**BIRDLAND BITES:** The Orioles open a six-game, seven-day homestand tonight against the Dodgers (3 to play) and Pirates (3 to play)...Baltimore returns from a 4-2 west coast trip through San Francisco (1-2) and San Diego (3-0).

👉 The Birds earned their sixth series sweep of the year with a 7-5 win on Wednesday at Petco Park...It marked the O's fourth series sweep on the road (6/3-5 at SEA, 7/4-6 at ATL, 8/18-19 at BOS)...The only MLB club with more road sweeps this season is the Twins (5 sweeps).

👉 **Colton Cowser, Coby Mayo, and Alex Jackson** hit back-to-back-to-back homers in the third inning, marking the O's second occurrence this season (also 6/24 vs. TEX: Sánchez, Urías, O'Hearn, 7<sup>th</sup> inn.)...It marked the first time in franchise history (since 1954) that Baltimore accomplished the feat twice in one season...Prior to 2025, the O's last did so on August 6, 2017 vs. Detroit (Schoop/Davis/Mancini, 1<sup>st</sup> inn.)...The Birds had not hit back-to-back-to-back homers on the road since September 16, 1985 at Detroit (Ripken, Jr., Murray, Lynn).

👉 The O's four homers were their second most away from Camden Yards this season, trailing the six they hit on Opening Day (3/27) at Rogers Centre vs. the Blue Jays.

👉 The Birds have 8+ hits in a season-best seven straight games, their longest run since June 14-21, 2024 (also 7 G)...They last did so in eight straight from April 13-21, 2024 (8 G)...Baltimore is 43-29 when recording 8+ hits this season, compared to 21-47 when tallying seven or fewer hits.

👉 Baltimore drew a season-high-tying eight walks (3x, last: 8/10 vs. ATH) in Wednesday's victory...It marked the O's most walks on the road since June 20, 2024 at Texas (9 BB).

**ACTION JACKSON:** Since making his MLB debut on August 1, **Jeremiah Jackson** is slashing .321/.351/.519 (34-for-106) with five doubles, two triples, four home runs, 15 runs, and 17 RBI...Over his last eight games, he is 11-for-35 (.314) with three doubles, three homers, and eight RBI.

👉 Jackson has 33 hits through his first 26 career starts, becoming the fourth Oriole in team history (since 1954) to accomplish the feat along with **Bob Hale** (36 H, 1955), **Curtis Goodwin** (35 H, 1995), and **Billy Ripken** (34 H, 1987).

👉 His 52 total bases are the third most by an Oriole through their first 26 starts in franchise history (since 1954), trailing **Trey Mancini** (65 TB, 2016-17) and **Jim Traber** (59 TB, 1984-86).

👉 He has reached base safely in 14 straight games since August 21, the sixth-longest active streak in the AL...His 13-game hitting streak ended on Wednesday at San Diego, which was the second longest by an Oriole this season (Henderson: 14, 6/5-20).

**LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS:** **Dylan Beavers** has reached base safely in 13 of his first 16 career games since debuting on August 16, slashing .314/.426/.451 (16-for-51) with four doubles, one homer, 10 runs scored, six RBI, 10 walks, and one stolen base.

👉 He has reached base safely 26 times to begin his career, second most in franchise history (since 1954) through an O's first 16 games behind **Curtis Goodwin** (29 TOB, 1995)...Goodwin and **Ryan Mountcastle** (2020) share the record through 17 games with 30 times on base apiece.

**NIP AND TUCK:** Since August 10, eight of Baltimore's 12 home games have been decided by one run, with the O's going 2-6 in those contests.

👉 Following the All-Star break, Baltimore has played an MLB-high 20 one-run affairs (8-12), ahead of Seattle (16 G)...The Birds opened the year playing 22 one-run games (12-10), tied for second fewest in the majors ahead of the Tigers (21 G).

**NO RISP, NO REWARD:** Since August 16, the O's have recorded 188 at-bats with runners in scoring position, the second-highest mark in MLB behind the Mets (189 AB)...Their .218 RISP average during this stretch, however, is second lowest in the majors ahead of the Astros (.198 AVG)...In comparison, the Mets own an MLB-best .365 RISP average during this period.

