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THE TWINS: Have gone 1-3 through four games on their seven-game roadtrip, going 1-2 in Chicago against the Cubs last weekend, followed by a loss in Cleveland to the Guardians last night...tonight, they will continue the trip with the second of four at Progressive Field through Thursday afternoon.
✂ Twins are looking to avoid dropping four-straight games for the first time since May 27-31, when they lost five-straight (2 at CWS, 3 at PIT).
✂ Twins looking to snap a three-game road losing streak after going 10-3 in a 13-game stretch away from Target Field, from June 15-July 17.

CLEVELAND ROCKED: The Twins lost to the Guardians last night at Progressive Field by a score of 13-4...Joe Ryan (6-6) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing eight runs on a career-high 10 hits in 4.0 innings pitched, including six home runs allowed — the most allowed by a pitcher in franchise history...the pitching staff allowed 19 hits on the night, marking a season-high and most since June 20, 2025 vs. Milwaukee (also 19)...the offense recorded 10 hits and were led by Josh Bell and Trevor Larnach, who had two hits apiece and both doubled.

MISTER ANDERSON, SURPRISED TO SEE ME?: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Jack Anderson from Triple-A St. Paul...Anderson made one start for the Saints since being claimed off waivers from the Red Sox on July 11, pitching 3.0 scoreless innings with two hits allowed, no walks and one strikeout on July 17 vs. Louisville...prior to joining the Twins, Anderson made his major league debut for the Red Sox on April 14 and pitched in three games in relief for Boston, posting a 3.38 ERA (8.0 IP, 3 ER) with eight hits allowed, two walks, six strikeouts and a .267 opponent batting average...the 26-year-old also made 16 appearances (11 starts) with Triple-A Worcester, going 2-4, 4.81 ERA (58.0 IP, 31 ER), 21 walks, 51 strikeouts and a .259 opponent batting average.
✂ To make room for Anderson on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Woosuk Go to St. Paul.

RINGING THE BELL FOR 10 YEARS: Josh Bell is celebrating 10 years of major league service today...teammates Byron Buxton (April 5) and Taylor Rogers (April 21) reached that milestone earlier this season...Bell was drafted by the Pirates in the second round of the 2011 MLB Draft and has played parts of 11 seasons with Pittsburgh ('16-20), Washington ('21-22, '25), San Diego ('22), Cleveland ('23), Miami ('23-24) and Arizona ('24)...among actives, he ranks tied for 25th in walks (606), 27th in games (1,385), 31st in RBI (736), 33rd in hits (1,243), 37th in total bases (2,150) and tied for 38th in homers (206).

✂ He has 60 RBI on the season, tied for 11th-most in the AL.
✂ Bell is three RBI from matching his 2025 total of 63, which he reached in 140 games.
✂ He is on pace to record 96 RBI, which would be the second-most of his career (116 - 2019).
✂ Since September 7, 2025, Bell has recorded 78 RBI, tied for sixth-most in baseball since that date.

HAWKINS LAB: Despite the five runs allowed last night, the bullpen has posted a 3.00 ERA with a .230 opponent batting average this month...below are the bullpen's June and July comparisons:

GUARD PLAY: The Twins and Guardians are playing the eighth of 13 meetings today...Twins are 4-3 vs. the Guards this season, going 2-2 at Cleveland and 2-1 at Target Field.

✂ Since the start of 2024, 20 of the 33 games between these two have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 7-13 in those)...and 14 have been decided by one run (Twins 5-9)...at Progressive Field alone, nine of the last 10 here have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 3-7).
✂ Twins have just three homers against Cleveland pitching this season: Buxton off Festa (5/8 at CLE), Buxton off Bibee (5/9 at CLE) and Lewis off Williams (7/9 at MIN).
✂ Over his last eight games vs. the Guards, Brooks Lee is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with six RBI.
✂ In his last 15 games vs. Cleveland, Kody Clemens is hitting .315 (17-for-54) with six doubles, two triples, a .500 slugging percentage and an .839 OPS.
✂ In his last seven games against Cleveland, Byron Buxton is hitting .370 (10-for-27) with three doubles, two home runs, four RBI, three walks, a .704 slugging percentage and a 1.137 OPS.

ROCK AND ROLL: Twins need to win each of the next three games to earn consecutive series wins in this ballpark, which would mark the first time since September of 2021 and June of 2022.

✂ Since 2019, the Twins have hit 76 home runs at Progressive Field, their second-most at any opposing ballpark, trailing Rate Field (98)...also in that span, no opponent has homered more in this ballpark (next: Royals with 60).
✂ In his last 15 games at Progressive Field, Josh Bell is hitting .345 (19-for-55) with four doubles, one triple, three home runs, 10 RBI and a .997 OPS.
✂ In 14 career games at Progressive Field, Royce Lewis is hitting .306 (15-for-49) with nine RBI and an .810 OPS...he has reached safely in nine-straight in Cleveland...his first game here came on July 7, 2019 for the AL team in the Futures Game.
✂ Byron Buxton has reached base safely in eight-straight games at Progressive Field, hitting .382 (13-for-34) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI and a 1.034 OPS in that span...has multiple hits in four of his last five games in this ballpark.

FEELING LIKE A MILLION BUX: Over his last 23 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .330 (29-for-88) with six doubles, eight home runs, 18 RBI, 17 runs scored, six walks, a .375 on-base percentage, a .670 slugging percentage and a 1.045 OPS...
✂ He is seeking his first home run since June 22 vs. Los Angeles-NL, a leadoff shot off Will Klein in a 2-1 loss...his current eight-game homer drought is his second-longest of the season; his long is 14 games to begin the season (March 26-April 11).
✂ He enters today with a six-game hitting streak on the road.

FOR THE ROAD...PHONE, WALLET, KEAS: Luke Keaschall has hit safely in seven-straight road games...over his last 14 road games, since June 16, Keaschall is hitting .409 (18-for-44) with eight walks, a .527 on-base percentage and a 1.118 OPS...his road OPS since that date ranks fourth in baseball, trailing Esmerlyn Valdez (1.131), Josh Bell (1.124) and Trevor Larnach (1.119).

OH JEEZ, PRETTY COOL: On this day in 2024, Joe Mauer was inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame, along with Todd Helton, Adrian Beltré and Jim Leyland...Mauer became the third catcher elected to HOF on first ballot (Johnny Bench, Ivan Rodriguez)...he also became the fourth player to make HOF after being drafted first overall (Ken Griffey Jr., Chipper Jones, Harold Baines).
