PITTSBURGH PIRATES (76-85) vs. NEW YORK YANKEES (93-68)
SEPTEMBER 29, 2024 AT YANKEE STADIUM, BRONX, NY - 3:05 EDT - GAME #162/ROAD #81
LHP BAILEY FALTER (8-9, 4.26 ERA) vs. RHP CLARKE SCHMIDT (5-5, 2.55 ERA)

THE PIRATES: beat the Yankees 9-4 on Saturday to earn a series win...Have hit at least one home run in each of their last eight road games...Have won 15 games in their last at-bat (their most since having 16 last at-bat wins in 2021)...Have won eight games when trailing after seven innings (their most since winning nine times in 2019 when trailing

after seven frames)...Have played in 51 one-run games, which are the most for the team since also playing in 51 in 2018...Have recorded 12 shutouts this year, which are tied for the sixth-most in the National League...Are tied for the fourth fewest home runs allowed (55) in MLB among relief pitchers...The only teams whose bullpens have surrendered fewer home runs are the Royals (49), Athletics (52) and Guardians (52)...Have used a total of 56 players this season after Mike Burrows made his MLB debut yesterday (tied for the 10th-most in MLB)...Had a total of seven players make their MLB debuts this season.

MAKING HIS CASE: Paul Skenes tossed 2.0 scoreless innings on Saturday to lower his ERA to 1.96 after 23 starts during his rookie season...According to StatsPerform, Skenes is the first rookie pitcher to record at least 23 starts with a sub-2.00 ERA in a single season since Scott Perry (44 games/36 starts) in 1918...Skenes also finished his rookie campaign with a .198 batting average against...That's the lowest by a Pirates starter all-time (minimum 16 starts).

UNTIL WE MEET AGAIN: The Pirates will close out a season on the road for the first time since 2020 with today's finale at Yankee Stadium...The next time the Pirates will return to game action will be on February 22 in Sarasota against the Orioles...Pittsburgh will open the 2025 campaign with a six-game road trip that takes the team to Miami and Tampa Bay from March 27 to April 2...The Pirates will then host the Yankees on April 4 for the beginning of a six-game homestand that also brings the Cardinals to town.

BRONX BOMBERS: The Pirates went deep five times in yesterday's win against the Yankees... It was the fourth time this season Pittsburgh hit at least five home runs in a game and first since July 9 at Milwaukee...The Pirates have now gone deep eight times in the first two games of this series...It's the most home runs by the Pirates in a three-game series since going deep nine times against the Astros from June 25-27, 2019.

CHECKING THE BROOM CLOSET: The Pirates will look for their fourth sweep of the season this afternoon...Pittsburgh swept the Marlins in a four-game series on the road from March 28-31 and in three games at home from September 9-11...The Bucs also swept a three-game series against the White Sox in Chicago from July 12-14...The last time the Pirates swept the final series of the regular season came in 2013 at Cincinnati.

A MODEL OF CONSISTENCY: Bryan Reynolds ranks fifth among all National League players with a career-high 171 hits...That's the most hits by a Pirate in a season since Andrew McCutchen had

172 in 2014...This is now the fourth straight year Reynolds will lead the team in hits...The last Pirate to do that was Al Oliver from 1972-75 (Oliver shared the team lead in hits in 1975 with Rennie Stennett)...Reynolds is the first Pirate since Brian Giles to hit at least 24 home runs in four straight seasons (1999-2002)...He has also led the Pirates in RBI in each of the last four seasons...The last Pirate to that was Dave Parker from 1978-81.

with punchouts this year is Houston's Josh Hader (105).

SAVING THE DAY: Aroldis Chapman comes into today tied with Detroit's Jason Foley for the Major League lead in saves this month with nine... That's his most in a month since he also had nine in August of 2019 (the last time he had more saves in a month was May of 2019 with eleven)...Chapman also enters the final day of the season with most strikeouts (98) among all lefthanded relievers in the National League...The only left-handed reliever in MLB

KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH'S MILESTONES: Andrew McCutchen comes into today one run shy of tying Arky Vaughan (936) for 10th all time in Pirates history...McCutchen is also two extra base hits shy of 800 in his career.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

September 29, 2013: The Pirates completed a three-game sweep of the Reds to close out the regular season with a 4-2 win over Great American Ball Park. Jordy Mercer had three hits and fell a double shy of hitting for the cycle while hitting an inside-the-park home run in the second inning. Brandon Cumpton made the fifth start of his big league career and responded with 5.0 scoreless innings while picking up his second win in the final tuneup before the two teams would meet again two days later in the Wild Card Game at PNC Park.

HOW ACQUIRED: From the Phillies in exchange for INF Rodolfo Castro on 8/1/23

STARTING OFF: The 27-year-old lefthander is in his second season with the Pirates after being acquired from the Phillies at the trade deadline last season (August 1) in exchange for infielder Rodolfo Castro...Falter is in his fourth Major League season...He made 50 appearances (24 starts) for the Phillies from 2021-23...He has also made 37 appearances (34 starts) with the Pirates from 2023-24 after being selected in the fifth round of the 2015 draft by Philadelphia.

AGAINST NEW YORK (AL): Falter will be making his first career appearance/start against the Yankees this afternoon...He is 2-1 with a 3.38 ERA (32.0ip/12er) in six starts this season against the American League.

HITTING HIS SPOTS: Falter comes into today with the longest active streak in MLB without hitting a batter (1082 plate appearances from August 20, 2022 to September 17, 2024)...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the last pitcher with as long of a streak without hitting a batter was Yusmeiro Petit (1205 plate appearances) from April 21, 2017 to June 6, 2021.

THIS MONTH: Falter is 2-2 with a 3.52 ERA (23.0ip/9er) in four starts this month...He won each of his first two starts of this month against the Nationals on September 5 and on September 11 against the Marlins...He lost for the first time this month and for the first time since the All-Star break in his start on September 17 at St. Louis...He also allowed four runs in 5.0 innings and lost a 7-2 decision against the Brewers on Tuesday.

STAYING IN THE PARK: Falter surrendered 11 home runs in 68.1 innings (1.45 per 9.0 innings) in his first 12 starts of this season through June 6...Since then he has allowed flve home runs in 71.0 innings in his last 15 starts, averaging 0.63 per 9.0 innings.

AND THE WHIFF: Falter had a career-high tying eight strikeouts in his start on August 17 against the Mariners at PNC Park...It was his fourth career eight-strikeout game and second of the season after also punching out eight batters on April 23 against the Brewers at PNC Park.

FIRING BLANKS: Falter posted a scoreless streak of 19.2 innings earlier this season from May 12-24...It's the longest scoreless streak of this season by a Pirate.

JUST LIKE SANDY: Growing up in Chino Hills, California, Falter's father, Darwin, taught him to idolize fellow left-handed pitcher Sandy Koufax...Bailey would do reports on Koufax at school and even had a framed picture of the Dodgers southpaw hanging above his childhood bed...To this day, his delivery on the mound mimics that of Koufax.
