mets at Busch Stadium III (Aug. 18, 2023).

Ryne Stanek pitched parts of the previous two seasons with the Mets (2024-25).

Oliver Marmol was born in Elizabeth, NJ.

Luke Weaver was selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (No. 27) of the 2014 MLB Draft... pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2016-18) before packaged in a trade to Arizona for **Paul Goldschmidt** (Dec. 5, 2018)...2016 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & Mets broadcaster **Keith Hernandez** was selected by the Cardinals in the 42nd round of the 1971 MLB Draft...played 10 seasons in St. Louis (1974-83)...won the 1979 NL MVP Award...named to two National League All-Star teams and won six Gold Gloves.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jason Isringhausen** was selected by the Mets in the 44th round of the 1991 MLB Draft...pitched parts of five seasons in New York (1995-97, 1999, 2011).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** was born in Middletown, NY...graduated from Valley Central High School in Montgomery, NY...played college baseball at Seton Hall University.

Devin Williams was born in St. Louis and is a Hazelwood West High School graduate.

Jeff Albert worked nine seasons in the Cardinals organization as a St. Louis hitting coach (2019-22) and minor league hitting coach (2008-12).

Mets Baseball Ops Special Asst. **Carlos Beltrán** played two All-Star seasons with St. Louis (2012-13).

Kyle Discoll is a native of Toms River, NJ... played collegiately at Rutgers University...held multiple roles with the Mets organization from 2019-2023, including Pitching Data and Movement Analyst, Rehab Coordinator, Assistant Pitching Coordinator, and Triple-A pitching coach.

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** was born in nearby Poughkeepsie, N.Y...graduated from F.D. Roosevelt High School in Hyde Park.

Mets Clubhouse Operations Coordinator **Scott Keltner** previously worked in the Cardinals organization in the Busch Stadium (2016-21) and AutoZone Park (2014-15) visiting clubhouses.

Cardinals.TV broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** was traded to the Mets with **Jeromy Burnitz**, **Lou Collier**, **Jeff D'Amico**, and cash (January 21, 2002)... attended Spring Training with New York before being released (March 13, 2002).

Jared Young played in 75 games for Memphis (AAA) in 2024.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **José Oquendo** played the first two seasons of his MLB career with the Mets...traded by NY with **Mark Davis** to St. Louis for **John Young** and **Angel Salazar** (April 2, 1985).

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** played for and managed both the Cardinals (1969-74 & 1990-95) and Mets (1975-77 & 1977-81).

Mets VP of Amateur & International Scouting **Kris Gross** was a Cardinals amateur scout for three seasons (2010-12).

Cardinals.TV reporter **Jim Hayes** was born in New York City and raised in nearby Nyack, NY...graduated from SUNY-Geneseo.

Cardinals Asst. GM **Moisés Rodríguez** is from the Lower East Side of Manhattan...formerly worked for MLB in New York (1998-2007).

The Mets made their National League debut in St. Louis on April 11, 1962, losing to the Cardinals at Busch Stadium I on Opening Day, 11-4...The day prior before the season opener was rained out, a dozen Mets players were trapped in the Chase Park Plaza elevator for about an hour.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- The 28-year-old **Dustin May** makes his 13th start as a member of the Cardinals (70th career start & 84th appearance) tonight.
- Is making his 4th career appearance vs. the Mets, and his 3rd start; **it's his first career start (2nd game) at Citi Field.**
- Has received one run of support or fewer in five of his last seven starts (April 27-present), and a total of just eight runs in those seven starts.
- Is seeking his 1st win since 4/21 at MIA, having gone 0-4 with three no-decisions in his last seven starts while producing a 3.86 ERA and .221 Opp. BA.
- Has fanned a season-high 9 batters in each of his last two starts; ranks 2nd among Cardinals pitchers with 60 strikeouts, one shy of **Matthew Liberatore** (61) and owns the top strikeout/walk ratio (3.16) among Cardinals starters.
- Pitched 6.0 innings in every start over a four-game stretch (April 27-May 15), the longest streak of his career and tying **Michael McGreevy** for the longest by a Cardinal this season. All were quality starts.
- Has three caught stealing on attempted base stealers, T-3rd among NL pitchers, one back of his teammate **Matthew Liberatore** (4).
- Has issued just three walks right handed batters among 103 RH batters faced, limiting RH batters to a .214 BA (21-98) and 1 HR.
- Joins **Nathan Church** (2024-26), **Hunter Dobbins** (2026), **Mark McGwire** (1997-2001), **Red Schoendienst** (1945-56, '61-63), and **Rex Hudler** (1990-92) as notable red-headed Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Tuesday, June 2 vs. Texas): ND, L, 7-4; 5.2.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 2 BB, 9 SO, 90 pitches.

