RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a two-city, six-game road trip to Houston (3-0) and Miami with the first of a three-game series with the Marlins at loanDepot Park. The Cardinals enter off a three-game sweep of Houston with a 7-5 win in 10 innings yesterday giving them their first three-game sweep at Daikin Park since April 2004. St. Louis is winners of five straight, tied with the Braves and Cubs for longest win streak in Major League Baseball.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals arrived at their team hotel at 2:00 AM Eastern Time last night following their sweep at Houston. The Cardinals enter in 2nd place in the National League Central, one half game back of first place Cincinnati. Every team in the N.L. Central is 12-9 or better and within 1.5 games of each other.

FOUR IS MORE: The Cardinals have won the first three games of this current road trip, the first time since June 27-29, 2025 at Cleveland, with the last time winning the first four at Washington (5/9-11/25) and at Philadelphia (5/12/25).

WE'RE GOING TO PLAY: This road trip is comprised of two opponents who have retractable roofs where weather cannot complicate the game being played. In Cardinals franchise history, they have a 460-470 record when playing in retractable roof or domed stadiums. The last time the Cardinals posted a winning record on a road trip of two cities or more with guaranteed playing conditions was May 4-9, 2012; playing at Houston (1-2) and then then at Arizona (3-0). A win in any of the next three games will match that mark. In 2015, St. Louis was 14-2 in stadiums with domes/roofs.

POD SQUAD: The Cardinals are playing the all of their four Gold Coast pod teams from Spring Training by April 22. March 30-April 1, they played the New York Mets (Port St. Lucie), then at the Washington Nationals (West Palm Beach) Apr. 6-8, Houston Astros (West Palm Beach) the last three games and Miami (Jupiter) to complete this road trip. St. Louis plays 24-of-28 Grapefruit League games against these four opponents.

HIT FIRST, HIT HARD: When the Cardinals score first, they are a perfect 8-0, the only unblemished mark in the league (three teams with one loss). The Cardinals are also 5-0 in extra innings, the best mark in MLB.

COMEBACK CARDS: With yesterday's come-from-behind win, the Cardinals have nine comeback wins, 2nd in MLB behind only Arizona (10).

A HARD FOUR: Cardinals outfielder **Victor Scott II** recorded his 4th RBI of the season with a bases loaded walk yesterday. His first four RBI this season have come without being knocked via hit (3 sacrifices and a bases loaded walk). He is the only position player to accomplish this feat in the Expansion Era (1961) and joins Rockies pitcher **Denny Stark** in 2003 (BB, SF, GO, BB) as the only two overall. *Elias Sports Bureau*

THE BIG STICK: Outfielder **Jordan Walker** extended his hitting streak to 14 games with an 8th inning double yesterday night. For Walker, it's his longest streak since a career-best 17 games as a rookie in 2023. He currently trails former Cardinals farmhand **Ildemaro Vargas** (ARI) with 15, and 18 dating back to 2025. Walker also leads the N.L. in home runs (8) and slugging (.646).