👉 On the season, **Gunnar Henderson** is batting .347 (35-for-101) with runners in scoring position...The .347 RISP average would be the seventh-highest mark (min. 100 AB) by an Oriole in club history (since 1954), including the highest since **Melvin Mora** (.360 RISP AVG) in 2008.

**IT TAKES A VILLAGE:** Following Tuesday's season debut of **Tyler Wells**, Baltimore has used a franchise record 67 players this season, surpassing the previous team record held by the 2021 Orioles (62 players)...The 67 players used are tied for the MLB lead along with the Braves.

👉 **Samuel Basallo** hit his first major league home run on August 30 at San Francisco, becoming the 23<sup>rd</sup> different player to homer for the team this season, breaking the franchise record (since 1954) previously shared by the 2018 and 2012 Orioles...The current number leads the majors this season and is the most by an MLB club since the 2024 Giants (also 23).

👉 **Dylan Beavers** became the 19<sup>th</sup> Oriole to swipe a base this year on August 23 vs. Houston, tied for the MLB lead along with the Brewers, Mariners, Rangers, and Rays...The 19 players are the most to steal 1+ base in team history, surpassing the previous record of 17 shared by the 2018, 2001, 1990, 1988, and 1955 Orioles.

👉 On August 18 at Boston, **Samuel Basallo** became the seventh player to appear at catcher for Baltimore this year, setting the franchise record...The previous record of six was shared by the 1986, 1962, and 1960 O's...The last MLB club to use at least seven catchers in a single season was the 2023 Cleveland Guardians (also 7)...The last to use eight were the 2022 Pirates.

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** Right-handed pitcher **Michael Forret** and outfielder **Reed Trimble** have been named the Orioles Minor League Pitcher and Player of the Month for August.

👉 In five starts between Double-A Chesapeake (3 GS) and Class-A Aberdeen (2 GS), Forret went 1-0 with a 1.16 ERA (3 ER/23.1 IP) and 26 strikeouts while limiting opponents to a .141 (11-for-78) average...Forret, 21, is rated the O's No. 11 prospect by both *Baseball America* and *MLB Pipeline*.

👉 In 21 games between Triple-A Norfolk (12 G) and Chesapeake (9 G), Trimble slashed .329/.426/.620 (26-for-79) with six doubles, one triple, five home runs, 17 runs, 18 RBI, 12 walks, and six steals...Trimble, 25, was selected in Competitive Balance Round B of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Southern Mississippi.

**LA LA LAND:** Baltimore is set to host Los Angeles at Camden Yards for the fifth time since the clubs first met in the regular season in 2002 ('02, '13, '19, '23)...The O's have played the Dodgers 21 times, their fewest matchups against a single opponent in MLB ahead of the Cardinals and Reds (both 24 G).

👉 On October 6, 1966, **Jim Palmer** outdueled Sandy Koufax in Game 2 of the World Series at Dodger Stadium in front of 55,947 fans, tossing a complete game shutout with six strikeouts...The O's go on to sweep the Dodgers in four games and claim the first World Series title in franchise history.

Ripken, Jr. goes 3-for-5 and homers in the Orioles 8-0 win over the Angels at Camden Yards. The Orioles tie a pair of club home run records, hitting four homers in the second inning, including three in a row by Jeff Manto, Mark Smith, and Brady Anderson.

**QUICK HITS:** Set to make his 28<sup>th</sup> appearance (27 GS) of the 2025 campaign...On June 12 vs. Detroit, he became the first Orioles pitcher to throw at least 7.0 innings in relief since **Aaron Brooks** on September 20, 2019 vs. Seattle and the first Orioles pitcher to throw 105+ pitches out of the bullpen since **Jason Johnson** on August 29, 2000 vs. Detroit (111 P)...Tossed 20.0 scoreless innings at home from June 12-July 25, the longest streak by an Oriole since **Grayson Rodriguez** (also 20.0 IP) from August 22-September 27, 2023...Recorded his 500<sup>th</sup> strikeout on June 17 at Tampa Bay...Recently announced his intention to play for Team Israel in the 2026 World Baseball Classic, marking his third appearance on Israel's roster in the WBC (also 2023 & 2017).

- LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered his 10<sup>th</sup> loss of the season on August 29 at San Francisco after allowing a season-high-tying seven runs (also 8/23 vs. HOU) on nine hits and two walks with one strikeout in a season-low 3.0 innings...Marked his shortest start since June 30, 2023 vs. Minnesota (L, 3.0 IP, 7 H, 7 R, 2 BB, 5 K, 2 HR)...The seven earned runs allowed tied a career high (3x, last: 6/20/23 vs. MIN)...The O's have lost seven of Kramer's last eight starts since July 19 at Tampa Bay...Threw 76 pitches, 48 strikes.
- Has allowed seven or more runs in consecutive starts for the first time in his career...The only Orioles to do so in three straight starts were **Dylan Bundy** (8/10-21/18 and 4/26-5/8/18), **Hayden Penn** (9/3-15/06), and **Scott Erickson** (6/18-29/00).
  - The 14 runs allowed by Kramer are the most in a two-game stretch in his career and the most by an Oriole since **Corbin Burnes** allowed 14 runs from August 16-22, 2024.
  - Has walked at least one batter in a career-high 21 straight starts...The last Oriole to do so in 22 or more consecutive starts was **Andrew Cashner** from 6/25/18-5/20/19 (24 GS).

**BATTLING THE BOYS IN BLUE:** Did not factor in the decision in his only previous start against the Dodgers on July 19, 2023 after allowing five runs on four hits (2 HR) and four walks with one strikeout in 4.2 innings.

- Owens a 1-6 record with a 7.01 ERA (40 ER/51.1 IP) in 10 career starts against NL West foes...Owns the highest ERA against the division among active pitchers (min. 10 GS)...Has allowed at least four earned runs in each of his last five starts against the division after allowing three or fewer earned runs in four of his first five career starts against the division.

**HOME COOKIN':** Kramer owns a 5-3 record with a 3.26 ERA (25 ER/69.0 IP) in 11 home games (10 GS) compared to a 4-7 record with a 5.53 ERA (53 ER/86.1 IP) in a MLB-lead-tying 16 road starts.

- Kramer has allowed 15 runs over his past four home starts (24.0 IP) after allowing six earned runs in his first six home starts (38.0 IP).

**SEVENTH HEAVEN:** Kramer has thrown at least 7.0 innings and allowed three or fewer hits in six starts this season, tied with SD's Nick Pivetta for second most in MLB trailing DET's Tarik Skubal (7 GS).

- The six starts of at least 7.0 IP and three or fewer hits are tied for second most in a season in franchise history (since 1954), trailing **Wally Bunker** (7 GS, 1964).

**SPLIT DECISION:** Over his past nine starts, Kramer has limited opponents to a .155 (9-for-58) clip with 23 strikeouts and a 48.7 percent whiff rate on his splitter...Has produced 56 whiffs on the pitch in that span, second most in MLB trailing TOR's Kevin Gausman (67)...His whiff rate on his splitter during that span leads the league (min. 50 AB ending in pitch), and his batting average against ranks second, trailing ATL's Hurston Waldrep (.074 avg., 4-for-54).

- However, over his past three starts, opponents are batting .333 (6-for-18) with two extra-base hits (2B, HR) on the pitch...The home run he allowed to HOU's Victor Caratini on August 23 was the first off his splitter since AZ's Corbin Carroll and Josh Naylor both took his splitter deep on April 9.
- Overall, Kramer's 39.4 percent whiff rate against his splitter leads the AL and ranks third in MLB (min. 100 PA ending in pitch), trailing NYM's Kodai Senga (41.8%) and LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto (41.2%)...His 25.3 percent hard-hit rate on the pitch ranks second in MLB trailing DET's Rafael Montero (25.0%).

**STARTING OFF SLOW:** Has allowed a .277/.322/.449 (142-for-512) slashline in innings one through five compared to a .180/.223/.326 (16-for-89) in innings six through eight.

- Kramer's .315 batting average against in the first inning is the sixth highest in the AL (min. 100 BF), trailing LAA's Jack Kochanowicz (.382), DET's Chris Paddack (.339), BOS/PHI's Walker Buelher (.330), LAA's Yusei Kikuchi (.325), and SEA's Bryan Woo (.316).
