HAPPY HOUR: The St. Louis Cardinals begin their 10th homestand of the season with today's make-up game against the visiting Arizona Diamondbacks (from June 25) ... Today's Happy Hour launches an eight-game homestand (Diamondbacks-1, Reds-3, Cubs-4) as the Redbirds continue a stretch of 20 consecutive games before their next open date on August 6 ... St. Louis finished 2-4 over its recent six-day road trip against the Diamondbacks (1-2) and Angels (1-2) out of the All-Star break.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters play today tied with Pittsburgh for 3rd place in the National League Central, 11.5 games behind 1st place Milwaukee and 4.5 games behind 2nd place Chicago ... The Cardinals are currently tied with Pittsburgh for 4th in the NL Wild Card race, but sit just 1/2 game back of Arizona for the final spot ... According to *Elias*, St. Louis has played the hardest strength of schedule so far this season, facing opponents with a combined .512 win percentage through the first 101 games.

HAPPY HOUR SHOWDOWNS: According to research dating back 30 seasons, St. Louis will play only its 2nd scheduled regular season home game in the 4 o'clock hour (not part of a doubleheader) today when they host the Diamondbacks at 4:15 p.m. Central Time, making up the June 25 rain-out between the two clubs.

- The last time St. Louis played a regular season home game with a first pitch occurring in the 4 o'clock hour was August 5, 2024 vs. the Mets, making up a May 8 rain-out and completing the season series.
- The previous Cardinals regular season home game in the 4 o'clock hour (not part of a doubleheader) was May 11, 2019 vs. the Pirates at 4:11 p.m., a 1:15 p.m. scheduled first pitch that was delayed 2 hours and 56 minutes due to rain.
- The last time St. Louis hosted a Postseason game in the 4 o'clock hour was 4:39 p.m. vs. the Cubs (Oct. 10, 2015).

IT'S WHACKING DAY: The Cardinals .600 win pct. (114-76) against the Diamondbacks is their best against any opponent (min. 25 games) and the highest in MLB vs. the Snakes among National League and common interleague opponents.

DIRTY MIKE AND THE BOYS: **Michael McGreevy** has allowed two runs or fewer in 13 of his 19 starts this season, tying Philadelphia's **Cristopher Sanchez** for the most such starts in MLB this season ... McGreevy's 0.49 ERA (18.1 IP) vs. NL West opponents this season is the lowest of any Major League pitcher (min. 15.0 innings).

GAME TIME IS ON TIME: Beginning with last Sunday's series finale in Arizona at 1:10 MT, the Cardinals will not repeat game times for nine consecutive games, playing at 7:10 PT, 6:38 PT and 1:07 PT in Anaheim, followed by 4:15 CT, 7:15 CT, 6:15 CT, 1:15 CT and 6:45 CT starts this homestand.

WETHER-BOLTS: With his game-winning homer yesterday in Anaheim, rookie **JJ Wetherholt** joined **Alec Burleson** (June 7, 2023 at Texas off Jon Gray) and **Pepper Martin** (June 21, 1931 at Boston off Socks Seibold) as only the 3rd Cardinals rookie (since 1900) to homer in 1-0 shutout win (9 innings) ... The 23-year-old Wetherholt has established new franchise rookie home run records to leadoff a game (4), by a leadoff batter (15), and by a second baseman (14).

EVERYDAY IVÁN: Today marks the first game this season that C/DH **Iván Herrera** is not in the Cardinals starting lineup ... The 26-year-old Herrera is the lone player to have appeared in each of the Cardinals first 101 games this season, which is 11 shy of matching **Joe Torre's** club mark for catchers of 112 games from the start in 1971 ... The last Cardinal to play in the first 101 or more games of the season was 1B **Paul Goldschmidt** (first 133 games of 2019).

HAPPY BIRTHDAY KT: Cardinals Bullpen Catcher and reigning Home Run Derby Champion Pitcher **Kleininger "KT" Teran** celebrates his 37th birthday today ... Others celebrating today include Diamondbacks Hitting Coach and former Cardinal **Joe Mather** (44), former All-Star shortstop **Nomar Garciaparra** (53), and Hall of Fame Point Guard **Gary Payton** (58).

