THE TWINS: After completing their first home series of the season by going 1-2 against Houston last weekend, the Twins began their second roadtrip of the season by going 1-2 through three games in Kansas City, their one win being last night...today, the Twins will play the four-game series finale at Kauffman Stadium...after today's game, the Twins will return home for a six-game homestand, playing three against Detroit over the weekend, followed by three against the Mets from Monday-Wednesday.

After three-straight night games in Kansas City, the Twins are playing their ninth day game of the season today...they are 2-6 in day games to start the season...their two wins are a 6-1 victory on April 2 at Chicago-AL and a 6-1 victory on April 5 vs. Houston.

RYAN KING: The Twins beat the Royals last night at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 4-0, their first shutout of the season and first since a 2-0 victory on August 30, 2024 vs. Toronto...Joe Ryan (1-1) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, no walks and four strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, three from Ty France, who hit his first homer of the season and drove in two runs...Matt Wallner also homered, giving the Twins two home runs in a game for the second time this season (the other was 4/2 at CWS)...the win for Minnesota snapped a six-game losing streak to Kansas City, beating them for the first time since August 13, 2024 at Target Field...it was their first win at Kauffman since March 30, 2024.

RETURNING TO THE SCENE: In a three-start stretch against the Royals from July 29, 2023-May 29, 2024, Bailey Ober went 0-3, 17.42 ERA (10.1 IP, 20 ER) with eight home runs allowed...however, in his last start against the Royals on September 7, 2024, he pitched 7.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed, no walks and seven strikeouts...below are his game logs in his last four starts against the Royals:

FROM LAKES TO FOUNTAINS: The Twins are playing the fourth of 13 games against the Royals this season and fourth of seven games at Kauffman Stadium...the next series between these two will be three games at Target Field from May 23-25...the next time the Twins will travel back to Kansas City will be for three games from September 5-7.

Twins have gone 29-17 in their last 46 against the Royals, dating back to April 21, 2022. Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 57-39 vs. Kansas City...57 wins are tied for his most against any opponent (Chicago-AL - 57-39).

Carlos Correa is hitting .302 (60-for-199) with 13 doubles, seven home runs, 23 RBI, 26 walks, a .382 on-base percentage and an .865 OPS in 52 games against the Royals since '19. Harrison Bader is hitting .313 (15-for-48) with a .796 OPS in 13 career games at Kauffman Stadium...he has reached safely in 12 of those 13.

Ty France is hitting .412 (47-for-114) with 10 doubles, six home runs, 22 RBI, a .496 on-base percentage, a .658 slugging percentage and a 1.154 OPS in 30 career games against the Royals; the OPS is his highest against any opponent...in 14 career games at Kauffman, he is slashing .481/.591/.769 (1.360 OPS)...among players with a minimum of 50 plate appearances at Kauffman since 2021, France ranks first in batting average, on-base percentage and OPS, and second in slugging.

Career notables vs. Michael Wacha: France is 10-for-20 (.500) with five doubles...Christian Vázquez is 5-for-11 (.455)...Bader is 4-for-11 (.364).

C4, SLOW BURN: Carlos Correa has gone 3-for-11 with three doubles and a walk in this series...below are Correa's number comparisons over the first 12 games of the season:

THE WILL TO BE ON BASE: Willi Castro has reached base safely in all 11 of his games played, the fifth-longest active on-base streak in the AL, trailing Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (13), Jacob Wilson (13), Kristian Campbell (12) and Adley Rutschman (12).

It marks the longest on-base streak for a Twin to start a season since Trevor Larnach reached safely in his first 11 of 2023...the last time a Twin reached in their first 12 games of a season came in 2018, when both Brian Dozier (17 games) and Joe Mauer (13 games) did it.

BIRTHDAY BOYS: Scott Blewett is celebrating his 29th birthday today...he has never appeared in a major league game on his birthday...Twins hitting coach Rayden Sierra is also celebrating a birthday today, his 30th.

BASEBALL ROYALTY: Paul Molitor hit .287 (124-for-432) with 24 doubles, three triples, 11 home runs, 42 RBI and a .771 OPS in 105 career games at Kauffman Stadium...his only career three-homer game was in this ballpark on May 12, 1982, going yard off Dennis Leonard twice and Dan Quisenberry once...one of Mollie's seven five-hit games was also in this ballpark on September 4, 1995, hitting three singles, one double and one home run.
