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BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles conclude a seven-game homestand tonight against the Guardians (1-1, 1 to play) after being swept in a four-game series by the Red Sox...The O's are in the midst of 16 games in as many days since August 25, which will end with tomorrow's off-day...Baltimore is 4.0 games of Cleveland for the final Wild Card spot with Toronto (1.0 GB) and Texas (1.5 GB) also in the mix.

- Yesterday, **Pete Alonso** hit his 298th career home run...Entering play today, there are 18 active players with 300+ career home runs, led by NYY's Giancarlo Stanton (456), LAA's Mike Trout (424), and SD's Manny Machado (395).
- The Birds have scored 2+ runs in 26 consecutive games against the Guardians dating to May 30, 2023...It is tied for the second-longest such streak against Cleveland in franchise history (since 1954), joining September 18 (G2), 1976-May 28 (G2), 1978)...The club record is a 35-game stretch from August 2 (G2), 1983-April 10, 1986.
- Tonight, Baltimore looks for its eighth rubber-match victory of the season, including its first since July 29 at Detroit.

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to tonight's game, the Orioles recalled **INF/OF Jeremiah Jackson** from Triple-A Norfolk and placed **INF/OF Blaze Alexander** (low back discomfort) on the 10-day Injured List.

DUE FOR A BREAKOUT: **Shane Baz** has made 14 starts since June 18 and received 19 runs of support across 81.1 innings...He has posted a 3.76 ERA during that period, but owns a 1-9 record, with the O's going 2-12 in those games.

- Entering play today, since June 14, 107 pitchers in MLB have thrown at least 60.0 innings...Baz's 2.10 run support average during that period is the lowest in the majors, ahead of NYY's Cam Schlichter (2.61) and LAA's Reid Detmers (2.61).

POLAR BEAR SIGHTING: **Pete Alonso** ranks among AL leaders in RBI (1st, 95), total bases (3rd, 272), home runs (4th, 34), slugging percentage (5th, .499), OPS (5th, .860), extra-base hits (6th, 58), runs (8th, 87), and hits (9th, 146).

- Alonso has started all 146 O's games this year, tied for the most in the majors this year with CHC's Pete Crow-Armstrong and SF's Rafael Devers...The only other player in the AL to start each of his team's games this year is TB's Junior Caminero (144 GS)...The last Oriole to start every team game in a season was Jonathan Schoop in 2016.
- He's played in 562 consecutive games, the second-longest active streak in the majors behind ATL's Matt Olson (927 G).
- Alonso leads HOU's Yordan Alvarez (95) for the most RBI in the AL...He looks to become the eighth player in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the AL in RBI, joining Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).
- According to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).

COBY BEEF: **Coby Mayo** saw his career-best 11-game hitting streak come to an end last night, but extended his on-base streak to a career-best 13 straight games...During the 13-game stretch, he is slashing .295/.367/.591 (13-for-44) with one double, four home runs, 11 RBI, an four walks.

- Mayo is batting .321/.381/.746 (43-for-134) with nine doubles, 16 home runs, and 33 RBI this year against left-handed pitching...He leads the majors in home runs, slugging percentage, and OPS (1.127) against lefties...The 16 homers are the second most in a season off lefties by an Oriole since Gary Roenicke hit 18 in 1983.

PLAYING THE LONG GAME: The Birds have hit 41 homers since August 9, tied for the second most in MLB during that time with the Reds behind the Cubs (57).

- The O's have homered in seven straight home games against the Guardians since June 25, 2024, totaling 17 longs balls during that period.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: The O's lead the AL and rank fourth in the majors with 541 walks this season behind the Cubs (615 BB), Brewers (607 BB), and Dodgers (551 BB)...The Yankees are second in the AL with 519 free passes.

- The team's 31 games with 6+ walks are the most by a Baltimore club since 1999 (35).
- The Birds are averaging 3.98 pitches per plate appearance, ranking second in MLB behind the Brewers (3.99).

'PEN PALS: The Orioles bullpen has allowed 17 runs (12 ER) in the last eight games, but the team's 2.25 ERA (16 ER/64.0 IP) in 19 games since August 20 ranks third in the majors during that period behind the Braves (2.17 ERA) and Guardians (2.19 ERA).

- Josh Walker** hasn't allowed a run in 14 games (11.1 IP) since August 6...That's the longest scoreless streak by an Oriole since **Félix Bautista** had a 14-gamer from June 25-August 6, 2023...The last Oriole with a longer scoreless outing stretch was **Yennier Cano** (17 G) from April 14-May 17, 2023...Walker's current stretch is the fifth-longest active stretch in the majors and second in the AL behind TOR's Mason Fluharty (20 G).
- Alex Hoppe** has yet to allow an earned run in 14 appearances (11.0 IP) since making his Orioles debut on August 5.
- Eleven Baltimore pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, breaking the franchise record since saves became an official statistic in 1969...The Birds are one of seven teams in MLB to have at least 11 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Cubs (14).

