HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs have won or split 5 of their last 7 series (4 wins, 1 split).

- **Corbin Burnes** is making his second start since returning from the 60-day Injured List on Sept. 8 and first home start since June 1, 2025 vs. Nationals.
 - In 6 home starts last season, went 2-0 (team 4-2) with a 1.75 ERA (7 ER in 36.0), opponent .188 (24-for128), 13 walks and 38 strikeouts.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 7-6 vs. Rangers yesterday after scoring 5 unanswered runs from the seventh inning on with a 3-run seventh inning and 2-run ninth inning, stranding the tying and go-ahead runs in the ninth.

- **Nolan Arenado** hit a 3-run homer in the seventh inning to cut the deficit to 7-4.
- **Gabriel Moreno** hit a solo homer in the fourth to make it a 2-1 deficit.
- **Nolan Arenado, Tim Tawa** and **Jordan Lawlar** each doubled in the ninth.
- **Eduardo Rodriguez** (L, 6 R-3 ER in 5.1 IP, 8 H, BB, 7 K) took his sixth loss.

ROSTER MOVE: Today, the D-backs claimed OF **Jesús Sánchez** from the Blue Jays.

- In 99 games with the Blue Jays, hit .260 (70-for-269)/.734 OPS with 18 doubles, 8 homers, 35 RBI, 17 walks and 1 stolen base
- Has played 7 MLB seasons with the Marlins (2020-25), Astros (2025) and Blue Jays (2026) . . in 679 career games, has hit a combined .242 (516-for-2,134)/.727 OPS with 110 doubles, 13 triples, 81 homers, 273 RBI, 188 walks and 34 stolen bases.

CARROLL NAMED D-BACKS’ 2026 ROBERTO CLEMENTE NOMINEE: The D-backs named **Corbin Carroll** as their Roberto Clemente Award nominee for a second straight year as one of baseball’s brightest stars is building a legacy rooted in humility, integrity, and compassion—the same values that defined Clemente’s extraordinary life...vote now at MLBTogether.com/clementeaward.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are fourth in the NL Wild Card race, 2.5 games behind the Padres (WC3, Season tied 5-5), 3.5 games behind the Phillies (WC2, tied 3-3) and 4.0 behind the Cubs (WC1, trail 2-4).

ROLLIN’ NOLAN: **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 9 straight games, batting .333 (10-for-30)/1.274 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 homers, 8 RBI and 7 walks...has reached 2+ times in 6 straight games.

- His 1.274 OPS ranks seventh among MLB qualified hitters in the span (since September 4).

ARENADO AMONG THE FEW: **Nolan Arenado** is 1 of 6 MLB players to collect 9+ seasons of 25+ homers with 100+ starts at third base, joining Mike Schmidt/PHI (12), Eddie Mathews/ATL (12), Manny Machado/BAL-LAD-SD (10), Aramis Ramirez/PIT-CHC-MIL (10) and Adrian Beltre/LAD-SEA-BOS-TEX (9).

KING OF CATCHERS: Gabriel Moreno’s 5.1 bWAR leads all catchers (ahead of Dillon Dingler/DET’s 3.9) and is tied for the 11th-highest mark among position players (with Elly De La Cruz/CIN).

- His .301 AVG, .377 OBP, .844 OPS, 31 doubles, 9 sac flies, and 5 stolen bases (T-1st) lead catchers [min. 90 G].
- His 9 DRS rank tied for third among NL catchers (also: Freddy Fermin/SD), behind Luis Torrens/NYM (13) and Joe Mack/MIA (10).

NOOT THERE IT IS: Lars Nootbaar has reached base safely in 13 of his last 16 games, batting .342 (13-for-38)/1.026 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 homers, 8 RBI, 8 walks and 1 sac fly.

- With runners in scoring position as a D-back, is carrying a .965 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 11 RBI, 6 walks and 1 sac fly.

LATE MAGIC: Ketel Marte, from the eighth inning on, is carrying a .918 OPS with 3 doubles, 7 homers, 20 RBI, 18 walks, 1 stolen base and 2 sac flies.

- **Jordan Lawlar**, from the seventh inning on, is hitting .333 (11-for-33)/.814 OPS with 1 double, 5 RBI and 3 walks.
- **James McCann**, from the seventh inning on, is hitting .365 (41-for-146)/1.007 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers, 10 RBI and 4 walks.
- **Ryan Waldschmidt**, from the eighth inning on, is hitting .409 (18-for-44)/1.127 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 homers (both walk-offs), 7 RBI, 7 walks and 1 sac fly.
- **Lars Nootbaar**, from the ninth inning on, is hitting .381 (8-for-21)/1.071 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 3 RBI, 6 walks and 1 sac fly.

STRONG ARMS: The D-backs bullpen’s 2.45 ERA (16 R-14 ER in 51.1 IP) in September ranks best in the NL, ahead of the Padres (2.87), Giants (3.40) and Cubs (3.43)...third in MLB behind the Blue Jays (2.10) and Guardians (2.24).

- Since Sept. 5, D-backs starters’ combined 3.65 ERA (15 ER in 37.0 IP) ranks tied for fifth in the NL with the Nationals to the Phillies (2.82), Pirates (2.97), Brewers (3.32) and Dodgers (3.43).

1-RUN WINS: 27 of the D-backs’ 79 wins (34 pct.) have been decided by 1 run...their 27 1-run victories are their most in a season since 2017 (29), and are second most in the Majors this season, behind the Dodgers (30) and ahead of the Braves (26).

VS. MARLINS: The D-backs are 6-6 in their last 12 games.
