**THE HUNT FOR A RED OCTOBER:** The Cardinals continue their final regular season road trip (3-0 at CHI, ARI-3) this afternoon, as they play the final game of a four-game series at Wrigley Field...the Cardinals have posted dramatic 5-4, 2-1 & 9-8 wins in the first three games of the series, and are seeking their fifth-straight win, and a four-game series sweep of the Cubs at Wrigley Field for the first time since May of 1921...the Cardinals are a season-high 21 games over .500 and have 7 games remaining (four against the Cubs)...St. Louis entered play today in first place in the NL Central, 3.0 games ahead of the Brewers & 6.0 games in front of the Cubs...the Cardinals magic number for clinching their first postseason berth since 2015 now stands at two over Chicago.

**DIVISION DANDIES:** The Cardinals are seeking their first NL Central title since 2015 and a share of their 12th overall (co-winners with Houston in 2001)...the Cardinals have won outright NL Central titles in 1996, 2000, 2002, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2006, 2013, 2014 & 2015 since the division was formed in 1995.

**NOT SINCE 1931:** Yesterday's 9th inning back-to-back game-tying and go-ahead homers by **Yadier Molina** & **Paul DeJong** marked just the second time in franchise history that the Cardinals hit back-to-back home runs to tie and go ahead in the final inning of a win according to the Elias Sports Bureau. The first time it happened was on June 16, 1931, when **George Watkins** and **Frankie Frisch** homered in the bottom of the 9th in a 2-1 win over the Phillies.

**IT'S A CHICAGO THING:** Friday's 3-hit game by **Yadier Molina** was the 1st time a Cardinals player had 3 of a team total 4 hits in a win since **Carlos Beltrán** did so on June 13, 2012 in a 1-0 win against the White Sox.

**FIREMEN SAVE FIFTY:** Yesterday's save by **Carlos Martinez** was the team's 50th of the season, with Tsunami leading the way with 23, following by **Jordan Hicks** (14), **Andrew Miller** (5), **John Gant** (3) and five others with one apiece...the Cardinals & NY Yankees co-lead the majors with 50 saves...the nine players with at least one save this season is just one shy of the club record of 10 players with saves which has been done four times (1966, 1965, 1964 and 1951).

**THE WRIGLEY BLEACHER REACHER:** **Matt Carpenter's** game-winning 10th inning homer on Thursday was his 12th career at Wrigley Field (T8th all-time among Cardinals) and his 7th in 15 games since July 9, 2018...since last year's All-Star break, Matt is batting .350 (21-60) at Wrigley with 5 doubles, 7 HR's and 14 RBI.

**THE EDMAN EFFECT:** Rookie **Tommy Edman** hit his team-leading 6th triple yesterday and was on base three times...Edman made his ML debut on June 8 at Wrigley Field as the Cardinals fell to 31-31 that night...since then, the Cardinals are 57-36...Edman has reached base safely in 11-straight games and has a 1.052 OPS and .681 SLG pct. in 20 September games.

**TIME TO FLY:** After a five-game losing streak on a West Coast trip to Oakland and Los Angeles-NL (August 3-7), the Cardinals are 30-12 since August 9, leading Major League Baseball in wins while boasting a MLB-best 3.00 ERA...the Cardinals lead the N.L. in winning pct. (.44-23; .657) since the All-Star break.

**TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS:** The Cardinals are 44-28 (.611) in divisional play, including a 29-11 (.725) mark since the All-Star Break...their .611 divisional win pct. leads all NL Central clubs and is their 4th best all-time.

**RUNNIN' REDBIRDS:** The Cardinals (111-for-140) lead the NL in stolen bases this season, four more than 2nd place Washington (109). Their 79.3% SB success rate (6th in NL) currently stands as the highest all-time in franchise history since 1951 (STATS LLC)...19 different Cardinals have stolen at least one base, most in MLB and T5th-most in franchise history (record held by 1906 club with 21 Cardinals)...St. Louis has stolen multiple bases in 30 games (1st in MLB).

**A WINNING TRADITION:** The Cardinals have posted their 12th consecutive winning season (2008-19), something they'd done just once previously in franchise history when they compiled 15 consecutive winning seasons from 1939-53.

#### CHICAGO CONNECTIONS

**Dexter Fowler** played two seasons (2015-16) with Chicago...member of 2016 World Series champions...initially became a Cub via trade by the Astros for **Dan Straily** and **Luis Valbuena** (Jan. 19, 2005).

