AROUND THE HORN

SERPIENTES REPLICA JERSEY AND POSTGAME FIREWORKS: On Friday, Postgame Fireworks return with music from My Chemical Romance and Jimmy Eat World to celebrate their upcoming concert at Chase Field on September 6...on Saturday, the first 25,000 fans can get a Serpientes Replica Jersey courtesy of Talking Stick Resort.

MEXICAN BASEBALL HALL OF FAME: On May 12, the Mexican Baseball Hall of Fame announced its Mexican Baseball Immortals of Class 2026, featuring the D-backs' own **Erubiel Durazo** and **Rodrigo Lopez** in the "Mexicans in Major Leagues" category...**Durazo**, who was a member of the D-backs' 2001 World Championship team, played 4 seasons (1999-2002) with Arizona and has served as D-backs Special Advisor on Mexico to the President, CEO & General Partner since 2016...**Lopez** pitched for the D-backs in 2010, where he led the team in innings (200.0) and starts (33), and has served as an analyst for D-backs Spanish Radio broadcasts since 2014 as well as GM of Team Mexico in the WBC in 2023 and 2026.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are 6-3 since May 9.

- D-backs' starters have recorded 9 quality starts in their last 13 outings since May 5 and allowed 2 or fewer runs in 9 of those.
- Ildemaro Vargas'** next game will be his 500th career game and 222nd as a D-back.
- Corbin Carroll** had his first career 7-game span with 6+ extra-base hits and 6+ walks, May 11-18, hitting .435 (10-for-23)/1.507 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 4 RBI and 9 walks (3 K).
- Gabriel Moreno** has 4 straight multi-hit games, batting .474 (9-for-19) with 1 double, 1 homer, 5 RBI, 1 walk and 2 stolen bases.
- Ketel Marte** has hit safely in 3 of his last 4 games at a .353 clip (6-for-17)/.812 OPS with 1 double, 2 RBI and 2 walks.
- Since May 5, the D-backs' 2.43 ERA ranks second in the Majors, behind the Brewers (11 G, 2.29).
 - In the span, the D-backs rank among MLB leaders in quality starts (1st, 9), innings (1st, 85.1), IP/G (1st, 6.2), OBP (1st, .248), WHIP (1st, 0.94), opponent AVG (2nd, .193) and strikeouts (3rd, 74).
- With a win, the D-backs will improve to above .500 for the first time since May 1.
- The D-backs seek their third series win in their last 4 (won vs. Mets, lost @ Rangers, won @ Rockies).

LAST GAME: The D-backs had a season-high 12 runs and 16 hits in a 12-2 win vs. Giants last night.

- The D-backs scored 7+ runs in the first 3.0 innings for the first time since May 19, 2025 @ Dodgers (7).
- Zac Gallen** tossed his second start of 6.0+ innings with 2 or fewer runs and 1 or fewer walks this season (also: April 1 vs. Tigers, 6.0 IP, 0 R, 0 BB).
- Nolan Arenado** hit his seventh career grand slam, first since Aug. 21, 2024 vs. Brewers and second career in the first inning (prev: Sept. 26, 2015 vs. Dodgers with the Rockies)...became the second D-backs cleanup hitter with a first-inning grand slam (also: Stephen Drew on April 28, 2011 vs. Cubs).
- Corbin Carroll** collected his league-leading fifth triple in the second inning.
- Ryan Waldschmidt** became the third D-back rookie (fifth time) ever to reach base 4+ times with 2+ stolen bases in a single game (last: Corbin Carroll on Sept. 20, 2023 vs. Giants).

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs selected C **Aramis Garcia** (No. 35) from Triple-A Reno and placed C **James McCann** on the 10-day injured list (strained right quad).

DIVISION SHOWDOWNS: The D-backs are 3-1 in this stretch of 13 straight NL West matchups (2-1 from May 15-17 @ Rockies, 1-0 from May 18-20 vs. Giants, May 21-24 vs. Rockies, May 25-27 @ Giants) and 17 of their next 20 (also: June 1-4 vs. Dodgers).

TRIPLE WATCH: Corbin Carroll is 2 triples shy (48 in 532 G) of 50 career and 5 from setting the club record (current: Stephen Drew, 52 in 773 G).

- Since 2023, his 46 triples are most in the Majors, ahead of Jarren Duran/BOS (29), Bobby Witt Jr./KC (29), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (25) and Elly De La Cruz/CIN (24).

GIANT SLAYER: Nolan Arenado's 35 homers, 83 extra-base hits and 119 RBI vs. Giants are the most among active MLB players.

- Since 1985, only 4 other players have hit 30+ homers vs. Giants: Gary Sheffield (34), Paul Goldschmidt (32), Jeff Bagwell (32) and Larry Walker (32).

BULLPEN RECENTLY AT HOME: In their last 7 home games, the D-backs' bullpen carries a 0.54 ERA (2 R-1 ER in 16.2 IP) with an opponent .143 AVG (8-for-56)/.383 OPS, 0.60 WHIP, 2 walks and 13 strikeouts.

- In its last 11 games, has held lefties to a .188 AVG (9-for-48)/.513 OPS with 6 walks and 14 strikeouts.
- Jonathan Loaisiga** has 7 straight scoreless home outings (6.1 IP, 3 H, 1 BB, 3 K).

HOMETRENDS: Nolan Arenado has reached base in 11 of his last 12 home games, hitting .405 (15-for-37)/1.187 OPS with 1 double, 3 homers, 8 RBI and 7 walks.

- Ryan Waldschmidt**, in his first 4 home games, is batting .545 (6-for-11)/1.402 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 RBI and 1 walk.

VS. GIANTS: The D-backs have won 5 of their last 8 home (4-3 last season).

- Have won 4 consecutive season series by a single game since 2022 (7-6 from 2023-25 and 10-9 in 2022).
- Have won 5 of their last 7 home series since May 11-14, 2023.

- Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has hit safely in 23 straight starts (since June 24, 2023), the longest active streak in MLB vs. Giants, batting .363 (33-for-91)/.991 OPS with 8 doubles, 4 homers, 12 RBI and 7 walks.

- Corbin Carroll** has an 8-game home hitting streak, batting .364 (12-for-33)/.894 OPS with 1 double, 2 triples, 3 RBI, 2 walks and 1 stolen base...has reached base safely 2+ times in 5 of the 8 games.

NEXT STARTER: RHP MERRILL KELLY (3-3, 5.91)

- Recorded his first career complete game in his last start on May 15 @ Rockies (1 R-0 ER in 9.0 IP, 4 H, 0 BB, 3 K).
- Has 4 straight quality starts vs. Giants, going 2-0 with a 2.36 ERA (7 ER in 26.2 IP), 6 walks and 24 strikeouts.
