City Connect

The Braves yesterday unveiled their new Nike City Connect uniforms and will wear them for the first time this entire series versus the Guardians. Atlanta will then wear them every Saturday home game for the remainder of the season.

The 2026 City Connect is a nod to the Braves' classic 1980s powder blue uniforms, harkening back to a time when Braves baseball was a national fixture in households across the country on the SuperStation. The uniforms have been remixed for the next generation, just as BravesVision is a new era of club-owned broadcasting for today's Braves fans.

Design elements recall the classic SuperStation era, including a new "ATL" block letter sleeve patch reminiscent of the old logo and a 3D "ATLANTA BRAVES" wordmark placed near the jocktag. The v-neck jersey was chosen with input from the players to maximize comfort and performance.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Guardians tonight open a three-game weekend series in what are the only scheduled meetings between the two teams this season...Cleveland is making just its second ever visit to Truist Park.

A Atlanta swept Cleveland over three games last season by a combined score of 17-4...The Braves have won four straight series versus the Guardians dating to 2019, and have won six of the eight total series between the clubs all time.

A The Braves and Guardians have played just 24 times since the advent of interleague play in 1997, with Atlanta playing to a 15-9 record (.625) all-time versus Cleveland...The two franchises have met twice in the World Series, with the then-Indians beating the Boston Braves in six games in 1948, before Atlanta bested Cleveland in six games in 1995 for the championship.

A Cleveland is making just its fifth-ever trip to the city of Atlanta, and just its second to Truist Park since the stadium opened in 2017...The Guardians dropped two-of-three here back in 2024, and are an even 6-6 in the city all time...Cleveland's three games here at Truist Park are the fewest by any visiting team in baseball.

A RH Slade Cecconi has never beaten the Braves in two career starts against the club, pitching to an 0-1 record with a 9.35 ERA (9 ER/8.2 IP)...The 6-foot-4, 219-pound native of Oviedo, FL, faced the Braves on August 16 last season at Progressive Field, and allowed 10 hits and eight runs, six earned, over just 4.2 innings...The right-hander is 0-1 with a 5.23 ERA through two starts this season, but did toss 6.0 scoreless, one-hit innings in his last turn vs. the Cubs.

SOMETHING'S GOTTA GIVE: Atlanta and Cleveland enter play tonight as the only two teams in baseball who have yet to lose a series this season...The Braves beat the Angels, 8-2, in a rubber game on Wednesday to win that series and keep the streak alive.

A Atlanta has won all three of its three-game sets this year, and split four games in Arizona.

A Cleveland has gone to a rubber game in all three of its own three-game series and won them all, beating Los Angeles-NL, Chicago-NL and Kansas City...The Guardians split four games with the Mariners to open the season.

A The Braves and Guardians enter play tonight with identical 8-5 records, and their respective .615 winning percentages rank tied for fourth in all of baseball...Only the Dodgers (9-3, .750), Brewers (8-4, .667) and Yankees (8-4, .667) have been better.

FIRST INNING: Atlanta opened the scoring with a first-inning run on Wednesday at Los Angeles, and the Braves 1.011 OPS in the opening inning is the highest in baseball.

A The Braves five first-inning homers are two more than any other club in the majors.

BRYCE ELDER: Enters play tonight as one of two qualified pitchers in baseball this season yet to allow an earned run, along with the Dodgers' Shohei Ohtani... Elder enters play 1-1 with a 0.00 ERA, allowing just two unearned runs over 13.0 total innings.

A Dating to August 24 of last season, Elder's 2.18 ERA (14 ER/57.2 IP) ranks fourth in the majors among pitchers with at least 50.0 innings...He trails just Yoshinobu Yamamoto (1.55), Max Fried (1.64) and Tarik Skubal (2.01)...Elder's eight "quality" starts in that span are tied with Fried, Yamamoto and Miami's Sandy Alcantara for the most in the majors.

A Elder ranks in the 94th percentile in baseball in expected ERA (1.73) and in the 91st percentile in chase percentage (37.5%).

A His slider carries a run value of three, making it the most valuable slider in baseball among qualified pitchers...He throws the pitch 37.2% of the time, and opponents have batted just .059 (1-for-17) with eight strikeouts against the offering.

A The 6-foot-2, 220-pound Texas native has made two career starts against the Guardians in his career, and is 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA (4 ER/12.0 IP)... Atlanta has won both such starts.

PITCHING: Atlanta allowed eight earned runs over three games in a series win over Los Angeles earlier this week, and the Braves currently lead Major League Baseball with a 2.03 ERA (26 ER/115.0 IP).

A The Braves have allowed no more than two runs in nine of their 13 games this season, and are 8-1 in these nine games...In the four games in which Atlanta has allowed four or more runs, the club is 0-4.

A Atlanta's bullpen pitched 2.1 scoreless innings of relief on Wednesday, and leads the majors with a 0.82 ERA (4 ER/44.0 IP)...The Braves did not allow a run in relief against the Angels, and has 12.2 consecutive innings without an earned run.

