**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY**  
**JUNE 2**  
**1966** - Tied 3-3 thru 11 innings, the Astros break out with an eight-run 12th en route to an 11-4 win over the Reds in Cincinnati...in the 12th, the Astros set a franchise record with eight consecutive hits in the inning (all singles)...also in the game, **Joe Morgan** walks in five straight plate appearances, which ties the franchise record for a single game.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Astros, who are 7-3 in their last 10 games, will continue their nine-game homestand tonight as they open a three-game series against their former divisional opponent, the Pirates...**RHP Mike Burrows**, who was acquired from the Pirates this offseason, will open the series against his former club tonight opposite Pirates hard-throwing starter **RHP Bubba Chandler**.

**ABOUT BURROWS:** For the first time in his career, **RHP Mike Burrows** is facing his former team, the Pirates, an organization he was drafted by in 2018 and spent his first eight years with as a professional...Burrows was acquired from the Pirates this off-season as part of a three-team, six-player trade in which the Astros sent **OF Jacob Melton** and minor league **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays, while the Rays sent **IF Brandon Lowe**, **OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates.

**VS. THE PIRATES:** The Astros are hosting the Pirates in Houston for their first series in the Bayou City since July of 2024...since the Astros moved to the AL in 2013, the Astros and Pirates have split their 18 matchups evenly with nine wins apiece...historically, these teams have played each other 718 times, with the Astros going 348-370.

**WELCOME BACK MURPHY!:** The Astros would like to welcome back Pirates pitching coach **Bill Murphy**, who previously worked for the Astros for the last 10 seasons (2016-25)...during his time with the Astros, Murphy had a variety of roles within the organization, serving as a minor league coach and minor league pitching coordinator before joining the Major League staff as the assistant pitching coach in 2021...Murphy was elevated to the pitching coach role in 2022, helping the club to a World Series championship that season.

**LOU GEHRIG DAY:** The Astros, in coordination with MLB, will honor and raise awareness for ALS today for the sixth annual **Lou Gehrig Day**...on the field, all players, managers, coaches and umpires will wear a special "4" decal on their uniforms...off the field, the Astros will have informational tabling on the concourse for select ALS associations, and will have pregame ceremonies and a first pitch in honor of Lou Gehrig Day.

**ON THE DIAL:** The Astros English radio broadcast this series will feature **Robert Ford** and **Josh Reddick**, who's subbing for **Steve Sparks**...Reddick, who played parts of 13 seasons in the Majors and was a 2017 World Series champion, will make select appearances on Astros radio this season.

**LOS ASTROS:** Space City Home Network will televise this series in English and Spanish with the Spanish broadcast being televised on SCHN2...**Danny Gonzalez** and **Enrique Vasquez** will be on the call on the Spanish telecast this series.

**THE SUNDAY SCARIES:** The Astros were shut out on Sunday by the Brewers in a 2-0 loss in Houston...**RHP Tatsuya Imai** (2ER/6IP) had a strong start for the Astros, but was outdueled by Brewers ace **RHP Jacob Misiorowski** (0ER/7IP)...the Astros offense recorded three hits, including a double by **3B Isaac Paredes**, which was his 500th career hit.

**ASTROS ROSTER MOVES:** The Astros have made the following roster moves:

- **LHP Josh Hader** was reinstated from the 60-day IL.
- **IF Carlos Correa** was transferred to the 60-day IL.
- **OF Zach Cole** was recalled from Triple A.
- **IF Braden Shewmake** was placed on the 10-day IL with a right adductor strain (retro to 5/31).
- Announced yesterday, **RHP Logan VanWey** was optioned to Triple A.

**FOR STARTERS:** Astros starters have a combined ERA of 3.33 (34ER/92IP) over the last 16 games (since May 15) with a 1.05 WHIP...in that span, they have allowed just 55 hits in 92.0 innings for a Major League-best .173 opponent average, while also ranking third in the AL in WHIP and third in ERA.

**MAY-KING HIS CASE:** **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** has made a strong case for the AL Pitcher of the Month award for May, going 4-1 with a 0.93 ERA (3ER/29IP) and a .165 opponent average (16x97) in five starts in the month...in May, he posted the lowest ERA and opponent average among AL starters, while ranking tied for first in wins.

**THERE IS A SANTA!:** **RHP Alimber Santa** (pronounced saun-tuh) has retired 15 consecutive batters through three appearances to open his MLB career...per Elias, this is a franchise record and Santa is the first pitcher to do so since **RHP Bryce Miller** of the Mariners retired his first 16 batters faced in his MLB debut on May 2, 2023 at OAK.

**ON THE LEADER BOARD:** **DH Yordan Alvarez** leads the Majors in total bases (137) and owns a share for the AL lead in homers (20)...also in the AL, he ranks second in extra-base hits (32), second in OPS (1.050), second in SLG (.634), second in OBP (.416), fifth in batting avg. (.301), tied for fifth in hits (65), sixth in RBI (39), and tied for sixth in walks (39).

**HIT PAREDES:** **3B Isaac Paredes** recorded his 500th career hit on Sunday vs. MIL, becoming just the 10th Mexican-born player in MLB history to reach the milestone...three of those 10 players have played portions of their careers with the Astros in Paredes (500 hits), **3B Vinny Castilla** (1,884 hits) and **C Alex Treviño** (604 hits).

**MAKING THE PLAYS:** The Astros have committed the fewest errors in the AL (21) and also lead the AL in fielding percentage (.990)...their 21 errors committed tie as the second-fewest in the Majors with the Dodgers and trail only the Padres (18).