- Fanned a season-high 9 batters in his 2nd consecutive start.
- Received 2 or fewer runs of support for the 6th time in his last seven starts.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

BASEBALL HQ TOUR: Took time yesterday to tour MLB's Central Offices while the Cardinals spent their off-day in NYC.

OH NO-NO: Took a no-hitter in the 8th inning on 5/27 at MIL, broken up by a Garrett Mitchell lead-off double, and eventually lost 2-1; Threw a season-high 7.0 IP and fanned a season-high 9 batters; the only Brewers batsmen to reach safely before the 8th came via a HBP and catcher's interference.

DECISIONS, DECISIONS: His 2026 season has been one of streaks starting with 2-straight loses, then 3-straight wins and now a career-high 4-straight losses.

STEADY STARTER: Has quality starts in 7 of his 12 starts; Has allowed 3 runs or fewer working into the 6th inning in each of his last 10 starts for a 3.18 ERA (59.1 IP/21 ER) in that span. He has received just 8 runs of support over his last seven starts.

KICKING THE BABIP HABIT: 17 or his 67 hits allowed this season came in his first two starts; he still owns the 6th-highest BABIP (.328) in MLB.

DON'T WALK TO STRANGERS: Has the 2nd-lowest walk percentage among Cardinals starting pitchers behind **Michael McGreevy** (6.0%) with 6.8%.

MAY'S DAY: Started on May 3 while wearing uniform No. 3, against his former team, the Dodgers, suffering 4-1 loss that snapped his 3-game winning streak.

EARLY BIRD: Has made a team-high 7 starts in Day games this season (1-6, 5.73 ERA), ranking T-2nd in NL; is 2-0 with a 3.10 ERA in his 5 Night starts.

BACK-TO-BACK JACK: Gained a 5-3 win vs. CLE (4/15) as he paired back/back quality starts & wins over BOS & CLE during that homestand.

MILESTONE WIN: Bested his former team the Red Sox on 4/10 in a 3-2 win. It was his 1st win as a member of the Cardinals and his 20th career win.

TIGER STRIKE: Was hit for a season-high seven runs on seven hits (and struck in leg by line drive) over 3.1 innings in an 11-6 loss at Detroit (4/4) in his second start. First Cardinals pitcher since **Mike Parisi** (2008) to begin a season allowing 6 or more runs in his first two starts of a season; and the first Cardinal to pitch the Opening Day series since **Dizzy Dean** (1936).

OPENING ACT: Took the loss in his Cardinals debut at Busch Stadium vs. TB (3/29) allowing six runs over 4.0 inning. Tied his career-high allowing 10 hits, the first Cardinals pitcher to allow double-digit hits in his debut in 55 years since **Chris Zachary** surrendered 10 to the Phillies (5/3/1971) *Elias*. Recorded his 300th career strikeout retiring **Junior Caminero**.

MAY VS. NEW YORK (N.L.):

- Is making his 4th career appearance & 3rd career start against the Mets tonight and it's his 2nd career start at Citi Field
- Is 0-0 with a 4.97 ERA in his three career appearances against the Mets, allowing 15 hits and 7 runs in 12.2 IP.
- Worked a scoreless inning of relief in his lone appearance at Citi Field while pitching for the Dodgers on 9/15/19.
- Allowed a leadoff HR to Francisco Lindor in his last appearance vs. the Mets (6/2/25 at Dodger Stadium).**
- Owens a 3-5 career mark vs. NL East clubs, with all three wins coming against MIA, including one this season.