IGGY APPROACHING HISTORY: Raisel Iglesias converted his second save of the season on Tuesday night at Los Angeles, and his next save will be his 100th with Atlanta...He has converted 99 of 113 total save opportunities with the club.

A Since Major League Baseball first recognized saves as an official statistic in 1969, just four pitchers in franchise history have recorded at least 100 saves with the club...Craig Kimbrel (186), John Smoltz (154), Gene Garber (141) and Mark Wholers (112) are the only others to do so.

A Iglesias' 255 career saves rank 39th in MLB history and fifth among all active pitchers.

A Since his Braves debut on August 5, 2022, Iglesias is 15-12 with a 2.29 ERA (57 ER/224.1 IP) over 227 total appearances...His ERA in that span is best in the National League among pitchers with at least 150 innings, and his 87.6% save percentage ranks third.

Today's Game

⚡ Makes his third start of the season and 82nd career appearance (81st start) for the Braves in the opener of a three-game weekend series against Cleveland at Truist Park...This is his third career start against the Guardians and first at home against the club, having faced Cleveland twice previously, both on the road.

⚡ Has faced Cleveland twice in his career, both starts at Progressive Field, going 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA (4 ER/12.0 IP) with six walks and three strikeouts... His most recent outing against the Guardians came on April 5, 2024 (5.1 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 4 BB, 2 K)...Earned a 4-2 win in his first career start against Cleveland on July 3, 2023 (6.2 IP, 7 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 1 K).

⚡ The 6-foot-2, 220-pound right-hander has not allowed an earned run through his first two starts of the season, covering 13.0 scoreless innings...His 13.0 innings without an earned run allowed are tied for 10th most in franchise history among starters to begin a season, and ninth most among Atlanta-era pitchers (since 1966)...He is the first pitcher to have as many innings without an earned run since teammate Spencer Schwellenbach tossed 14.0 frames in 2025.

⚡ Tossed 7.0 innings of two-hit ball in his most recent outing on April 4 at Arizona, striking out eight while allowing two unearned runs and one walk in a 3-2 loss on 89 pitches...Committed his first career error (throwing) in the second inning, which led to both Arizona runs.

⚡ Has tossed 6.0 or more innings while allowing three earned runs or fewer in eight of his last nine starts dating to August 24, 2025, posting a 2.18 ERA (14 ER/57.2 IP) with a 0.95 WHIP and 54 strikeouts in that span.

⚡ His eight quality starts in that stretch are tied with New York's (AL) Max Fried, Miami's Sandy Alcantara and Los Angeles' (NL) Yoshinobu Yamamoto for the most in baseball.

⚡ Has recorded quality starts in four consecutive outings dating to September 19, 2025.

⚡ Has struck out five or more batters in seven consecutive starts, tying the longest such streak of his career.

⚡ In his career, Elder is 13-11 with a 4.88 ERA (121 ER/223.1 IP) in 42 appearances at home and 12-14 with a 4.01 ERA (100 ER/224.1 IP) in 39 games on the road.

⚡ Since the start of the 2023 season, the Braves are 39-32 (.549) in Elder's starts.

2026

⚡ Earned the win in his season debut on March 30, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings against the Athletics (5 H, 1 BB, 5 K, 83 pitches)...Recorded his first career pickoff, catching Lawrence Butler at first base in the second inning.

⚡ Was the first Braves starter since Charlie Morton (June 2, 2024) to record a 6.0-plus inning scoreless start against the A's.

⚡ Took the loss on April 4 at Arizona despite tossing 7.0 innings without allowing an earned run (4 H, 2 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 8 K, 89 pitches)...Committed his first career fielding error, a throwing miscue in the second inning that resulted in two unearned runs...Atlanta managed just two runs of support in the 3-2 defeat.

2025

⚡ Led the Braves in starts (28) for the second time in three years...Also led the staff with 31 starts in 2023.

⚡ Struck out a career-most 12 hitters on June 7, scattering three hits and one earned run over 8.0 innings at San Francisco without issuing a walk...The 12 punchouts were the second most by a Braves starter in 2025.

⚡ Recorded six quality starts over his final seven outings of the season, dating to August 24...The six quality starts led the National League over that stretch and were tied with New York's (AL) Carlos Rodón for the most in the majors.

⚡ Closed the 2025 season going 3-2 with a 3.13 ERA (11 ER/31.2 IP) and 32 strikeouts in five September starts...Allowed two earned runs or fewer in four of those five outings.

⚡ Won back-to-back starts on September 3 and 8 against Chicago (NL), going 2-0 with a 0.68 ERA (1 ER/13.1 IP) and 12 strikeouts over the two outings.

⚡ Went 0-3 with an 8.25 ERA (22 ER/24.0 IP) over five June starts...Allowed a career-high 10 runs (9 ER) and three home runs over 2.0 innings on June 27 against Philadelphia.

⚡ When pitching on four days of rest, Elder has posted a career 3.87 ERA while going 7-8 across 28 starts...He is 10-5 with a 4.41 ERA on five days rest and 7-11 with a 5.43 ERA on six or more days rest.