**MINOR LEAGUE HONORS:** The Astros had a pair of minor leaguers win their league's weekly awards for the week of May 25-31...**LHP Colton Gordon** won the Triple A Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Week after tossing 6.0 shutout innings in a start on Wednesday vs. OKC...**OF Kevin Alvarez**, the Astros top prospect, was named the Class A Carolina League Player of the Week going 12x21 (.571) with six doubles, seven runs scored, three RBI and two walks in six games for the Woodpeckers.

**ON THE MEND:** **OF Joey Loperfido** has played in five games on his current minor league rehab assignment, last playing on Sunday at Triple A and going 2x4 in a start in left field...Loperfido has been sidelined since April 18 with a right quad strain.

**LAST START 5/27 at TEX:** Allowed 2 runs on 5 hits with a walk and 6 strikeouts in 7.0 IP...threw 91 pitches (64 strikes)...surrendered his last run of the outing in the 2nd inning, a home run to **TEX Joc Pederson**...after Pederson's home run, he retired 20 of the final 23 batters he faced...marked his 2nd outing of the season with 7.0 innings pitched...has tossed at least 6.0 innings in 4 of his last 5 starts...logged his 3rd quality start of the season (last, May 8 at CIN).

**ABOUT BURROWS:** The 2nd-year starter is making his 12th start of the season after opening the year as the Astros No. 2 starter...leads the Astros in innings pitched (63.1), in starts (11) and in strikeouts with 54...is the only member of the Astros Opening Day rotation to avoid the Injured List; **RHP Hunter Brown** (right shoulder strain), **RHP Cristian Javier** (Grade 2 right shoulder strain), **RHP Tatsuya Imai** (right arm fatigue) and **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (right shoulder inflammation).

**THE JOURNEY:** A native of Waterford, CT, Burrows was committed to the University of Connecticut out of high school...the Pirates selected him in the 11th round of the June 2018 draft and signed him to an over-slot bonus to sign and forego his commitment to UConn...spent 6 seasons (2018-23) in the Pirates minor league system before finally debuting in 2024 with a single appearance...pitched the majority of the 2025 season at the Major League level and flashed potential before the Pirates flipped him to Houston this offseason.

**VS. THE PIRATES:** Is set to make his 1st career start against his former club...made his Major League debut on Sept. 28, 2024 at NYY in a relief appearance and threw 3.1 innings, allowing 2 runs (1 earned) on 2 hits and 3 walks with 2 strikeouts, earning his 1st Major League win...appeared in 24 games (19 starts) from 2024-2025 with the Pirates, owning a 3-4 record with a 3.90 ERA (43ER/99.1IP)...had 99 strikeouts throughout that span in the Majors...his 97 strikeouts in 2025 finished T-3rd in the NL for strikeouts by a rookie.

**THE TRADE:** After spending eight seasons (2018-25) in the Pirates organization, the Astros acquired Burrows this offseason in a 3-team, 6-player trade...as part of the deal, the Astros traded **OF Jacob Melton** and minor leaguer **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays...meanwhile, the Rays traded **IF Brandon Lowe**, **OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates, and Burrows got dealt to the Astros.

**CONNECTICUT CONNECTION:** Native of Connecticut, Burrows is in a small fraternity of Major Leaguers from the Constitution State...only four other Connecticuter's have played for the Astros in their franchise history: **C Brad Ausmus** (1259g), **OF George Springer** (795g), **RHP Bill Dawley** (157g) and **RHP Josh Zeid** (48g).

**2025 RECAP:** Pitched most of the season with the Pirates, making 23 appearances (19 starts) and going 2-4 with a 3.94 ERA (42ER/96IP)...struck out 97 hitters in 96.0 IP...had two Major League stints on the year, from April 24-25 and from May 21 thru the end of the year...recorded a strong second half with the Pirates, posting a 3.27 ERA (20ER/55IP) in 13 games (10 starts)...in that span, allowed 1-or-fewer runs in 7 of his last 8 appearances, posting a 2.22 ERA (7ER/28.1IP) in those games, which spanned from Aug. 16 thru the end of the year...did not allow a homer over a 26.1-inning span from Aug. 16-Sept. 21...finished tied for third in the NL in strikeouts by a rookie (97).

LAST APPEARANCE (5/29 vs. MIL): Allowed 1 run on 2 walks in 0.1 of an inning on Fri. night vs. MIL.

TIDES TURNING: In his last 10 appearances (since May 3), he's recorded a 1.00 ERA (1ER/9IP) with 7 strikeouts, a .143 opponent batting average and a 1.22 WHIP...prior to May 3, he posted a 12.54 ERA (13ER/9.1IP) in his first 11 games of the season.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing RHP Octavio Dotel for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...ranks 7th all-time in appearances (338) among relievers in Astros history, and is closing in on RHP Ryan Pressly (342) for 6th on that all-time list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (471).

DAIKIN PARK RANKINGS: His 244 career strikeouts at Daikin Park are 3 away from matching RHP Octavio Dotel (247) for the 2nd-most by a reliever in the venue's history...reached 179.2 career innings pitched at Daikin Park with his outing on May 16 vs. TEX, surpassing RHP Ryan Pressly (179.1) for 4th-most by a reliever in the venue's history.

VS. PIT: In 5 career appearances against the Pirates, he's recorded a 0.00 ERA (0ER/5.1IP) with 8 strikeouts, a 0.94 WHIP and a .167 opponent batting average.

CAREER: In 338 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.87 ERA (111ER/348IP) with 471 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.18 K/9 and a 0.75 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