**Paul DeJong** graduated from Antioch (Ill.) Comm. High School...played college baseball at Illinois State University (2013-15) while majoring in biochemistry and pre-medicine.

**Daniel Ponce de Leon** was selected by the Cubs in the 14th round of the 2013 MLB Draft after his junior season, but failed his physical due to concerns about the ulnar nerve placement in his right elbow.

**Kolten Wong** (August 13, 2016 at Wrigley Field), **Dakota Hudson** (July 28, 2018 at Busch Stadium), **Tyler O'Neill** (April 19, 2018 at Wrigley Field), **Andrew Knizner** (June 2, 2019 at Busch Stadium), and **Tommy Edman** (June 8 2019 at Wrigley Field) all made MLB debuts against the Cubs.

**John Brebbia** earned his first Major League win against Chicago (June 17, 2018).

**Mike Maddux's** younger brother, **Greg Maddux**, was a Hall of Fame pitcher for Chicago for parts of 10 seasons (1986-92, '04-06)...originally selected by the Cubs in the 2nd round of the 1984 MLB draft.

**Jason Heyward** played the 2015 season with St. Louis...originally traded by Atlanta with pitcher **Jordan Walden** to St. Louis for pitchers **Tyrell Jenkins** & **Shelby Miller** (Nov. 17, 2014).

As compensation for the departure of Heyward signing with the Cubs, **Dakota Hudson** was selected by St. Louis with the 34th overall pick in the first round of the 2016 MLB draft.

**Daniel Descalso** played parts of five seasons in a Cardinals uniform (2010-14)...appeared in 44 postseason games and was a member of the 2011 World Champion Cardinals...originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2007 MLB Draft.

**Steve Cishek** appeared in 27 games with St. Louis in 2015...originally traded by the Marlins to St. Louis for **Kyle Barraclough** (July 24, 2015).

**Rowan Wick** was selected by St. Louis as a catcher in the 9th round of the 2012 MLB draft...played/pitched six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization before selected off waivers by San Diego (Feb. 16, 2018).

Cardinals broadcaster and Hall of Fame outfielder **Jim Edmonds** played part of 2008 with the Cubs. Cubs Bullpen Coach **Lester Strode** pitched for the Triple-A Louisville Redbirds (1987-88) in the Cardinals' minor league organization.

Cubs Director, Player Development **Jaron Madison** previously served as the Cardinals Assistant Director of Scouting (2008-09).

Cubs Catching Coach **Mike Borzello** played four seasons (1991-94) in the Cardinals minor league system...originally selected by St. Louis in 1991.

Cardinals VP/General Manager **Michael Girsch** is a Chicago native...graduated from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Chicago.

**TODAY'S GAME**

- Makes his team-leading 32nd start of the season (74th career start) and 101st career appearance, as he faces the Cubs for the 4th time this season.
- He's the first Cardinals pitcher age 30+ to start 30 or more games in consecutive seasons since Adam Wainwright did so in three consecutive seasons from 2012-14.
- Had his team-record streak of having walked two or fewer batters in 43 straight starts dating back to July 4, 2018, broken on 9/6 at PIT. The streak surpassed the Cardinals previous best of 39 games by Curt Davis (July 3, 1938-Sept. 3, 1939).
- The 43 consecutive starts with two walks or fewer was the longest streak in MLB since 2017 when Clayton Kershaw (47) and Andy Sonnanstine (45) each ran streaks of 40+ dating back to the 2015 season.
- Held his opposition to three runs or less in his last five starts. Has pitched between 5.0 and 6.1 innings in every start (12) since 7/15 when he threw a shutout vs. PIT.
- Has induced nine grounded into double plays post All-Star break, T3rd in the N.L. and currently ranks T3rd in the N.L. this season with teammate Dakota Hudson at 20.
- Has walked one or fewer in 22 of his 31 starts, including no walks in 10 outings.
- The Cardinals sport a 39-23 record (.629 win pct.) in his games pitched since 2018.
- He's 12-6, 3.41 ERA (158.1 IP/60 ER) in 26 post All-Star starts as a Cardinal (2018-19).

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Made his 100th career appearance and took the loss allowing three runs over 6.0 innings in his 16th quality start. It was his 14th loss of the season and first since 8/17.