⚡ **Awards:** 2023 National League All-Star.

⚡ Completed his first full major league season in 2023, going 12-4 with a 3.81 ERA (74 ER/174.2 IP) in 31 games, all starts.

⚡ Named to the 2023 National League All-Star Team, his first selection.

⚡ Joined Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz and Michael Soroka as the only starters in Atlanta-franchise history to make the All-Star team in their second year playing.

⚡ Atlanta won 21 games started by Elder in his first full season with the Braves, the second most team victories on the season...Trailed only teammate Spencer Strider's 26 team wins that year.

⚡ Made six starts in his career of at least 6.0 innings without allowing a run, the most such games in Braves franchise history (since 1900) in a player's first 25 starts...Irv Young (1905), Clif Curtis (1909-'10) and Ian Anderson ('20-'21) each had five such starts.

⚡ Was originally drafted by Atlanta in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Texas...Was the fifth member of the 2020 draft class to debut, and the lowest-selected pick to do so.

⚡ Of the first five members to play in the majors from the 2020 draft class, three were selected with the first 11 picks in the draft - Detroit's Spencer Torkelson (No. 1 overall), the Angels' Reid Detmers (No. 10) and the White Sox's Garrett Crochet (No. 11).

⚡ The other two were both selected by Atlanta, and chosen with the 126th (Spencer Strider) and 156th (Elder) overall selections.

- Appeared in 42 games in his second season as a Brave in 2025, pitching to a 3-2 record and a 3.81 ERA (23 ER/54.1 IP) with 51 strikeouts and a 1.25 WHIP, his lowest since 2020...Was placed on the injured list on August 24 due to left shoulder inflammation and missed the remainder of the season.
- Ranked in the 99th percentile in baseball with a barrel rate of just 3.2% in 2025...His nine total barrels and 2.8% barrel rate allowed since joining the Braves in 2024 are both the best in the majors (min. 400 batters faced).
- Opponents hit ground balls off him 55.8% of the time last season (league average 42.4%)...Since his debut in 2017, Bummer's career ground ball rate of 64.0% is highest in the majors (min. 350 games).
- Tossed his curveball a career-high 35.1% of the time in 2025, the most of any major league pitcher with at least 900 total pitches last season...Utilized a curveball for the first time in 2024 at a 2.3% clip.

- Picked up the 41st multi-inning save of his career, his second as a Brave (also: 9/22/24 at MIA, 2.0 IP), on April 7 at Los Angeles-AL...Despite having just two since 2022, Iglesias' 41 saves of 1.1-plus innings are the most in MLB since he became a primary reliever in 2016.
- In his third full season with Atlanta, appeared in a career-high 70 games and went 29-for-34 in save opportunities...Pitched to a 3.21 ERA (24 ER/67.1 IP)...Ranked fourth in the NL and tied for ninth in the majors in saves.
- Has not allowed a run in 47 of his last 50 appearances since June 9 of last season...He leads major league relievers with at least 45.0 innings pitched in ERA (1.10, 6 ER/49.0 IP), WHIP (0.67) and batting average against (.139) and ranks second in fWAR (1.7) in that span...Is the first Braves pitcher to allow six runs or less across 50 appearances since Craig Kimbrel from June 8, 2013-April 12, 2014.
- Among active pitchers with as many appearances since his Braves debut on August 5, 2022 (227 apps.), Iglesias owns the best ERA (2.29, 57 ER/224.1 IP), WHIP (0.93) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.98, 244 K/49 BB).
- Ranked second among Braves pitchers in franchise history (min. 100 G) in WHIP and ERA+ (183), third in strikeout-to-walk ratio, fourth in hits-per-nine-innings (6.4) and fifth in ERA and saves (99).

- Pitched to a 5-0 record with a 0.72 ERA (2 ER/25.0 IP), a 0.68 WHIP and 22 strikeouts in 24 outings with Atlanta to conclude the 2025 season.
- Since his Braves debut on July 31, 2025, Kinley ranks among major league pitchers (min. 25.0 IP) in ERA (2nd, 0.61, 2 ER/29.2 IP), opponent's OPS (3rd, .354), WHIP (4th, 0.67) and batting average against (4th, .126).
- Is tied with Raisel Iglesias for the fewest runs allowed (2) in a pitcher's first 29 outings with Atlanta in the live-ball era...He and Craig Kimbrel hold the second-lowest ERA, only trailing Iglesias' mark of 0.34 when he arrived to the club in 2022.
- Allowed a run in his third appearance with the Braves, August 5, and then allowed one additional tally over his final 21 games...Strung together a career-high scoreless streak of 19.1 innings between runs.
- Among Braves pitchers with at least 24 appearances in a season, Kinley holds the second-best ERA, WHIP, hits-per-nine-innings (4.0) and ERA+ (583) marks in a single campaign.
- Ranked in the 100th percentile in baseball by allowing a hard-hit percentage of 29.6 percent.
