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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore continues its final homestand of the year with one more game against Milwaukee (0-2) tonight before hosting Toronto for three games beginning Monday... Following an off day on Thursday, the Orioles wrap up the regular season with three games at Yankee Stadium...The O's are 4.0 games behind the White Sox for the final Wild Card spot with the Astros (2.0 GB) and Blue Jays (3.0 GB) also in the mix...The Birds hold the tiebreaker against Houston and Chicago, but not against Cleveland and Texas with both of those division races within 1.0 game...Baltimore would need to sweep Toronto to secure that tiebreaker.

⚾ The Orioles were shut out on Saturday for the seventh time this season and for the third time this month, joining September 4 and 5 vs. Boston...The club has been blanked five times since the start of August, tied for the third most in the majors during that period behind the Reds (7) and Guardians (6).

⚾ Baltimore fell yesterday for the third time this year when allowing three hits or fewer, along with August 7 at Texas (3 H) and April 18 at Cleveland (3 H)...Entering this year, the team had lost three such games combined from 2015-25.

⚾ **Trevor Rogers** suffered the loss despite allowing one run in 8.0 innings on Saturday... He has two losses of 8.0+ innings and one run allowed since the start of last year, along with August 1, 2025 at Chicago-NL (8.0 IP, 1 R)...From 2011-24, the only other such instance by an Oriole during the regular season was Dean Kremer (8.0 IP, 1 R) on August 12, 2025 vs. Seattle...Corbin Burnes (8.0+ IP, 1 R) did so in Game 1 of the 2024 AL Wild Card Series on October 1 vs. Kansas City.

⚾ Rogers became only the third Oriole since 2000 to suffer the loss despite pitching 8.0+ innings while striking out 10+, joining Scott Erickson (8.0 IP, 10 K) on June 27, 2002 vs. New York-AL and Pat Hentgen (9.0 IP, 10 K) on April 13, 2001 vs. Tampa Bay.

⚾ The O's went 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position yesterday and are now batting .145 (9-for-62) with one double and three home runs in those situations in seven games since September 12...The club has not produced more than two hits with a runner in scoring position since September 11 at Toronto (4-for-9).

POLAR PLUNGE: **Pete Alonso** leads the AL and is tied for third in MLB with 105 RBI this season while also ranking among AL leaders in total bases (3rd, 292), home runs (4th, 38), OPS (5th, .864), slugging percentage (5th, .503), extra-base hits (6th, 62), hits (T-7th, 154), and runs (8th, 92)...Since the All-Star break, his 17 home runs lead the AL ahead of SEA's Randy Arozarena (15 HR).

⚾ He leads the AL in RBI ahead of HOU's Yordan Alvarez (99 RBI)...Alonso led the NL with 131 RBI in 2022 with the Mets and looks to become the first player to lead the AL and the NL in RBI in a season, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...Seven Orioles have led the AL in RBI: Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).

⚾ According to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).

⚾ Alonso hit his 300th career home run on Tuesday at New York-NL, a game-tying solo homer in the ninth inning...According to *STATS Perform*, Alonso became the 10th fastest player to reach 300 career home runs at 1,160 games, trailing Aaron Judge (955 G), Ralph Kiner (1,087 G), Ryan Howard (1,093 G), Juan Gonzalez (1,096), Shohei Ohtani/Alex Rodriguez (both 1,117 G), Giancarlo Stanton (1,119 G), Harmon Killebrew (1,137 G), and Mark McGwire (1,148 G)...He's hit 302 career home runs, the third most in a player's first eight seasons in MLB history behind Ralph Kiner (329) and Albert Pujols (319).

⚾ Alonso's 38 home runs this year are the fourth most by an Oriole in their first season with the club behind Frank Robinson (49, 1966), Mark Trumbo (47, 2016), and Nelson Cruz (40, 2014)...He's the sixth Oriole with 100+ RBI in his first year with the team, along with Miguel Tejada (150, 2004), Frank Robinson (122, 1966), Albert Belle (117, 1999), Nelson Cruz (108, 2014), and Mark Trumbo (108, 2016).

⚾ He has started all 155 O's games this year, tied for the most starts in MLB along with ATL's Matt Olson and PHI's Bryce Harper...The last Oriole to start every team game in a season was Jonathan Schoop in 2016.

⚾ Alonso has played in 571 consecutive games, the second-longest active streak in the majors behind ATL's Matt Olson (937 G).

COBY BEEF: **Coby Mayo** has reached base safely in a career-best 22 straight games since August 25, slashing .291/.371/.608 (23-for-79) with four doubles, seven home runs, 16 runs, 16 RBI, and nine walks.

⚾ His on-base streak is the longest by an Oriole since **Gunnar Henderson's** 36-game stretch from May 22-June 29, 2024.

⚾ Mayo's .575 slugging percentage since the All-Star break is the highest in the AL (min. 150 AB).

⚾ Since August 31, he is 11-for-37 (.297) with three doubles and four home runs against right-handed pitching after going 0-for-29 off righties from August 11-30.

⚾ Mayo is batting .317/.386/.718 (45-for-142) with nine doubles, 16 home runs, and 33 RBI this year against left-handed pitching...He leads the majors in home runs, slugging percentage, and OPS (1.104) against lefties...The 16 homers are the second most in a season off lefties by an Oriole behind Gary Roenicke's 18 in 1983.

'PEN PALS: **Josh Walker** hasn't allowed a run in 20 games (17.2 IP) since August 6, the longest streak by an Oriole since Zack Britton had a franchise-record-tying 25-game stretch from June 22-August 22, 2016.

