The Arizona Fall League announced Tuesday the participants and format for the 2025 AFL Home Run Derby at Sloan Park on Saturday, Nov. 8, at 6:30 p.m. MST. In 2025, the AFL will be introducing a brand-new format where the eight (8) participants will be split into four (4) teams of two (2) players. The teams include:

Team 3: Luke Adams (SUR/MIL) & Thomas Sosa (PEO/BAL)

Thursday's Top Performance

PATRICK CLOHISY (GLD/ATL/INF) went 2-for-4 with 2 RBI and two stolen bases. Since 2005, Cloishy is only the 4th player to steal 20-plus bases in the Fall League and is tied for 2nd most during that time.

LOGAN WAGNER (GLD/LAD No.30/INF) went 2-for-3 with an RBI. Since the calendar flipped to November, Wagner has a .545 batting average with 6 hits, a double, and a home run to go along with 5 RBI.

CUTTER COFFEY (GLD/TOR No. 27/INF) extends his on-base streak to 8 games after going 3-for-4 with a two-run single and a stolen base.

DANTE NORI (SUR/PHI No. 6/OF) went 2-for-4 with a two-run inside-the-park home run.

JUAN BENJAMIN (SUR/CLE/INF) went 1-for-3 with a two-run 444-foot home run.

LUKE ADAMS (SUR/MIL No. 8/1B) went 2-for-3 with two runs scored and an RBI.

NICK MORABITO (SCO/NYM No. 16/OF) went 3-for-3 at the plate with a walk, stolen base and a two-run single in the first at 105.2 mph off the bat.

CHRIS SUERO (SCO/NYM No. 15/C) went 2-for-3 with two singles, an RBI and a walk.

Today's Headlines

Torey Lovullo To Toss Ceremonial First Pitch: The Arizona Fall League has announced that Arizona Diamondbacks Manager Torey Lovullo will throw out the honorary first pitch at the 19th Annual AFL Fall Stars Game on Sunday, Nov. 9. Receiving the honorary first pitch will be Nick Lovullo, Torey's son and coach on the Mesa Solar Sox.

Scottsdale @ **Glendale:** The Scottsdale pitching staff continues to shine after allowing just two earned runs, with starter Spencer Miles (SCO/SF) leading the way with four strikeouts in two innings pitched. Out of the bullpen, Ricardo Estrada (SF), Juan Sanchez (SF), and Hudson Leach (HOU) combined to give up three combined hits, one walk, and one earned run.

They toss out RHP **Dariel Fregio** (DET), making his eighth appearance and first start in the AFL. After attending DII Saint Leo, Fregio played in the Frontier League for the Washington Wild Things. He recorded a 13-6 record with a 4.04 ERA across 30 appearances (29 starts) in two seasons before being signed by the Tigers on June 22. Moved to the bullpen, Fregio had a 6-1 record with three saves and a 1.82 ERA across three levels. He pitched in Game 2 of the Midwest League Championship Series, helping West Michigan to a league title.

On Thursday, the Desert Dogs shut out the Javelinas. **Chen-Wei Lin** (GLE/STL No. 16/RHP) had his best outing of the fall, striking out five in three scoreless innings. They go to another 6-foot-8 right-hander in **Luke Sinnard** (ATL No. 16). Sinnard has 16 strikeouts in 1 2/3 innings pitched. He has struck out five in each of his last two starts, having allowed three total walks this season.

Mesa @ **Peoria:** RHP **Luis Martinez-Gomez** (CHC) makes his first start in the AFL after six relief appearances. He has 14 strikeouts in 7 1/3 innings picthed, leading the Solar Sox with a 17.18 strikeout per nine rate. He faces RHP **Kannon Kemp** (SD No. 28). Kemp makes his second start and fifth appearance after allowing one run across five innings, striking out six.

Salt River @ **Surprise**: After an 8-6 start, the Rafters have lost nine of their last 10 games, hoping to bounce back before Fall Stars Weekend. American League Fall Star recipient RHP **Luis Perales** (BOS No. 9) makes his sixth start, having struck out a season-high five in his last outing. 17 of his 24 fastballs (30.8%) were 99 mph or above.

The Saguaros are coming off a shutout win against Salt River. **Trenton Denholm** (SUR/CLE/RHP) went four shutout innings, surrendering three hits while collecting six strikeouts. The outing lowers his ERA to 2.13, which is tied for seventh.

RHP **Logan Martin** (KC) makes his fifth start for the Saguaros. He spent the 2025 Minor League season in High-A Quad Cities with Surprise and NL Fall Stars Game manager Jesús Azuaje. Across 22 starts, Martin had an 8-4 record and a 3.45 ERA in 91 1/3 innings pitched.
