**METSCELLANEOUS:** The Mets fell to the Nationals, 5-4, yesterday... The team has now lost six of their last seven series and drop to 10-21 through their first 31 games...It is their worst mark through 31 games since the 1981 team began the season 8-22-1...Are just 2-7 in one run games this season...Dropped to 6-12 at home this season...Today, the Mets head West to face the Angels (three games), Diamondbacks (three games) and Rockies (three games).

**ROSTER MOVES:** Yesterday, the Mets claimed INF Andy Ibáñez from the Athletics...He has appeared in 431 career games across six seasons, batting .252/.303/.385 with 28 home runs and 131 RBI.

**ANGELS-METS NOTES:** The Mets swept their series against the Angels from July 21-23 at Citi Field last year...The team visits Angels Stadium for the first time since August 2-4, 2024 where they went 1-2.

**MY OH MYERS:** Tobias Myers is now 0-1 with a 2.33 ERA (5 ER/19.2 IP), three walks and 16 strikeouts in nine games this year...He has not allowed an earned run over his last three appearances, tossing 6.1 scoreless innings and allowing three hits, two walks and seven strikeouts.

**THE WAY YOU MAKE ME FEEL:** MJ Melendez is batting .345 (10-29) with four runs, three doubles, two homers, six RBI, three walks, a .406 OBP and a .655 SLG in 11 games this season...He has safely hit in four straight games, going 5-11 in that span with two runs, a double, a homer, a walk and four RBI.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** The Mets are in the midst of their third road trip of the season...They are 4-9 in 2026...Last season, the Mets went 34-47 on the road...The team has posted a 3.69 ERA on the road, which is seventh in the majors and fourth in the National League.

**MOVING ON UP:** Juan Soto has 247 career home runs...That ties with Miguel Cabrera for the 14th-most in Major League history prior to turning 28 (next: Andruw Jones, 250)...Has 69 career opposite field home runs, the second-most in the majors since 2018 (most: Aaron Judge, 97)...Courtesy of Sarah Langs.

**THEY'RE OUT OF OUR LEAGUE:** The Mets are 2-4 against the AL in 2026...New York went 24-24 against the American League in 2025...Since Interleague Play began in 1997, the Mets are 304-304 against the American League.

**LET'S GO STREAKING:** Soto has reached base safely in each of his first 16 games this season...It is his longest streak to begin a season in his career...Since returning from the Injured List on April 22 he is slashing .333/.471/.630 (9-27) with seven walks.

**WE REMEMBER:** The New York Mets announced that the club will wear a memorial "Davey" patch on the sleeve of their home and road uniforms during the 2026 season...Johnson passed away on September 5, 2025 at the age of 82...He finished his Mets career with the most managerial wins in franchise history (595) and the best winning percentage (.588)...In 1986, Johnson guided the team to a franchise-record 108 regular season victories and capped the year off with a dramatic World Championship...From 1984-1990, under his helm, the Mets averaged more than 95 wins.

**THIS DAY IN 1986:** The Mets had their 11-game winning-streak stopped on this day in 1986 as the Mets fell to the Braves, 7-2...Rick Aguilera took the loss, allowing six runs in 3.1 innings of work...George Foster collected two hits, while Ray Knight and Keith Hernandez doubled in the loss...This season, the Mets will celebrate the 40th anniversary of the 1986 World Series Champions New York Mets...The Mets will also host a 1986 World Series Reunion and Celebration to celebrate the 1986 World Champion Mets on Saturday, August 1 prior to the 4:10 p.m. game against the Miami Marlins...Additional information regarding programming for the 1986 World Series Reunion and Celebration will be available at a later date at Mets.com/1986.

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** Jack Weninger tossed a season-high 5.2 innings in the Syracuse Mets victory yesterday...He allowed only four hits, walked one and struck out seven in the victory...In five starts this year, Weninger is 2-1 with a 1.61 ERA (4 ER/22.2 IP), 12 walks and 26 strikeouts...The Barrington, IL native was selected in the sixth round of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Illinois.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Threw 1.1 innings and allowed one earned run in his first start since July 21, 2024...He issued a career-high five walks...He is the first Mets pitcher to issue five or more walks in a game since David Peterson on August 13, 2025 at Atlanta.

