TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Padres play the second game of this three game series today...dating back to the start of last season, SF has won eight of 14 home games against the Padres, outscoring them 78-56.

RUF RYDERS ROLL: IF/OF Darin Ruf turned in his second career multi-HR game yesterday...his other came on October 2, 2012 at Washington while playing for Philadelphia...according to *Sport Radar*, the amount of days between Ruf's first and second career multi-HR games (3,517 days between October 2, 2012 and May 20, 2022) is the 14th longest stretch for a player between their first and second career multi-homer games in Major League history.

OUT HERE RUF'IN IT: Since April 30, Ruf is slashing .400/.516/.640 over his last 17 games...he has three doubles, three homers, 13 RBI, 15 runs scored and has walked (12 times) more than he has struck out (11 times)...furthermore, since the start of 2021, Ruf has a hard-hit percentage of 52.6% of his batted balls, ranking 12th in the Majors in that time (min. 250 PA)...Mike Trout is 11th, Manny Machado is 13th and teammate Evan Longoria is eighth (53.7%) (SIS).

DON'T GET TOO COMFY: The Giants are in a stretch where they play 16-of-22 games on the road from May 13-June 5...this six-game homestand with the Padres and Mets is SF's only six games in this stretch...they are 3-4 in the 22-game stretch thus far.

MAY FLOWERS: This month, the Giants have hit .258 with a .349 OBP and a .753 OPS in 17 games...the Giants .349 OBP is tops in the Majors this month while their .258 average is fifth-best in the Majors...the club's .753 OPS is sixth-best...the Giants have scored 92 runs this month, tied for fifth-most in the Majors with Milwaukee...the Dodgers lead the Majors with 111 runs scored in May.

WHO ARE WE GONNA CALL?: SF fell to 1-2 in extra-inning affairs in 2022 with last night's loss...since 2020, the Giants are 12-14 (.461) in extra-inning contests...they are 5-7 in extras at home since 2020 and 7-7 on the road.

MAINTAIN DISCIPLINE: According to *Sports Info Solutions*, the Giants rank 23rd in MLB in OPS when the pitcher is ahead in the count (.460 OPS)...when the pitcher is behind in the count, SF owns a 1.030 OPS, 2nd-best in the Majors behind the Yankees (1.045)...when the count is even, SF's .726 OPS is fourth best.

WITHIN THE PARK: SF's 27 homers allowed this year are fewest in the Majors...only 10 of those homers have come here at home, tied with Houston and Cleveland for the fewest in MLB...since 2020, however, SF has given up 19 homers to the Padres here at Oracle Park, the most they've allowed against any opponent in that span (Dodgers are second with 13) (Stats, LLC).

STEERING THE SHIP: IF Brandon Belt had five hits over his two games played against the Padres earlier this season, extending his hitting streak against them to nine games...the nine game streak is the second-longest active such streak behind Adam Frazier (13)...Belt has 137 hits against the Padres throughout his career, fifth-most vs. San Diego among active players...teammate IF Brandon Crawford is fourth (138) (Stats, LLC.)

MORE WALKING, LESS TALKING: SF drew five walks in last night's loss to the Padres, just the second time this year SF has drawn at least five walks and lost...they are 11-2 in such games with the only other loss coming May 1 vs. Washington...the Giants 149 walks this season are second in the Majors behind the Dodgers, who have walked 161 times.

SITUATIONAL: The Giants have an MLB-leading eight homers with runners in scoring position and two outs this season after totaling 26 such homers in all of last year...overall, SF's 13 homers with RISP are fourth-most in the Majors...conversely, SF's on base percentage with nobody on base is .310, sixth-best in MLB.

WITH THE GIANTS: Embarks on his first season with SF after spending the past seven seasons with the Chicago White Sox... signed a two-year contract with the Giants on March 16, 2022.

LAST OUTING: Struggled in his last outing, allowing eight runs on 10 hits in 3.2 innings of work in the Giants 15-6 loss to the Cardinals...his eight runs allowed matched his career high (fourth time; previous: April 26, 2019 vs. DET).

A LITTLE MORE ABOUT LAST TIME: St. Louis went 6-for-12 vs. Rodón's fastball and 4-for-7 off his slider..Rodón also got hurt at the bottom of the zone (four hits – two doubles and a HR in 20 pitches)...entering the last start, he'd allowed five hits total all season long on low pitches (209 pitches) (S/S).

