ATHLETICS (73-81) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (65-89) September 20, 2025 - PNC Park - Pittsburgh, PA - 6:40 EDT - Game #155/Home #80 RHP Luis Morales (4-1, 3.08 ERA) vs. RHP Bubba Chandler (2-1, 5.66 ERA)

THE PIRATES: have lost five straight games (since September 14 at Washington) and 12 of their last 13 games (since September 5 vs. Milwaukee), including a 4-3 loss on Friday vs. the Athletics...Are 42-37 at PNC Park (most home wins in a season since going 44-36 in 2018)...Are 53-63 since Don Kelly made his managerial debut on May 9 vs. Atlanta...

Have at least one extra-base hit in 53 straight games (since July 22 vs. Detroit), the second-longest active streak in Major League Baseball (the Athletics, 71 games, rank first) and their longest single-season streak since a 64-game run from June 1-August 14, 2019...Have played in a Major League-high 58 one-run games (are 24-34 in those games), their most in a season since 2014 (60).

PREMIER PROSPECTS: Bubba Chandler, who will make his sixth Major League appearance (third start) tonight vs. the Athletics, is rated No. 7 among MLB Pipeline's top-100 propsects... Chandler is one of five Pirates farmhands rated on Pipeline's top-100 list, along with Konnor Griffin (No. 1), Seth Hernandez (No. 26), Hunter Barco (No. 82) and Edward Florentino (No. 97).

MAKE IT A DOUBLE: Rafael Flores has doubled in each of his first two MLB games (Wednesday vs. Chicago-NL and Friday vs. the Athletics)...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, the only other Pirates since at least 1900 to double in their first two games were Fred Carisch in 1903, Cotton Tierney in 1920, Stu Clarke in 1929, Billy Cox in 1941, Jack Merson in 1951 and Jack Wilson in 2001 (Wilson was the only one to do it in his first three games)...Aside from Wilson, the only Major Leaguers in the 21st century to double in each of their first three games were Cincinnati's Chris Dickerson in 2008, Detroit's Alex Avila in 2009, Toronto's Rowdy Tellez in 2018, San Francisco's Joey Bart in 2020, Kansas City's Nick Loftin in 2023 and Miami's Agustín Ramírez and Jakob Marsee this year.

IN THE BIGINNING: Pittsburgh plated three runs in the first inning of Friday night's game vs. the Athletics...Their 81 first-inning runs are their most in any inning this season...The Pirates' 47 first-inning runs since August 1 at Colorado are the most in all of Major League Baseball during that stretch (San Francisco, 39, ranks second)...Pittsburgh's .260 batting average in the first inning this year ranks third in the National League, behind only Cincinnati (.265) and New York (.263).

TAKE A WALK: The Pirates have drawn at least one walk in 63 straight games (since July 7 at Kansas City)...That is the longest active streak in Major League Baseball and the fourth-longest streak in MLB this season...The only teams with a longer such streak were Baltimore (94 games, March 27-July 12), Arizona (67 games, April 8-June 23) and Atlanta (65 games, March 27-June 9).

SPENCER'S GIFTS: Spencer Horwitz went 1-for-3 with an RBI double on Friday vs. the Athletics...He has hit safely in eight straight starts (since September 7 vs. Milwaukee), going 9-for-29 (.310) with three doubles, two home runs, four RBI, four walks, six runs scored and a 1.015 OPS in that stretch...Since making his Pittsburgh debut on May 17 at Philadelphia, Horwitz ranks second on the team in OBP (.338), as well as third in batting (.261), hits (89) and RBI (43)... His 43 RBI since May 17 rank eighth among all National League first basemen.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

<u>September 20, 2002</u>: Jack Wilson recorded the first walkoff hit of his career with a one-out, ninth-inning single that scored Mike Benjamin and gave the Pirates a 5-4 victory over the Cubs. They entered the bottom of the ninth trailing, 4-3, but Kevin Young singled and scored the tying run on Armando Rios' double. Scott Sauerbeck earned the win, pitching a scoreless inning of relief.

2025 RECORD: 2-1, 5.66 ERA

HEIGHT/WEIGHT: 6-3/218 **BATS/THROWS:** S/R

BORN: September 14, 2002

AGE: 23 SIGNED: Thru 2025 HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in the third round of the 2021 Draft.

START ME UP: Chandler will make his third Major League start tonight...He is 2-0 with one save, a 2.25 ERA (12.0ip/3er) and a 0.83 WHIP across his three relief appearances, which came on August 22 vs. Colorado, August 27 at St. Louis and September 2 vs. Los Angeles (NL)...In his two starts, which came on September 7 vs. Milwaukee and September 13 at Washington, he is 0-1 with a 10.38 ERA (8.2ip/10er), three walks issued and 10 strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Chandler allowed one run on two hits (zero walks) while striking out seven batters over 6.0 innings of work on September 13 at Washington, having a no-decision in Pittsburgh's 5-1 win...He had a perfect game through 5.0 innings before the Nationals' Dylan Crews led off the bottom of the sixth inning with a single...With that start, Chandler became the fourth Pirates rookie in the Modern Era (since 1901) to post those stats or better in a game, joining Woodie Fryman (July 1, 1966 at New York), Nick Kingham (April 29, 2018 vs. St. Louis) and Jared Jones (May 4, 2024 vs. Colorado)...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, he also became the fourth Pirates rookie in the Expansion Era (since 1961) to have a bid for a perfect game of at least 5.0 innings, joining Kingham (6.2ip) on April 29, 2018, Bruce Kison (5.2ip) on July 23, 1971 at San Diego and Max Kranick (5.0ip) on June 27, 2021 at St. Louis.