**2024 SEASON RECAP:** Scott finished his rookie season going 0-3 with a 4.56 ERA (24 ER/47.1 IP), adding 39 strikeouts and 12 walks before being placed on the IL with a sprained UCL in his right elbow...Made his MLB debut on May 4 in Tampa Bay, throwing 6.2 innings and allowing just one run, adding six strikeouts and one walk...Recorded a career-high eight strikeouts on May 11 against Atlanta, throwing 6.0 innings and allowing just three runs.

**SINCE YOU'VE BEEN BACK:** Has made three starts since he has been recalled from Triple-A Syracuse in 2024...Has posted a 5.17 ERA (9 ER/5.2 IP) in that span with four home runs, four walks and 10 strikeouts.

**DOWN AT THE FARM:** Since he returned to Triple-A, Scott made four starts with the Syracuse Mets, posting a 2.12 ERA (4 ER/17.0 IP) with six walks and 19 strikeouts...All together in nine starts at Triple-A, Scott is 3-0 with a 2.76 ERA (13 ER/42.1 IP) with 12 walks and 55 strikeouts.

**WHAT A DEBUT:** Scott made his major league debut on May 4 in Tampa Bay...He recorded a no decision in the Mets 3-1 loss, throwing 6.2 innings and allowing just one run on five hits with one walk and six strikeouts...He became the third Mets player to make his major league debut this year...Scott is the first Mets pitcher to toss at least 6.0 innings in their debut since Steven Matz did so on June 28, 2015 vs. Cincinnati.

**SIZZLING IN SYRACUSE:** At the time of his first call up, was 3-0 with a 3.20 ERA (9 ER/25.1 IP) at Syracuse...Has made five starts, allowing six walks and striking out 36...Led the International League in WHIP (0.71) and batting average against (.136), while placing fourth in strikeouts (36) and ninth in ERA (3.20). **23 AND ME:** Named the New York Mets 2023 Pitcher of the Year after making 19 starts this across three levels season and posting a 5-4 record with a 2.57 ERA (25 ER/87.2 IP) with 12 walks and 107 strikeouts.

**HE'S GOT PROSPECTS:** Entered the 2024 season as the 99th best prospect in the minors by ESPN.

**SLIDE TO THE RIGHT:** While seeking a third pitch, looked at Pitching Ninja video and discovered the slider grip used by Max Scherzer...It's still the grip he uses today... Was predominately a reliever throughout his career at the University of Florida and transitioned to a starting role after he was selected by the Mets.

**MINOR LEAGUE BACKGROUND:** In 2023, held opposing hitters to a .199 batting average and posted 10.98 strikeouts per nine innings...Started for the Rumble Ponies in Game One of the Northeast Division Series...In 2022, he split his time between A St. Lucie and A+ Brooklyn with a combined 4.45 ERA in 18 appearances...In 2021, he had three relief outings for FCL Mets and threw 12 strikes out of 16 total pitches.

- Fired 2.0 innings of relief on April 26 vs. Colorado (G1) (2.0 IP, 2 H, ER, K, BB)...Marked his second multi-inning relief outing of the season.
- Entered in the eighth inning with the bases loaded and surrendered a grand slam on April 23 vs. Minnesota (0.2 IP, H, ER).
- Since the start of last year, he has recorded four or more outs without allowing an earned run in 18 relief appearances, which is tied for the sixth-most appearances among NL relievers.
- Fired 2.2 scoreless innings in relief on April 11 vs. the Athletics (2.2 IP, 2 H, 3 K)...Marked his ninth scoreless relief appearance of at least 2.0 innings since the beginning of last season...Is tied for the eighth-most such games among NL relievers during that span.
- Made his third career Opening Day roster and his second consecutive with the Mets.
- Pitched in three games for the Dominican Republic in the World Baseball Classic...He tossed 4.0 scoreless innings and struck out seven of the 13 batters he faced.
- Appeared in three Grapefruit League games and he threw 3.0 scoreless innings...He struck out five of the 11 batters he faced during the spring.
- Last season, he made a career-high 52 appearances and finished with a 5-2 record, two saves, 12 holds, 57 strikeouts, and a 3.57 ERA (25 ER/63.0 IP).
- In 2025, he allowed just five earned runs over 25 combined appearances in March, April, and May (1.34 ERA)...His ERA through his first 25 games of the season is the 11th-best in franchise history.