ELITE STATUS: Prior to his last outing, he had posted a 4-1 record with a 1.80 ERA, .165 opponents average and 53 strikeouts in six starts...in each of those starts he tossed at least 5.0-innings and allowed two-runs-or-less...allowed three hits or fewer in five of the six.

VS. SAN DIEGO: Is scheduled to face the Padres for the first time in his career...is 1-3 with a 5.40 ERA in five career games against the National League West.

LIMITING LEFTIES: Left-handed hitters are just 2-for-22 (.091) off him, while right-handers are 9-for-28 (.237).

FAST AND FURIOUS: Has thrown his fastball 63.6% of the time with opponents hitting .215 (20-for-103) off of it...his fastball is averaging 96.3 mph, the third-hardest of any left-handed starter this year (up from 95.4 mph in 2021).

IN THE RANKINGS: Has posted a 13.03 strikeout per 9.0 inning ratio, the second-best figure in the Majors behind CWS' Dylan Cease...he's also posted a 0.23 home run per 9.0 inning ratio, the fifth-best figure in the Majors behind TEX's Martin Perez, TOR's Kevin Gausman, HOU's Framber Valdez and OAK's Paul Blackburn. .

Last Game: 5/20 vs. SD; 0.1ip (4 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed his first home run since June 1, 2021 (56.2 innings) on Thursday in COL...it was the longest active streak in the Majors.
- ▶ Has allowed five runs in 9.1 innings of work, covering his 14 appearances this season...eight of his 14 outings have been less than 1.0 inning of work.
- ▶ Right-handers are 7-for-their-last-13 (.538) off him after starting the season 0-for-11.
- ▶ Has allowed one hit on his changeup this year (1-for-17).

#59 JOHN BREBBIA ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Changeup
Last Game: 5/20 vs. SD; 1.0ip, 1k (18 pitches)

- ▶ Has held opponents scoreless in 14 of his 17 outings, posting a 2.00 ERA (4er, 18.0ip).
- ▶ Has struck out 9.50 batters per 9.0 innings this year.
- ▶ Batters are 1-for-20 off his fastball in 2022...they went 10-for-39 (.256) off his fastball last year.
- ▶ His average fastball velo is up 1 mph (92.9mph to 94.2 mph)...his slider velocity is up 1.7 mph from last year (81.4 to 83.1 mph).

#75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Cutter
Last Game: 5/20 vs. SD; L, 1.0ip, 2h, 2r, 1er, 1k (18 pitches)

- ▶ Has been unscored upon in 13 of 16 games this year...has allowed just two earned runs in his last 15 games (15.2ip).
- ▶ Is 7-for-8 in save opportunities.
- ▶ Right handers are just 3-for-35 off him, while lefties are 9-for-26.
- ▶ Recorded 20 of his 21 strikeouts on his slider, which batters are hitting .116 (5x43) off of...batters are 7x18 (.389) off his cutter.

#66 JARLÍN GARCÍA ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Changeup, Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider
Last Game: 5/13 at STL; 1.0ip (9 pitches)

- ▶ Has yet to allow an earned run in 13.1 innings...is one of five relievers in MLB to have not allowed an earned run this year, joining J.P. Feyereisen, Josh Hader, Ryan Helsley and Joe Smith (min. 12ip).
- ▶ García has walked six and struck out 10 in 13 games this year.
- ▶ Left-handers are 1-for-14 (.071) off him.
- ▶ Owns a 1.67 ERA (12er, 64.2ip) since June 1 of last year, the sixth-best in the NL in that time (min. 45 games).

#52 DOMINIC LEONE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, 4-Seam FB, Sinker
Last Game: 5/17 at COL; 1.0ip, 1h, 1k (11 pitches)

- ▶ Has allowed just two walks in 12.2ip...his 3.7 BB% ranks in the top 8% of the league.
- ▶ Missed seven games while on the Covid List From April 29-May 7..
- ▶ Opponents are hitting .360 (9x25) off his cutter this year compared to .229 last season.
- ▶ Batters are also hitting .273 off his slider (3-for-11) early on this year...they were 5-for-55 off it a season ago (.091).
- ▶ LHBs are 7-for-15 (.467) off him with five doubles and a home run.

#46 ZACK LITTELL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Splitter
Last Game: 5/20 vs. SD; 0.2ip, 1bb, 2k (21 pitches)

- ▶ Has allowed four earned runs in his last 3.0 innings, covering his last three outings (12.00 ERA)... allowed four runs in 10.2ip over 10 games prior to that (3.38 ERA).
- ▶ Activated off the Covid-IL on May 5...missed seven games.