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 47-51 in games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for the most such games in the majors this year with the Guardians (51-47)...The .480 winning percentage in those games ranks 19th in the majors.

- Baltimore is 16-22 in one-run games this year...The .421 winning percentage ranks 25th in the majors.

AWARD SEASON: RHP **Anthony Eyanson** and OF **Enddy Azocar** have been named the Orioles Minor League Pitcher and Player of the Month for August, respectively.

- Eyanson, 21, made four starts with Double-A Chesapeake, going 2-1 with a 2.14 ERA (5 ER/21.0 IP) and 32 strikeouts.
- Azocar, 19, slashed .353/.398/.588 (30-for-85) with seven doubles, two triples, three home runs, 20 runs, 19 RBI, six walks, and seven steals in 21 games with High-A Frederick.

QUICK HITS: Baz is scheduled to make his 29th start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss on September 4 vs. Boston after tossing 6.1 innings of one-run ball, scattering four hits (1 HR) and two walks with six strikeouts...Threw 95 pitches, 61 strikes.
⚡ Baz has permitted one earned run in nine of his starts, posting a 1.53 ERA (9 ER/53.0 IP) in those outings...However, he owns a 2-3 record in those starts, with the O's going 2-7.

CLEVELAND ROCKS: Baz has made three career starts against the Guardians, going 0-2 with a 4.76 ERA (9 ER/17.0 IP).
⚡ Took the loss at Progressive Field earlier this season on April 16 after throwing 6.0 innings, allowing four runs on six hits (1 HR) and three walks with six strikeouts.
⚡ In that outing, Baz permitted a two-run homer to José Ramírez in the opening frame, while the Guardians added runs in the fifth and sixth frames.

NOW WE TURN THE TIDE: Despite posting a 3.76 ERA (34 ER/81.1 IP) over his last 14 starts since June 18, he is 1-9 in those outings, with the Orioles going 2-12 in his starts.
⚡ The Birds have lost 21 of his 28 starts this season.
⚡ Entering play today, his 15 losses are tied for the most in MLB along with CLE's Tanner Bibee (15)...The 15 losses are the most by an Oriole since Dylan Bundy (16) in 2018.

HELP WANTED: Baz has received 19 runs of support over his 14 starts since June 18, including zero runs in seven of the outings.
⚡ Among all 133 MLB hurlers who have thrown at least 50.0 innings since June 18, Baz's 2.10 run support average is the lowest in MLB ahead of both NYY's Cam Schlitler and CIN's Nick Lodolo (both 2.61).
⚡ Overall, his 3.14 run support average is lowest in MLB ahead of CLE's Tanner Bibee (3.27).

CONTROLLING THE LONG BALL: In 34 starts since August 26, 2025, Baz has permitted 12 home runs over 191.2 innings (0.56 HR/9.0 IP)... Over his first 26 starts of the 2025 campaign, he allowed 26 homers over 138.0 innings (1.70 HR/9.0 IP).
⚡ He has allowed one or zero home runs in each of the 34 outings, the third-longest active streak among all MLB starters behind STL's Andre Pallante (38 G) and LAD's Kris Bubic (35 G).
⚡ Baz is the only Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) to pitch at least 4.0 innings without allowing more than one home run in each of their first 28 starts with the team, surpassing the previous record held by Jim Hardin (19 GS, 1967-68).
⚡ His 0.66 home runs per nine innings this season signal the lowest mark by an Orioles starter (min. 25 GS) since Scott Erickson (0.65 HR/9.0 IP) in 2014.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Entering play today, Baz has allowed 41 doubles, second most in MLB behind KC's Seth Lugo (43)...On April 21 at Kansas City, Baz permitted a career-high five doubles.
⚡ His 35 doubles were the most allowed by an Oriole pitcher in the first half of the season in club history (since 1954), ahead of Rodrigo López (34, 2006).

KNUCKLE SANDWICH: After holding the opposition to a .184 (9-for-49) clip on his knuckle curveball in May, opponents hit .283 (15-for-53) against the offering in June and 13-for-37 (.351) off it in July.
⚡ In six August starts, opponents went 9-for-36 (.250) with two doubles and 16 strikeouts against the pitch.
⚡ In his last start, Boston went 2-for-11 with two strikeouts.

MAKE 'EM (UN)EARN IT: Baz has allowed 10 unearned runs, ninth most among MLB starters and sixth in the AL behind CLE's Joey Cantillo (15), MIN's Joe Ryan/NYY's Will Warren (both 13), and Kyle Bradish/TB's Griffin Jax (both 12).

TEEEING OFF EARLY: Opponents are slashing .337/.352/.618 (30-for-89) with 13 doubles and four home runs off Baz on the first pitch of an at-bat.