ARIZONA CONNECTIONS

Nolan Arenado played five seasons in St. Louis (2021-25), where he was a three-time NL All-Star and the winner of one Silver Slugger Award and a pair of Platinum Gold Gloves Awards...traded to Arizona with cash considerations for RHP Jack Martinez (Jan. 13, 2026).

Matthew Liberatore was born in Peoria, Ariz.... graduated from Mountain Ridge High School in Glendale...signed his letter of intent to the University of Arizona before being drafted by the Rays.

JoJo Romero played college baseball at Yavapai College in Prescott, Ari...committed to transfer to the University of Arizona, but first spent a season at Yavapai due to transfer restrictions, and was subsequently drafted before transferring.

George Soriano made his MLB debut vs. Arizona (April 16, 2023), tossing 3.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball with a pair of strikeouts...fanned Corbin Carroll for his first career strikeout.

Jon Jay played 84 games for Arizona in 2018.

Kyle Driscoll previously worked two seasons (2024-25) as Pitching Coordinator with Arizona.

Dbacks Hitting Coach **Joe Mather** was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2001 MLB Draft... played parts of two years in St. Louis (2008, '10).

Dbacks 1B Coach **Dave McKay** served in the same position for St. Louis for 16 seasons (1996-2011).

Casey Chenoweth served as a Diamondbacks hitting coordinator from 2020-22 in Scottsdale prior to joining the Cardinals organization.

Daniel Descalso played two seasons for the Diamondbacks (2017-18)...served as a Special Assistant to Baseball Operations for Arizona in 2023.

Brandon Allen played parts of three seasons (2009-11) with the D-Backs...made his MLB debut with Arizona (Aug. 22, 2009 at Minute Maid)... singled off **Brian Moehler** for first career hit.

Ildemaro Vargas was signed by St. Louis as an international free agent (June 26, 2008) and played seven seasons in the Cardinals minor league system (2008-14).

Zac Gallen was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft...pitched two seasons in Cardinals minor league system before being traded to Miami as part of the package to acquire **Marcell Ozuna** (Dec. 14, 2017).

Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** was a Dbacks Baseball Operations Executive for parts of four seasons (2014-17).

D-Backs Player & Media Relations Coordinator **Kat Ritter** previously worked as a Cardinals Communications Gameday Associate in 2019.

Arizona VP of Latin American Scouting **César Gerónimo** previously worked six seasons (2011-16) as a Cardinals international crosschecker.

TODAY'S START:

- Making his 20th start of the season, continuing to add to his career-high in starts and appearances. Making consecutive starts vs. Arizona, after pitching at Chase Field getting the call to open the 2nd half following the All-Star Break.
- Allowed two runs or fewer in 13 of his 19 starts this season; his 13 starts of 6.0+ IP and 2 or fewer runs allowed tie Philadelphia's Cristopher Sanchez for the most in MLB.**
- Is 1-1 with a 2.21 ERA in 7 day games starts this season with an 0.93 WHIP. Lowest day tilt ERA among Cardinals starters. Has only allowed more than two runs in a day game once (at DET, 4/3 - 3 R).
- Since making his MLB debut (July 31, 2024), leads qualifying Cardinals starting pitchers in ERA (3.45), opponent BA (.246), and WHIP (1.13), Hits/9 (8.38).
- Held his opposition to 3 runs or fewer in all 9 home starts this season (2-2, 1.89 ERA, 52.1 IP); ranks 5th among MLB starters in home ERA.
- Distributes pitches well ranking among N.L. leaders in Pct. Pitches Taken (54.6%, 6th), Pct. Pitches Put in Play (19.7%, 7th), Pct. Swings Put In Play (43.5%, 2nd), Fewest Pitches/Inning (15.6, 9th),
- Has made 20 career appearances (18 starts) at Busch Stadium where he is 7-5 with a 3.28 ERA (112.1 IP).
- The Cardinals are 24-16 (.600 win pct.) in his 40 career games started.
- Has yet to issue more than three walks in any of his first 38 career starts, longest such streak to begin a career by a Cardinal. Seattle's **George Kirby** leads active leaders with 130.
- Allowed 1 run or fewer with 6.0+ IP in a four-start stretch (April 26-May 14), the longest such streak by a Cardinal since **Adam Wainwright** had four straight starts from Sept. 2-18, 2019.
- Has pitched 6.0+ innings in 25 of 38 career starts (22 quality starts).
- Since joining the rotation June 8, 2025, St. Louis has won 19 of his starts - three shy of **Matthew Liberatore** for the most among all STL starters.