THREE'S COMPANY: Chandler allowed three runs on six hits (three strikeouts) over 4.0 innings in his outing on September 2 vs. Los Angeles (NL), earning a 9-7 win...Two of the three runs he allowed came via solo home runs from Shohei Ohtani and Andy Pages...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, Chandler became the second Pittsburgh reliever since at least 1900 to pitch at least 4.0 innings in each of his first three outings, along with Carmen Hill (1915)... He became the second Pirates reliever in the Modern Era (since 1901) to record at least three strikeouts in each of his first three Major League outings, joining Cecilio Guante (1982)... With that win, Chandler became one of three Major League pitchers (since saves became an official stat in 1969) to earn two wins and a save in his first three Major League games...He joined Minnesota's Tom Johnson (1974) and Cincinnati's Hector Carrasco (1994) on that list.

WIN (AND SAVE) THE DAY: Chandler earned his first Major League win with 4.0 scoreless innings of relief on August 27 at St. Louis (second big-league appearance)...He also earned his first Major League save with 4.0 scoreless innings of relief on August 22 vs. Colorado, making him one of five Major League pitchers (since saves became an official stat in 1969) to earn both a win and a save in his first two MLB games, joining Rick Waits (1973/1975), Bob Stanley (1977), Mardie Cornejo (1978) and Mickey Weston (1989)...He became one of four MLB relievers in the Modern Era (since 1901) to begin his career with two outings of at least 4.0 scoreless innings (Hugh Bedient in 1912, Von McDaniel in 1957, Eric King in 1986).

DYNAMITE DEBUT: Chandler secured a 4.0-inning save in his Major League debut on August 22 vs. Colorado...Since saves became an official statistic in 1969, he was the first Pirate to earn a save in his big-league debut, and he was one of four Major Leaguers to earn a 4.0-inning save in his Major League debut, joining Boston's Bob Stanley (April 16, 1977 at Cleveland), St. Louis' Zack Thompson (June 3, 2022 at Chicago-NL) and San Francisco's Keaton Winn (June 13, 2023 at St. Louis)...Chandler was the only one to not surrender a run.

FOUR SCORE (LESS): Chandler pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in his MLB debut on August 22 vs. Colorado, becoming the first Pirates reliever to pitch at least 4.0 scoreless innings of relief in his first Major League game since Barry Jones on August 11, 1986 at Wrigley Field...That game began on April 20, but was suspended until August 11...Jones made his big-league debut that year on July 18 vs. San Diego...The only other MLB reliever to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings in his debut this season was Toronto's Paxton Schultz (4.1ip) on April 20 vs. Seattle.

SAVE IT: Chandler became the second Pirates pitcher to earn a 4.0-inning save in 2025 (August 22 vs. Colorado), along with fellow rookie Thomas Harrington (April 7 vs. St. Louis)...They became the first pair of Pirates rookies to each earn a 4.0-inning save in the same season since saves became an official statistic in 1969 (the only other Pirates rookies to earn a 4.0-inning save were Kent Tekulve on September 22, 1975 vs. Philadelphia and Blas Minor on June 19, 1993 vs. New York)...Chandler and Harrington became the first pair of Pirates teammates to each earn a 4.0-inning save in the same season since 1993...That year, Minor did it on June 19, while Joel Johnston did it on September 29 vs. Philadelphia.

TOMORROW'S STARTER

Pittsburgh has not named a starter for tomorrow's series finale against the Athletics at PNC Park.

- **®** Is 19-for-73 (.260) with seven extra-base hits since 7/23 vs. Detroit (has reached base safely in 21 of 27 games with a plate appearance in that time).
- Š Has gone 40-for-134 (.299) with runners on...Has thrown out three runners attempting to steal vs. him in his last eight starts (since 8/30 at Boston).
- Š Has a double, a home run, five RBI and three walks across nine games this month...Is 21-for-68 (.309) with a .912 OPS against left-handed pitchers.

- **®** Is 12-for-35 (.343) with three home runs in his last 18 games (since 8/18 vs. Toronto)...Has 10 multi-hit performances (last on 9/11 at Baltimore).
- **®** Has made 30 appearances (21 starts) in left field, 26 appearances (20 starts) in center field and 22 appearances (12 starts) in right field this year.

- Went 0-for-2 with a walk in Friday night's 4-3 loss vs. the Athletics...Has recorded each of the 17 hardest-hit balls by any Pirates batter this season.
- Has hit safely in four of his last six starts, dating back to 9/9 at Baltimore, going 5-for-19 (.263) with a double, a triple and an RBI during that span. **®** His 19 home runs as a center fielder are the second-most among all National League players this year, trailing Chicago's Pete Crow-Armstrong (29).
- **®** Has a career-high 38 stolen bases...Would be the first Pirates player to lead the National League in steals since Tony Womack had 58 steals in 1998.

- Š Has hit safely in back-to-back games...Has thrown out seven of the last 11 baserunners trying to steal vs. him, dating back to 8/15 at Chicago (NL).
- **®** Threw out his 14th runner trying to steal against him (Nico Hoerner) on Tuesday vs. Chicago-NL (the most by a Pirate since Elias Díaz, 14, in 2019).
- **®** His 2.95 catcher's ERA (643.2ip/211er) so far this year is the lowest by any Pittsburgh catcher with at least 600.0 innings caught in a single season.

- Š Was acquired from Kansas City on 7/16 for infielder/outfielder Adam Frazier...Hit .266 (101-for-379) in his 103 total games at Triple-A this season.

- **®** Hit .281 (38-for-135) with four doubles, six home runs, 28 RBI, 15 walks and 17 runs scored over 36 games with Indianapolis prior to his promotion.
- Š Is rated by MLB Pipeline as the No. 8 prospect in Pittsburgh's organization...Was acquired from New York (AL) on 7/31 as part of a four-player trade.