- Fired a scoreless ninth inning and struck out the side on April 28 vs. Washington (1.0 IP, 3 K)...Is the first time he's recorded three or more strikeouts in an outing since September 21, 2025 vs. Seattle while with Houston.
- Through 5.1 innings pitched this season he has recorded seven strikeouts...Good for a K/9 of 11.81...Hasn't surrendered an earned run in five of his six appearances this season.
- Over 22 career appearances against the Angels, he has pitched to a 2.25 ERA (5 ER/20.0 IP) while recording 11 of 12 save opportunities...Over 134 career Interleague matchups he has 56 saves, a 3.74 ERA (53 ER/127.2 IP) and 187 strikeouts...His 56 saves in Interleague play are tied for the third-most in Major League history.
- Struck out two over a scoreless inning in his Mets and 2026 debut on April 11 vs. the Athletics (1.0 IP, H, 2 K)...Has now made an appearance for 10 Major League clubs.
- Signed with the Mets as a minor league free agent with an invite to Spring Training...Over six Grapefruit League appearances, he finished with a 4.50 ERA (3 ER/6.0 IP) and five strikeouts.

- Made an appearance for Single-A St. Lucie on April 7 and he completed a scoreless inning while recording one strikeout.
- Among relievers all-time, he is tied for fourth in strikeouts and fifth in saves...Among active relievers, he ranks second in strikeouts behind only Aroldis Chapman and second in saves behind Kenley Jansen.
- Last season, he appeared in 14 games between Atlanta (one game) and Houston...He went 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA (3 ER/12.0 IP) with two holds and 17 strikeouts.
- He is a nine-time All-Star, which is the second-most selections all-time among relief pitchers, only trailing Mariano Rivera's 13 selections
- He was the National League Rookie of the Year in 2011 while with the Atlanta Braves...He was also named the Trevor Hoffman NL Reliever of the Year in 2014 with Atlanta and the Mariano Rivera AL Reliever of the Year with Boston in 2017.

- Threw 2.2 innings in relief on April 29 vs. Washington (2.2 IP, 7 H, 6 ER, 4 K, 2 BB).
- Has thrown 22.0 innings in relief this season, which is the third-most among NL relievers...His 23 strikeouts this season are the fourth-most among NL relief pitchers.
- Over 15 career appearances (14 starts) against the Angels he is 4-4 with a 3.96 ERA (34 ER/77.1 IP) and 64 strikeouts.
- Recorded seven strikeouts over 3.1 innings in relief on April 24 vs. Colorado (3.1 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 7 K, BB)...Marked his third career game with seven or more strikeouts as a relief pitcher (also: 8 K, 5/22/23 at Minnesota w/San Francisco and 7/13/25 at Kansas City)...Joins Tug McGraw (5), Nolan Ryan and Skip Lockwood as the only relief pitchers in franchise history with multiple seven+ strikeout games.
- He and Chase Dollander (Colorado) are the only two relievers who have thrown 3.0 or more innings in at least five relief appearances this season...No one else has even done so four times.
- Went 0-2 with a 3.72 ERA (4 ER/9.2 IP) with two walks and nine strikeouts in three starts during Spring Training.
- In 40 career games in relief, Manaea is 5-4 with a 4.49 ERA (56 ER/112.1 IP) with 36 walks and 126 strikeouts.
- In 2025, finished the season going 2-4 with a 5.64 ERA (38 ER/60.2 IP), 12 walks and 75 strikeouts in 15 appearances (12 starts).
- Last season was originally placed on the 15-Day IL on March 27 (retro. March 24) with a right oblique strain and then was transferred to the 60-Day IL on April 29.