LAST TIME OUT (Friday, July 17 at Arizona):, ND, W, 5-4; 6.1 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 5 SO, HR; 94 pitches

- Matched his season-high with 6.1 innings en route to a no decision in a 5-4 Cardinals win, taking the final lead in the 9th inning.
- Held his opposition to two runs or less for a 4th consecutive start tossing 6.0 innings; T-3rd longest streak behind **Jake Bennett** (5, BOS) and **Eduardo Rodriguez** (5, ARI); posted a 1.46 ERA (4 ER/24.2 IP) over that period.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

TWO FOR THE PRICE OF ONE: Has induced 10 ground into double plays, matching his single-season high.

HERE COMES THE SUN...: His 2.21 ERA (40.2 IP/10 ER) in Day games is tops among all Cardinals pitchers with 26-to-5 strikeout to walks ratio, however has allowed 6 of 14 HR in his 7 afternoon starts.

EMPTY HANDED: The Cardinals have given him 2 runs of support or fewer in 8 of his starts. The Cardinals have been shut out five times this season, four of which when McGreevy starts.

FAITH IN FIELDERS: Has the NL's 2nd-lowest percent (19.1) of Swing & Miss and 8th-best BABIP (.254). His difference in Opponent BA (.236) vs. xBA (.285) leads all MLB qualified starting pitchers (-.049).

NESTING: Has worked at least 5.0 innings with 2-or-fewer runs allowed in eight of his nine home starts this season, and did so in each of his 1st four starts before allowing three runs in his 5/20 start vs. PIT.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY!: Celebrated his 26th birthday on July 8 with a 5-1 win over division-leading Milwaukee, limiting the Brew Crew to one run over a season-high 6.1 innings. **HAPPY IT HAPPENED:** Had a 14.0 scoreless innings streak that covered portions of three starts from April 26-May 8 snapped on a leadoff HR by **Nick Kurtz** that was his only run allowed during a 6.0-inning start 5/14 at ATH during a 5-4 St. Louis victory.

ONE-HIT WONDER: Struck out a career-high nine batters at SD (May 8) over 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball at Petco Park in a 6-0 Cardinals win.

DODGE BALL: Blanked the Dodgers on 3 hits over 6.0 IP in a 3-2 win on May 2 as the Cardinals turned 4 double plays behind him.

"NO" NEWS IS GOOD NEWS: Retired the first nine batters en route to 6.0 no-hit innings in his first start of the season vs. TB (3/28) in a no decision the Cardinals won in 10 innings (6-5).

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: Became the first Cardinal to throw 6.0+ no-hit innings in a completed start since **Erick Fedde** on April 9, 2025 at Pittsburgh (6.0 IP). Since 1961, the Cardinals record for the longest hitless inning streak as a starter (excluding any possible intervening relief appearances) to begin a season is 8.0 IP by **Daniel Ponce de Leon** - July 23, 2018 (7.0 IP) and Aug. 21, 2018 (1.0 IP) - *Elias*

RARE BIRD: In his season debut on 3/28 vs. TB, became the 2nd pitcher in team history with a hitless start within his first 2 starts (**Jack Flaherty** 4/1/23 vs. TOR) and the 14th time in MLB a pitcher has in a start of 6.0+ IP. **Emerson Hancock** (SEA) had 6.0 no-hit innings vs. CLE the next day.

McGREEVY vs. ARIZONA:

- Completed the cycle against National League West teams, pitching against Arizona at Chase Field last Friday (7/17) getting the opening call following the All-Star Break.
- Received a no decision after pitching 6.1 innings, matching his season high and allowing two runs (one earned), while departing with a 3-2 lead.
- Is 2-0 with an 0.49 ERA in three starts vs. N.L. West opponents this season, pitching two scoreless starts vs. LAD (5/2) and at SD (5/8).
- His 0.49 ERA vs. N.L. West opponents is the lowest of any pitcher in MLB this season with 3 or more starts.**

LAST APPEARANCE vs. DIAMONDBACKS: 7/17/26 at ARI: ND, W, 5-4 - 6.1 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 1 ER, HR, 1 BB, 5 SO - 94 pitches.
