THE TWINS: After finishing their six-game, eight-day roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (1-2 at Baltimore and 1-2 at Kansas City), the Twins opened their first homestand of the season with a split of the first two games against the Rays...today, Minnesota will host Tampa Bay for the three-game series finale...starting tomorrow night, the Twins will host the Tigers for four games from Monday-Thursday.
 ☞ Today marks day five of a stretch of 15-straight days with a game for Minnesota...their next off-day will be on April 16.
 ☞ Twins went 7-5 in rubber games in 2025...final rubber game win was September 25, 2025 at Texas...they are 0-1 in rubber games this season, dropping their only chance in the finale at Baltimore on March 29.

GAME TWO GOES THE WAY OF THE RAYS: The Twins lost to the Rays last night at Target Field by a score of 7-1...Mick Abel (0-2) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing four runs on six hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with three walks and three strikeouts...the offense recorded just three hits, singles from Matt Wallner, Brooks Lee and Luke Keaschall...Lee drove in the only run for the Twins on the night with a second inning single...Twins hitters also drew three walks and struck out nine times.

LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Garrett Acton from Triple-A St. Paul...Acton, 27, was acquired from the Miami Marlins on Thursday, reported to St. Paul and did not pitch for the Saints...he recently appeared in two games for Triple-A Jacksonville, pitching 2.1 scoreless innings, with one hit allowed, one walk and four strikeouts for the Jumbo Shrimp...the 6-foot-2, 215-pound righty spent most of 2025 with Triple-A Durham in Tampa Bay's organization, going 5-1, 3.68 ERA (58.2 IP, 24 ER), 27 walks, 71 strikeouts, three saves and a 1.13 WHIP in 45 games (4 starts)...the Naperville, Illinois native was originally selected by the White Sox in the 35th round of the 2016 MLB Draft and has appeared in seven major league games, six in 2023 with Oakland and one in 2025 with Tampa Bay.
 ☞ To make room for Acton on the 26-man roster, the Twins optioned right-handed pitcher Zak Kent to St. Paul after last night's game vs. Tampa Bay...Kent appeared in two games for the Twins, allowing five runs (2 earned) on four hits, with five walks and two strikeouts in 3.2 innings pitched.

RAY AREA: The Twins and Rays are playing the third of six games this season as Minnesota won the first game last night...these two will play again for three games at Tropicana Field from April 24-26, on the back end of a six-game roadtrip that starts in New York against the Mets.
 ☞ Twins are 95-100 all-time against the Rays...they were 44-29 against Tampa from 1998-2006, but have gone 51-71 since 2007.

BYRON BUXTON FROM BAXLEY: Byron Buxton is celebrating 10 years of MLB service today...Buck was drafted second overall by Minnesota in 2012 and made his debut with the Twins as a 21-year-old on June 14, 2015 at Texas...he recorded his first major league hit in his next game on June 15 at St. Louis, tripling off John Lackey...he hit his first home run on September 27, 2015, off Jose Valdez...on the Twins all-time list, Buxton ranks sixth in stolen bases (117), ninth in home runs (168), 12th in triples (32), 18th in runs scored (525), 21st in doubles (179) and 22nd in games (905).
 ☞ List of Twins (since 1961)/Senators (1901-60) to reach the 10-year service mark with the Twins/Senators as their first (or only) team (13): Harmon Killebrew, Kirby Puckett, Kent Hrbek, Rod Carew, Joe Mauer, Gary Gaetti, Tony Oliva, Bob Allison, Eddie Guardado, Randy Bush, Jim Kaat, Glen Perkins and Brad Radke.

BULLSEYE BUCK: Over his final 43 games of 2025, Byron Buxton slashed .273/.337/.553 with an .870 OPS at Target Field...in that span, he hit 13 doubles, three triples, eight home runs, 21 RBI and 32 runs scored, while going 9-for-9 in stolen base attempts...he enters today with 84 career home runs at Target Field, tied with Max Kepler for the most in the ballpark's history (top 10 - lower right margin).
 ☞ Buck's .878 OPS at Target Field last season was the 10th-highest in the AL among players with at least 275 plate appearances in their home ballpark...his .541 slugging percentage ranked sixth in that same group.
 ☞ Buxton's other rankings in Target Field history (since 2010): first in stolen bases (67), fourth in runs (264) and RBI (215), fifth in hits (382), and sixth in doubles (80)...below are Target Field rankings in a few offensive categories:

TWINS GO FOR THE MEATLOAF: A win today and the Twins will earn their first series victory of the season...they have gone 0-2-0 in series play, losing a series 1-2 in Baltimore from March 26-29 and another 1-2 in Kansas City from Monday-Thursday.
 ☞ Last season, they went 18-32-2 in series play last season, going 11-13-2 at home and 7-19-0 on the road...Minnesota finished the season going 1-7-0 in their final eight series, their only win coming September 23-25 at Texas, taking two of three from the Rangers during their final roadtrip.
 ☞ A series win over the Rays will mark their second consecutive series victory over Tampa Bay after taking two of three during their last series from July 4-6, 2025 at Target Field...the last time the Twins won consecutive series' over the Rays was when they won both in 2022, two games to one.

TWINS MILB WEEKLYS: Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitchers James Ellwanger and Reed Moring have been named Twins minor league co-Pitchers of the Week, and Double-A Wichita infielder Ben Ross has been named Player of the Week.
 ☞ Ellwanger, 21, made his professional debut in a start vs. Clearwater on Friday, pitching 3.0 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, one walk and four strikeouts...he was drafted by the Twins in the third round last July out of Dallas Baptist University.
 ☞ Moring, 21, piggybacked Ellwanger in that start and pitched 4.0 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, no walks and seven strikeouts...Moring was selected by the Twins in the 15th round last July out of the University of California, Santa Barbara.
 ☞ Ross, 24, played in two games for the Wind Surge, going 4-for-7 with one double, one home run, four RBI and a walk against Northwest Arkansas...Ross was selected by the Twins in the fifth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Notre Dame.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2014, Ron Gardenhire earned his 1,000th career managerial victory with a 7-3 win at Cleveland, managing his 1,950th career game...Gardy is second on the Twins all-time list for managerial victories with 1,068, trailing Tom Kelly's 1,140...in 2019, Jorge Polanco became the 11th player in club history to hit for the cycle, doing so at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia.
