NATIONALS NEWS

STAYING HOT IN THE DESERT

The Washington Nationals and Arizona Diamondbacks continue their three-game weekend series with game two on Saturday at Chase Field.

- The Nationals took game one last night against the Diamondbacks, 14-1...**Foster Griffin** earned his seventh win of the season, allowing just one earned run on two hits with four strikeouts in 5.0 innings...The offense recorded 16 hits and **Luis García Jr.** hit his first career grand slam in the sixth inning and finished with two homers and a career-high six RBI.
- With a win today, the Nationals will secure their third consecutive series victory against the Diamondbacks dating back to April 4-6, 2025...A win would also mark Washington's fourth consecutive road series win...It would be the Nationals longest streak since May 2018, per *Elias Sports Bureau*.
- The Nationals are 20-12 (.625) on the road this season...Washington's 20 wins on the road are tied second-most in Major League Baseball with the Dodgers (20) and behind only the Braves (23)...The .625 winning percentage is tied for third best.
- Overall, the Nationals are 21-16 (.5567) since April 25...Washington has won eight of their 13 series over this stretch and has lost just two series since May 2.

VOTE FOR OUR ALL-STARS

All-Star voting is now open and **CJ Abrams** and **James Wood** have placed themselves among the best players in Major League Baseball and the National League...See charts to the right for position specific rankings.

- Abrams has reached base safely in 10 of the last 11 games...He has two doubles, two home runs, three RBI, two hit by pitches, six walks, two stolen bases and seven runs scored during that span.
- Wood has reached base safely in 18 of his last 20 games, hitting .342/.457/.592 with four doubles, five home runs, 11 RBI, 15 walks, one hit by pitch and 20 runs scored during that stretch.

GO LUIS GO!

Since May 23, **Luis García Jr.** is hitting .300 (12-for-40) with a double, a triple, four home runs, 15 RBI, two walks and five runs scored in 11 games.

- García Jr. hit his first career grand slam on June 5 at Arizona...Was his second multi-homer game on the season and finished the night with a career-high six RBI.

BACKSTOP BATS

Drew Millas and **Keibert Ruiz** have been the most productive offense catching tandem in Major League Baseball since May 6...Combined, they rank among all MLB catching groups in slugging percentage (1st, .588), OPS (1st, .961), batting average (1st, .320), home runs (T5th, 6), RBI (T3rd, 23) and hits (7th, 30).

- Ruiz has hit safely in 12 of his last 16 games, going 21-for-55 (.382) with seven doubles, four homers, 17 RBI, two walks, one stolen base and 13 runs scored.
- On the season, Ruiz is tied for third among Major League catchers with 12 doubles and among all catchers (min. 100 PA) in slugging percentage (9th, .469).

VERY OFFENSIVE AS OF LATE

Since May 6, Washington's offense ranks first in runs scored (162), RBI (157) and in home runs (46), second in slugging percentage (.468) and doubles (54) and third in OPS (.782).

- Washington has scored 49 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals recorded at least one extra-base hit in 32 straight games from April 29-June 2, the fourth-longest active streak in baseball behind San Francisco (36), Pittsburgh (34) and Chicago White Sox (33) at that time.

THUNDER FROM DOWN UNDER

Curtis Mead is hitting .292 (26-for-89) with six doubles, five home runs, 16 RBI, 16 walks (.411 OBP), a stolen base and 20 runs scored over his last 28 games since April 29.

- Mead has six RBI over his last seven games and nine RBI over his last 10 games...He is hitting .318 (7-for-22) with runners in scoring position since April 29.

THIS AND THAT

Some notable notes about other Nationals players:

- Dylan Crews** has reached safely in all 13 games since being recalled on May 19, the longest active on-base streak on the Nationals.
- Daylen Life** is tied for second among National League outfielders with 15 doubles.
- Nasim Nuñez** is tied for most stolen bases (22) in Major League Baseball with **Jose Ramirez** and **Bobby Witt Jr.**

SAVES ON SAVES

The Washington Nationals have had eight separate pitchers record at least one save this season, the second-most in Major League Baseball (Minnesota, 11) and tied for the second-most in Nationals history (2005-pres.) with the 2009 Nationals and behind the 2017 Nationals.

- Gus Varland** (4), **Richard Lovelady** (4), **Clayton Beeter** (4), **Orlando Ribalta** (2), **Andrew Alvarez** (1), **Mitchell Parker** (1), **PJ Poulin** (2) and **Paxton Schultz** (1) have all recorded saves this year.

FARM REPORT

NOT JOSH'IN AROUND

Harrisburg right-handed pitcher **Josh Randall** threw 7.0 scoreless innings striking out nine batters while only allowing three hits and a walk in yesterday's 21-4 victory...In his last three starts, he's gone 2-0 and has allowed just one earned run with 18 strikeouts and a .185 opponent's average in 18.0 innings pitched.

CAREER

Veteran starter is one of 27 pitchers in Major League Baseball to make 67 starts and maintain an ERA under 3.99 since the beginning of 2024.

- Littell (lih-TELL) began his career as a reliever before moving to the rotation in 2023 after being claimed by Tampa Bay...Is 21-27 with a 3.99 ERA in 80 starts since June 29, 2023.
- In 2024, was named the recipient of the Paul C. Smith Champion Award by the Tampa Bay chapter of the BBWAA, presented to the player who best exemplifies the spirit of true professionalism on and off the field.

LAST START

Littell allowed two earned runs on five hits and two walks across 6.0 innings of work...He struck out five to earn the win in the 4-2 victory over the San Diego Padres on May 31.

vs. ARIZONA

Littell is set to make his fifth career start and 11th career appearance against Arizona...He is 1-1 with a 5.71 ERA (11 ER/17.1 IP) and 16 strikeouts.

MAY FLOWERS

Littell went 5-0 in the month of May, pitching to a 2.35 ERA (8 ER/30.2 IP) with a .209 opponents' average and 19 strikeouts across six appearances.

- Ranks tied for first in Major League Baseball for wins in the month of May with Milwaukee's **Jacob Misiorowski**.
- He did not allow an earned run on May 15 against the Baltimore Orioles for the first time since July 30, 2025.

2025

He led Major League Baseball with .042 walks per batter faced and was second with 1.54 walks per 9.0 innings...His 32 starts were tied for ninth in Major League Baseball...Did not issue a walk in 13 starts, tied with Tarik Skubal for the most-such outings in MLB...Was acquired by the Reds at the Trade Deadline.

- Set career highs in wins (10), starts (32) and innings pitched (186.2), while pitching to a 3.81 ERA for Tampa Bay and Cincinnati in 2025.
- He tossed his first career complete game on May 31 at Houston (9.0 IP, 10 H, 3 ER, BB, 6 SO).
- Made his Reds Postseason debut as the club's starting pitcher in Game 2 of the National League Wild Card Series at Los Angeles (NL)...Was his first career Postseason start after five Postseason relief appearances with Minnesota (2019), San Francisco (2021) and Tampa Bay (2023).
- 2025 Pitch Mix:** Slider (27.5%) Split Finger (27.3%) Four Seamer (23.8%) Sinker (16.0%) Sweeper (5.4%)

2024

In his first full season as a starter, went 8-10 with a 3.63 ERA in his seventh Major League season...Led the Rays in wins (11st, 8), innings (156.1), starts (29) and quality starts (11st, 10)...All were career highs.

- From April 17-May 4, recorded at least six strikeouts without issuing a walk in a club-record four straight starts...On May 11 vs. New York (AL), he walked Anthony Rizzo in the second inning to end a streak of 123 batters faced without walk, the fourth longest in franchise history.