⚾ The O's bullpen had thrown 16.2 consecutive scoreless innings until the ninth inning on Friday.

⚾ Eleven Baltimore pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, breaking the franchise record since saves became an official statistic in 1969...The Birds are one of seven teams in MLB to have at least 11 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Cubs (14).

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: The O's lead the AL and rank fourth in the majors with 566 walks this season behind the Cubs (650 BB), Brewers (642 BB), and Dodgers (607 BB)...The White Sox are second in the AL with 563 free passes.

⚾ According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, the Birds look to lead the AL in walks for the seventh time in franchise history (since 1954) and for the first time since 1990 (660 BB).

⚾ Baltimore has had 10 different players this season record at least 30 walks, tied for most in MLB with Milwaukee and Minnesota...It is tied for the most by the Orioles in a single season in franchise history (since 1954), along with 1999, 1982, 1973, and 1970.

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 50-53 in games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for the most such games in the majors with the Royals (44-59) and Guardians (55-48)...Their .485 winning percentage in those games ranks 18th in the majors.

⚾ Baltimore is 17-24 in one-run games this year...The team's .415 winning percentage in those situations is tied for 26th in the majors with the Rockies behind the Angels (.396, 19-29), Giants (.372, 16-27), and Tigers (.357, 15-27).

QUICK HITS: Young is set to make his 27th start of the season and the 39th of his career...Was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk for the second time this year on April 23...Was optioned to minor league camp on March 7 after making two Grapefruit League appearances...Signed with the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on June 14, 2020.

LAST TIME OUT: Didn't factor into the decision of a 2-1 Orioles win on September 14 at New York-NL after throwing 5.0 innings of one-run ball on five hits (1 HR) and five walks with six strikeouts...Threw 106 pitches, 59 strikes.
⚡ The 106 pitches marked a career high ahead of May 24 (G1), 2026 vs. Detroit (105 pitches) while his five walks tied a career high (also 4/26/25 at DET).

NEW TEAM, WHO DIS?: Young is scheduled to make his first career start against Milwaukee...He is 3-0 with a 3.89 ERA (18 ER/41.2 IP) over eight Interleague starts this season, during which the O's are 7-1 (.875).

SWEET VICTORY: The Orioles are 19-7 (.731) in Young's 26 starts this season after going 3-9 (.250) in 2025...According to *STATS Perform*, his 19 team wins are tied for the seventh most by an Orioles pitcher through the first 26 starts of a season in team history (since 1954) trailing leader Dave McNally (22 team wins in 1969).
⚡ Young is 9-4 (.692) in 26 starts this season...The .692 winning percentage is fifth highest in the AL (min. 15 GS) trailing leader TB's Nick Martinez (.789, 15-4).
⚡ According to *STATS Perform*, after going 1-7 (.125) in 2025, his +.567 increase in winning percentage would be the third largest in MLB history from a pitcher's first major league season to his second (min. 10 GS each season)...The record currently belongs to George "Stump" Weidman, who went 0-9 in 1880 with the Buffalo Bisons and 8-5 in 1881 with the Detroit Wolverines (+.615).

HOMER HAPPY: Young has allowed a home run in a career-high six consecutive starts (9 total HR) since August 17, over which he holds a 2.53 HR/9.0 IP...That included a start on August 17 at Tampa Bay where he allowed a season-high three home runs.
⚡ It marks the longest such streak by an Oriole starter since Tomoyuki Sugano (also 6 GS, 8/25-9/27/25)...The last Bird to allow a homer in seven straight starts was Tyler Wells (10 GS, 7/18/23-9/24/25).
⚡ He allowed 12 home runs over his first 20 starts of the season with a 0.95 HR/9.0 IP.

THE YARD: Young is on a season-high two-decision losing streak at home over his last four starts since August 6, over which he holds a 6.20 ERA (14 ER/20.1 IP) and .304 opponent average (24-for-79).
⚡ Over his first 10 home starts of the season, he went 2-1 with a 3.19 ERA (21 ER/59.1 IP) and .247 opponent average (57-for-231).

FASTBALL FOCUS: Over his last seven starts since August 11, opponents are slashing .321/.441/.554 (18-for-56) on his four-seam fastball with six extra-base hits (2 2B, 3B, 3 HR), 11 walks, and eight strikeouts.
⚡ Over his first 19 starts of the season, Young held opponents to a .191/.293/.322 (29-for-152) slash line on the pitch with 10 extra base hits (5 2B, 5 HR), 21 walks, and 28 strikeouts.
⚡ His average fastball has climbed to 94.2 mph in 2026, up 1.7 miles per hour from 2025 (92.5 mph)...The 1.7 mph increase is tied for the sixth-highest year-over-year increase by any pitcher in MLB, including the highest by a starting pitcher.

THEM CHANGES: Young is averaging 83.6 mph and 1,409 revolutions per minute (RPM) on the pitch over his last 20 starts since May 24 (G1), during which opponents are hitting .231 (21-for-91) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, and 23 strikeouts to three walks.
⚡ Over his first six starts of the season his splitter averaged 87.7 mph and 1,501 RPM, with opponents hitting .476 (10-for-21) off it with three doubles and two strikeouts to two walks.
⚡ Holds a 42.9 strikeout rate on the pitch over his last four starts since August 28 (9 total K)...Recorded a career-high five strikeouts with it on September 3 at Boston.
