In his last 38 games, **Jackson Chourio** is batting .310 (40-for-129) with 5 HR and 24 RBI.....during this stretch, he has a .362 OBP/.496 SLG/.858 OPS.

In the absence of Devin Williams this season, Trevor Megill has 20 saves in 22 opportunities (90.9%)..... he notched his first career save on 4/25 at Pittsburgh and ranks fourth in the majors in saves since that date.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Brewers are 18-11-3 in series play Game 1: 16-17, Game 2: 20-13, Game 3: 19-11, Game 4: 3-2 Sweep Wins [5]: at NYM [3g, 3/29-3/31], at STL [3g, 4/19-4/21], vs. CWS (3g, 5/31-6/2), vs. TEX (3g, 6/24-6/26), at MIN (2g, 7/20-7/21) Sweep Losses [1]: at PHI (3g, 6/3-6/5)

AT HOME: The Brewers are 29-17 at home, going 10-4-1 in series play.....the team has lost its last two home series (1-2 vs. PIT, 1-2 vs. WSH) after winning nine home series in a row.....the team has gone 25-10 in its last 35 home games after a 5-7 start.....the Brewers had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from May 29-June 10.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 29-26 on the road, going 8-7-2 in series play.....the team had a season-high 4-game road winning streak from April 9-13.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing Bud Black in June [42-54].....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach **Jim Henderson** (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff..... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 26 replay challenges this season, going 16-10.....their last challenge (won) came on 7/23 at Chicago-NL as an out call at first base involving Garrett Mitchell was overturned.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP FREDDY PERALTA (20gs, 6-5, 3.88)

RHP Freddy Peralta will be making his 21st start of the season and second against the Marlins.....Peralta last started last Saturday at Minnesota and received no decision in the Brewers' 8-4, 12-inning win (6ip, 2h, 0r, 2bb, 8k, 1wp, 102 pitches).....he left the game with a 1-0 lead.....the team is 13-7 in his starts.....he has 8 quality starts.....opponents are batting .220 (89-for-404, 14hr).....Peralta is 3-3 with a 4.19 ERA in 9 career games/6 starts against Miami (34.1ip, 30h, 16r, 16er, 6bb, 45k, 6hr), including a 1-0 loss this season on 5/22 at loanDepot park (7ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 7k, 1hr)..... his only run allowed came on a leadoff homer to Jazz Chisholm Jr.
