AROUND THE HORN

LARGEST 50/50 RAFFLE ALL-TIME: Last night’s D-backs Give Back 50/50 Raffle jackpot of \$712,332 was the largest all-time, surpassing \$560,331 on Father’s Day 2025.

D-BACKS RACE AGAINST CANCER: On Sunday, Sept. 27, the D-backs Foundation will host their 13th annual Race Against Cancer, presented by Dignity Health Cancer Institute, a charitable 5K race that begins and ends at Chase Field, bringing together community members in support of Arizona nonprofit organizations dedicated to cancer screening, treatment, and support for individuals and families affected by all types of cancer.

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs are seeking their second straight series win vs. Yankees (also: 2-1 from April 1-3, 2025 on the road) and third home series win all-time (prev: 2-1 from May 16-18, 2016 and 2-0 from April 30-May 1, 2019).

- Corbin Burnes** is making his third start this season since being reinstated from the Injured List (right ulnar collateral ligament surgery).
 - The team is 2-0 in his 2 starts...in 4 career starts vs. Yankees, is 0-2 with a 1.93 ERA (5 ER in 23.1 IP), 7 walks and 30 strikeouts.
- Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely 2-or-more times in 3 straight games and reached base in 14 straight games, batting .367 (18-for-49)/1.170 OPS with 2 doubles, 5 homers, 9 RBI and 7 walks.
- Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 12 straight games, hitting .308 (12-for-39) with 1 double, 2 RBI and 8 walks.
- Gabriel Moreno** has hit safely in 12 of his last 14 games, hitting .352 (19-for-54)/1.065 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 homers, 8 RBI and 7 walks.
- Corbin Carroll** is carrying an .831 OPS with 3 homers and 9 RBI in his last 9 games.

LAST GAME: On the night of the 25th anniversary celebration of the 2001 World Series Championship, the D-backs walked-off 5-3 vs. Yankees courtesy of **Pavin Smith’s** ninth-inning, pinch-hit homer.

- Was **Pavin Smith’s** second career walk-off homer and third career walk-off plate appearance.
- Jordan Lawlar** made it a 2-1 lead with his first career triple in the fifth inning.
- Corbin Carroll** tied the game at 3-3 with a sac fly in the sixth inning.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are fourth in the NL Wild Card race, 5.0 games behind the Cubs (WC T-1, trail 2-4) and Padres (WC T-1, season tied 5-5, 3-game series from Sept. 25-27), and 4.0 games behind the Phillies (WC3, tied 3-3).

MINOR LEAGUE SPOTLIGHT - DOUBLE-A AMARILLO ADVANCES: Later this afternoon, Double-A Amarillo will face Springfield (Cardinals) in game 1 of the Texas League best-of-3 Championship series.

WALKIN’ IT OFF: The D-backs’ franchise-record 6 walk-off homers are most in the Majors, ahead of the White Sox (5) and Padres (4).

- The D-backs’ franchise-high-tying 2 pinch-hit walk-off homers (also: 2024) are most in the Majors.
- The D-backs’ 10 walk-off wins are tied for second most in franchise history, behind 2013 (13)...are fifth most in the Majors, behind the Cubs (12), White Sox (11), Mariners (11) and Padres (11).

ANSWERBACKS: The D-backs’ 46 comeback wins lead the Majors, ahead of the Padres (44).

- Their 24 comeback home wins are tied for third in the NL with the Cubs, behind the Padres (29) and Dodgers (27).

HOME WIN MARK BEST SINCE 2017: The D-backs’ .550 (44-36) home win pct. is their highest since 2017 (.642, 52-29).

- The D-backs’ .654 (17-9) day-game win pct. this season ranks seventh in the Majors, behind the Rays (.719, 23-9), Marlins (.714, 25-10), Brewers (.700, 21-9), Mariners (.667, 20-10), Pirates (.667, 22-11) and Padres (.667, 16-8).

ARENADO’S STREAK VS. YANKEES: **Nolan Arenado’s** 17-game hit streak vs. Yankees is the longest among active players and tied for the longest hit streak overall by a MLB third baseman vs. Yankees since Paul Molitor’s 21-gamer from 1983-86.

ARENADO NEARING NINTH 25/75 SEASON: **Nolan Arenado** (25 HR/74 RBI) is 1 RBI shy of becoming the fifth third baseman since 1969 [min. 100 GS per year] with 9+ seasons of 25+ homers and 75+ RBI, to join Mike Schmidt/PHI (12 from 1974-87), Aramis Ramirez/PIT-CHC-MIL (10 from 2001-12), Manny Machado/BAL-LAD-SD (10 from 2015-2026) and Adrián Beltré/LAD-SEA-BOS-TEX (9 from 2004-16).

GABI THE EXTRAORDINARY: **Gabriel Moreno**, with his .304 AVG (sixth in MLB), is looking to become the first qualified primary catcher to hit .300+ since Buster Posey/SF in 2017 (.320).

- His .304 AVG, .383 OBP and .863 OPS lead MLB catchers [min. 90 G].

STRONG SEPTEMBER ‘PEN: The D-backs bullpen’s 2.54 ERA (25 R-21 ER in 74.1 IP) in September ranks second in the Majors, behind the Guardians (2.23), ahead of the Red Sox (2.65).

SHUTTING IT DOWN: **Justin Martinez** has not allowed an earned run in his 11 games this season (2 R-0 ER in 10.1 IP) since returning from the 60-day Injured List on Aug. 18...is 2-0 with an opponent .147 AVG (5-for-34)/.492 OPS, 6 walks and 13 strikeouts.

- Brandyn Garcia** is scoreless in 27 of his 28 home games, going 0-0 with a 0.34 ERA (1 ER in 26.2 IP), opponent .140 AVG (12-for-86)/.382 OPS, 0.64 WHIP, 5 walks and 22 strikeouts.
- Juan Morillo** is scoreless in 14 straight home games (13.2 IP), going 3-0 with 2 saves, an opponent .130 AVG (6-for-46)/.411 OPS, 7 walks and 12 strikeouts.

VS. YANKEES: The D-backs have won or split 4 of their last 6 series (3 wins, 1 split) vs. Yankees.
